They are seen as divine vessels in mythology, creating a connection between the celestial and mortal realms. This symbolism is prevalent in traditional art and literature from the Ming and Qing Dynasties. The significance of lucky clouds continues today, with their representation on Chinese athletes' uniforms during the 2008 Beijing Olympics.

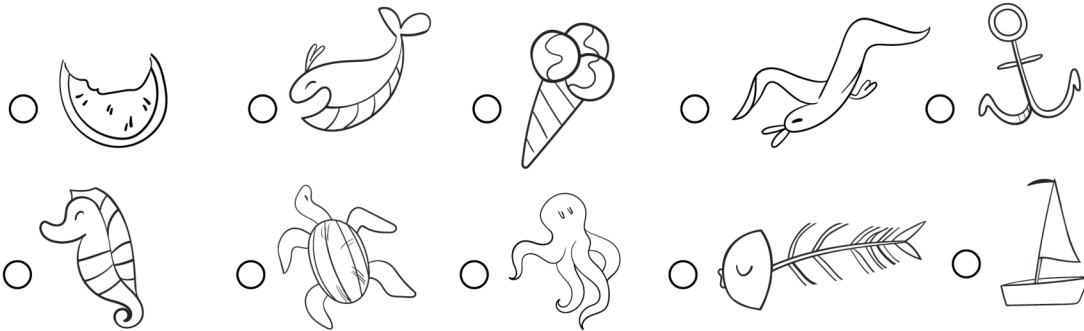

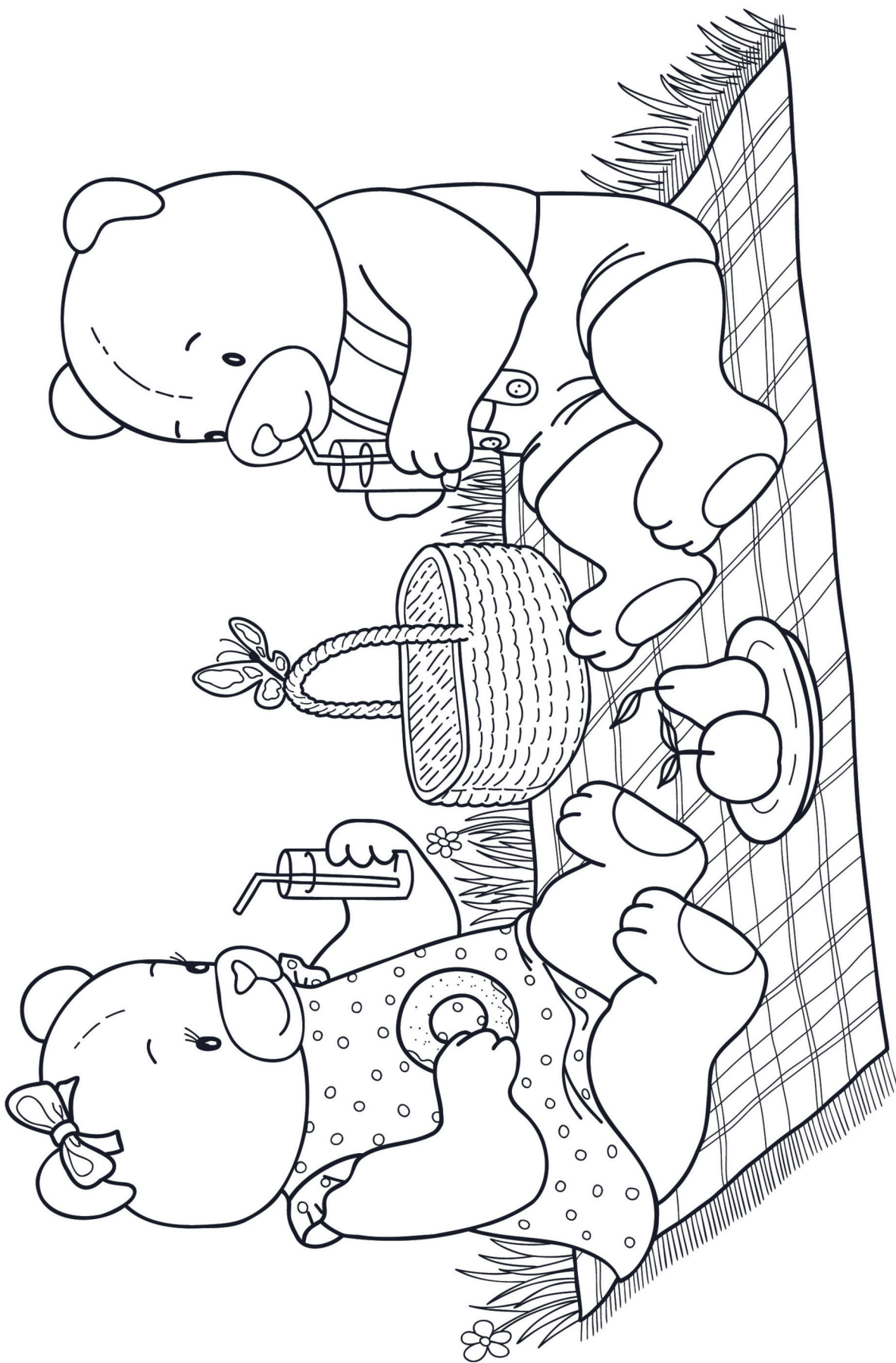

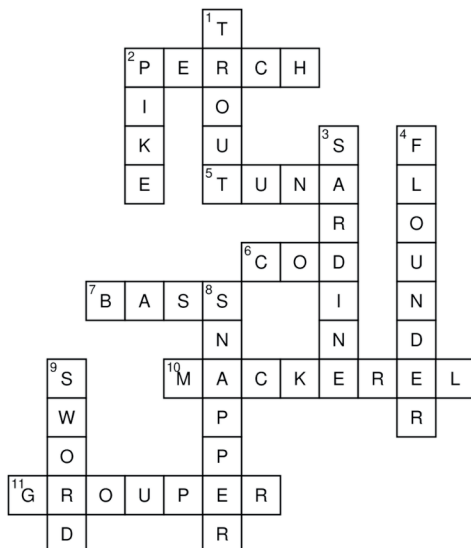




SOLUTIONS
