DID YOU KNOW? Chunnel

The Channel Tunnel, or Chunnel, is a remarkable 31.35-mile underwater railway connecting Folkestone in England to Coquelles in France beneath the English Channel. As the only fixed link between Great Britain and mainland Europe, it boasts the world's longest underwater tunnel section at 23.5 miles and ranks as the third-longest railway tunnel overall. At its deepest point, it is 246 feet below the seabed, with trains zipping through at 99 mph. It's a modern marvel!

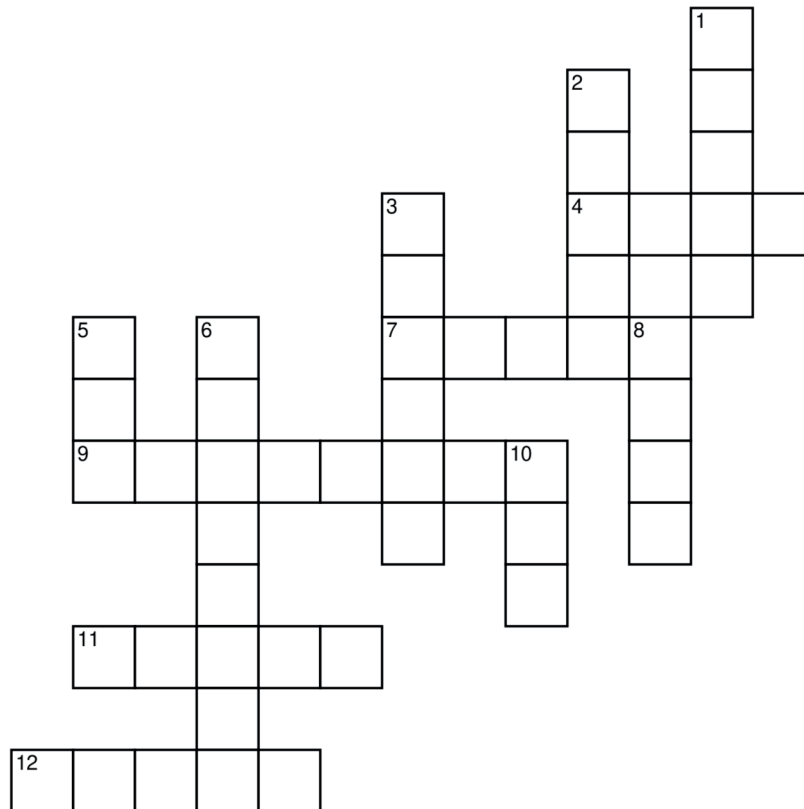

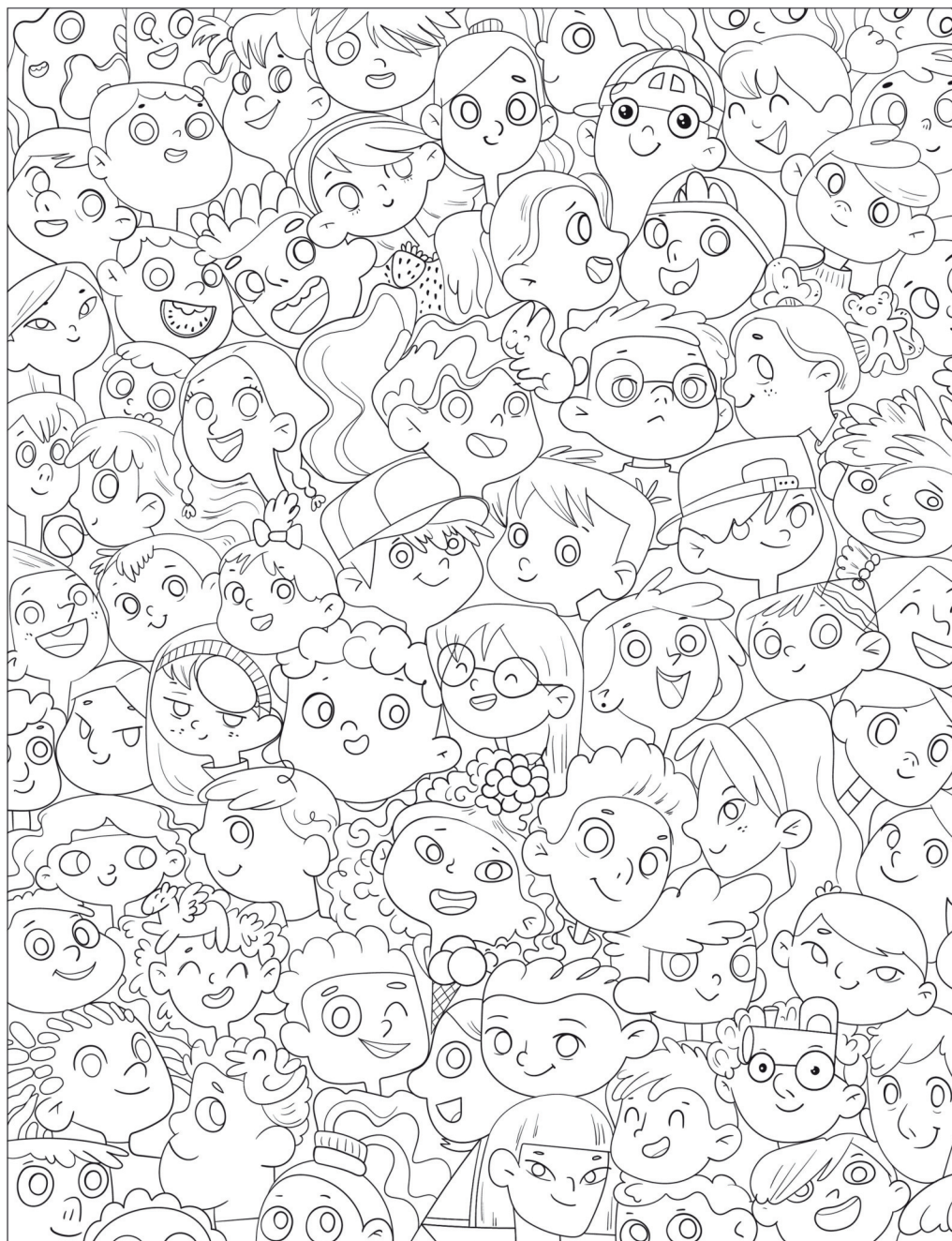

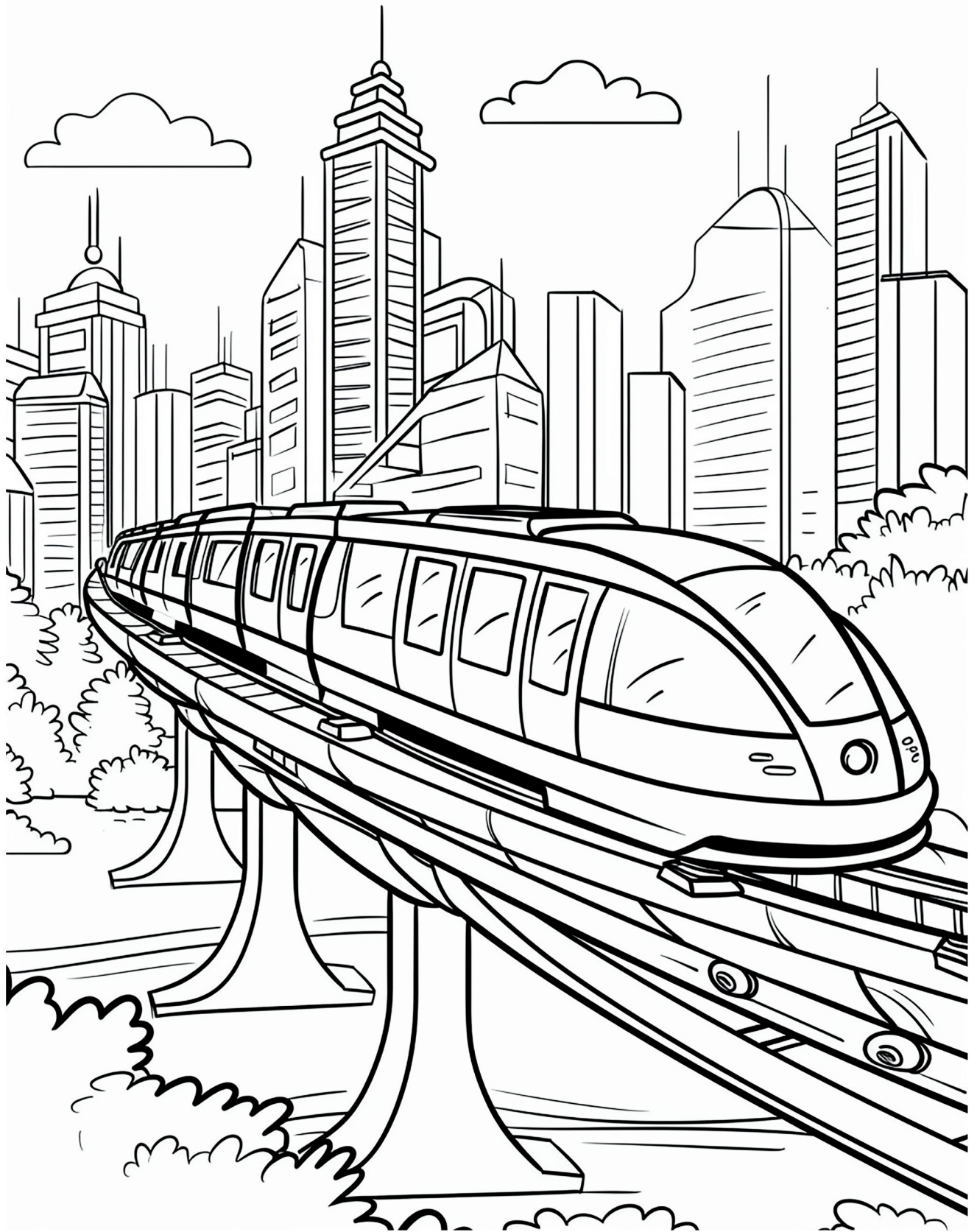
