## DID YOU KNOW? Brando's Try at Directing

Marlon Brando took on a major role in the production of *One-Eyed Jacks* (1961), replacing original director Stanley Kubrick as both star and director. While this creative control suited him, Brando's tendency to allow extensive improvisation led to significant time and budget issues. Producer Frank P. Rosenberg criticized the resulting 4.5-hour cut as merely a collection of footage. The film was eventually cut to 141 minutes, discouraging Brando from directing again.

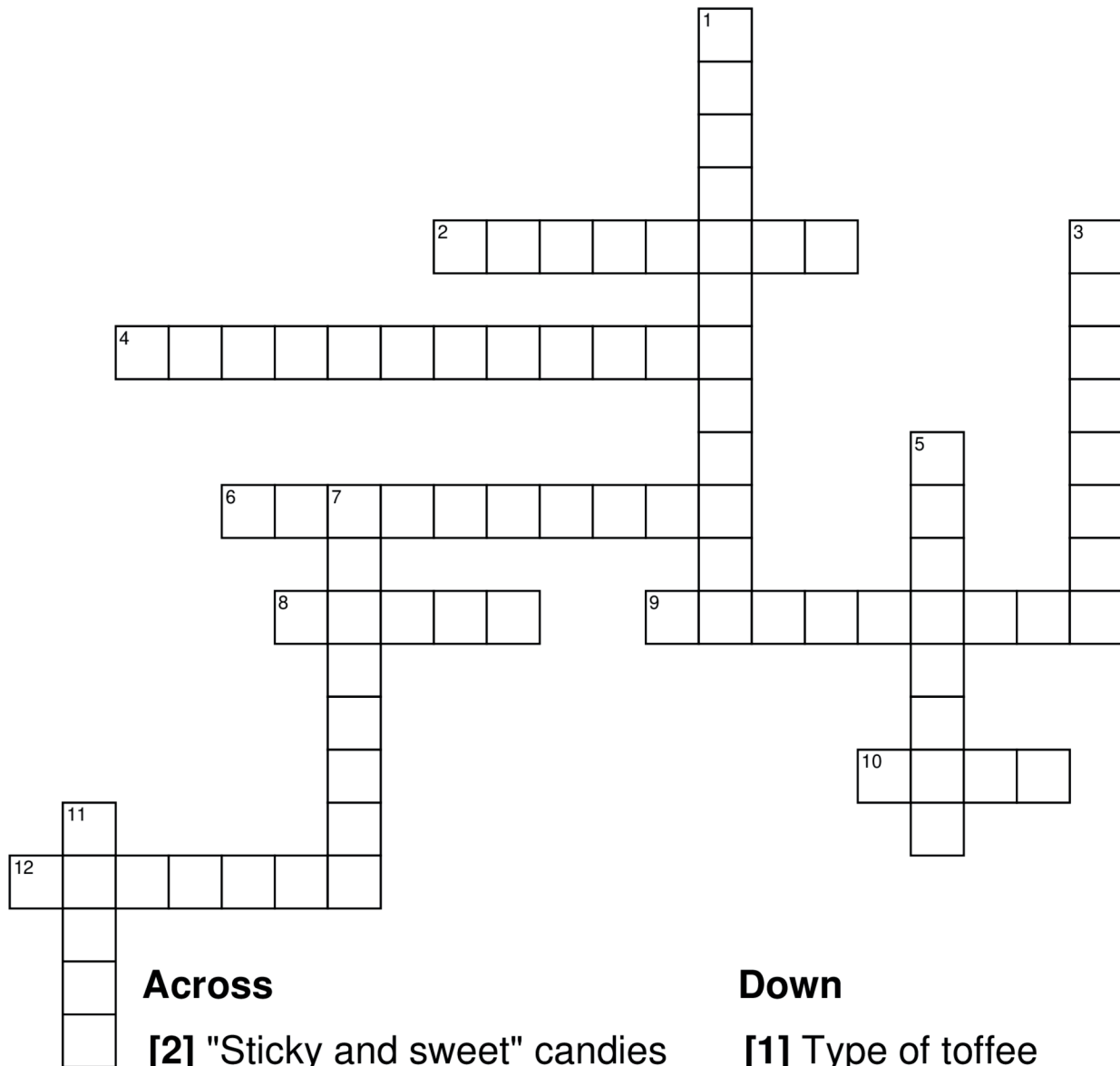

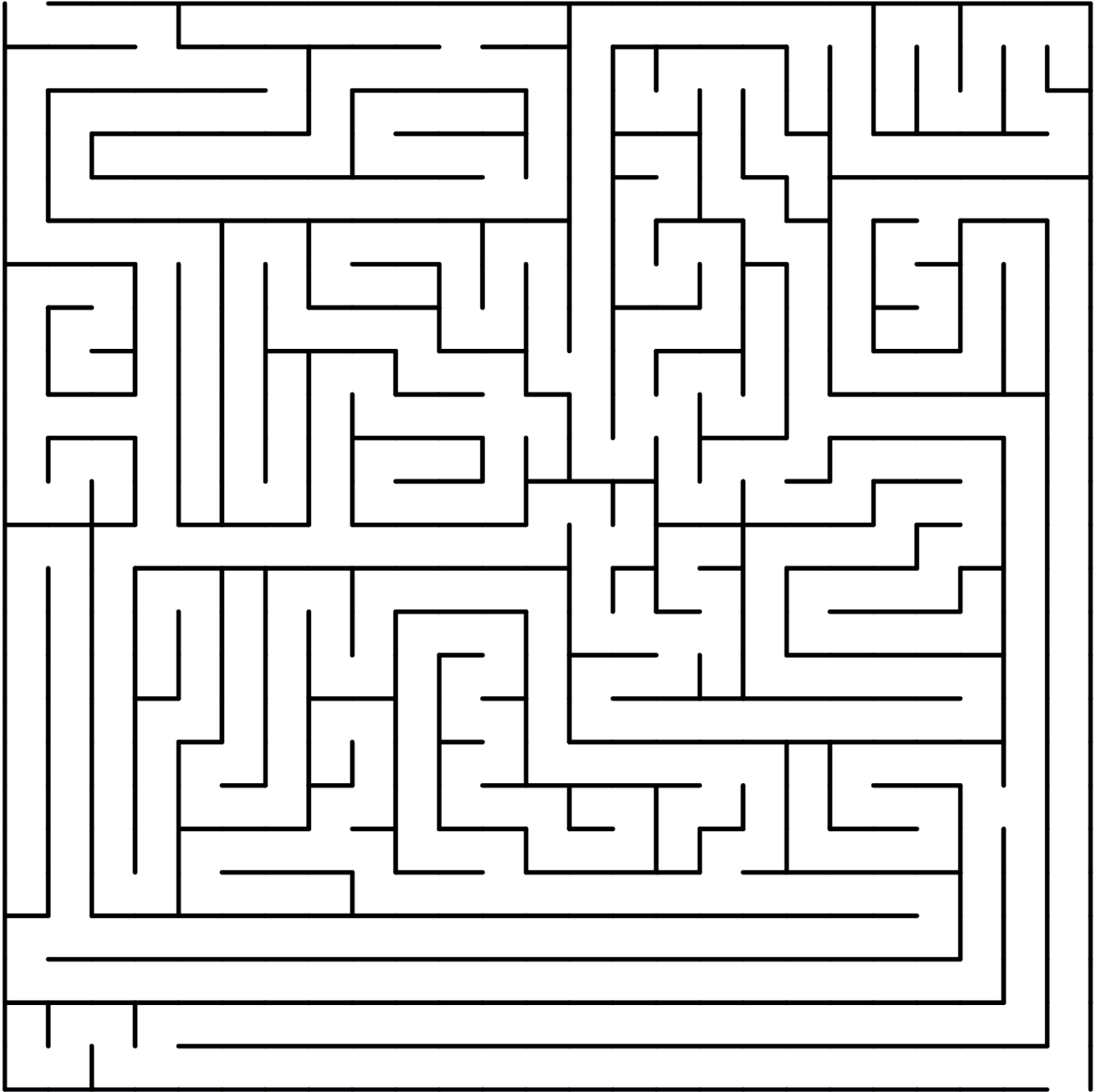
