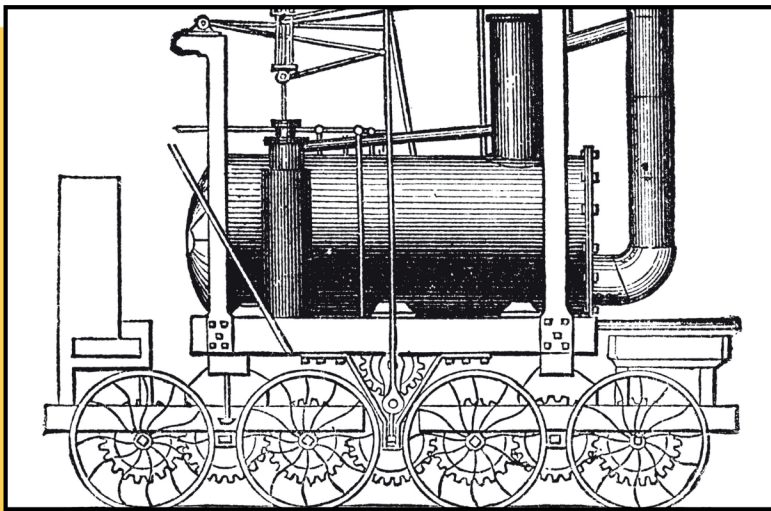


Today in History

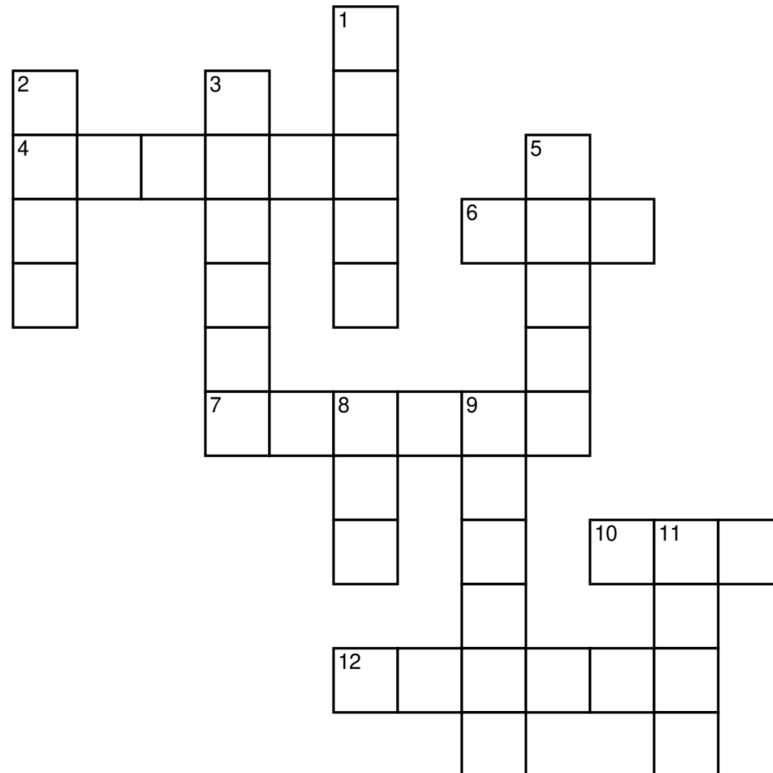

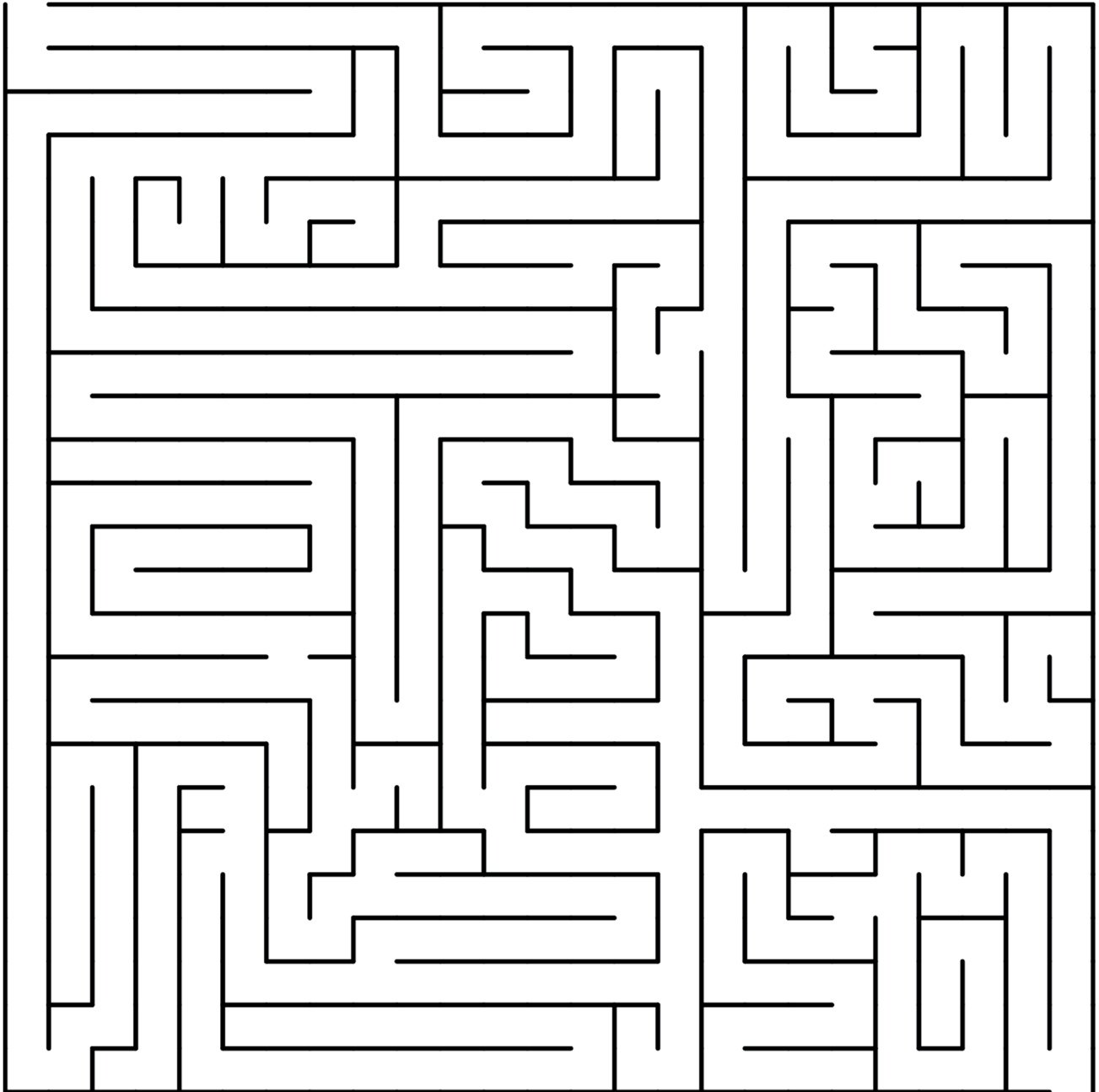

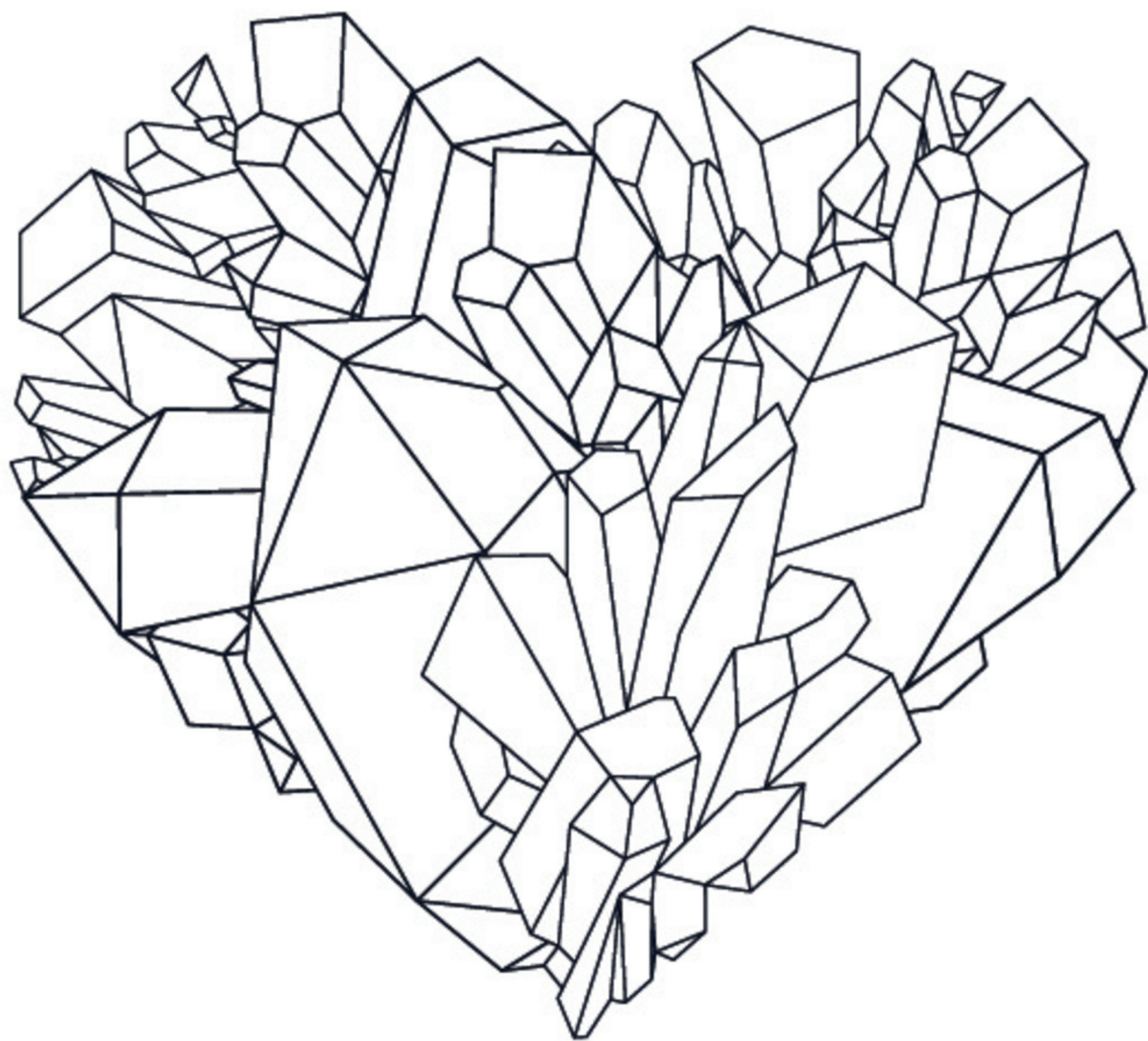
