Picasso's Stripped Connection

Pablo Picasso's iconic striped shirt was more than a fashion choice; it was a deliberate part of his persona. The shirt, a “marinière” or Breton stripe, was the traditional uniform of French sailors, designed to make them visible if they fell overboard. For Picasso, who spent much of his life in France, it symbolized a connection to the sea and working-class authenticity. By adopting this garment, he crafted a signature look that blended artistic nonchalance with Gallic charm.

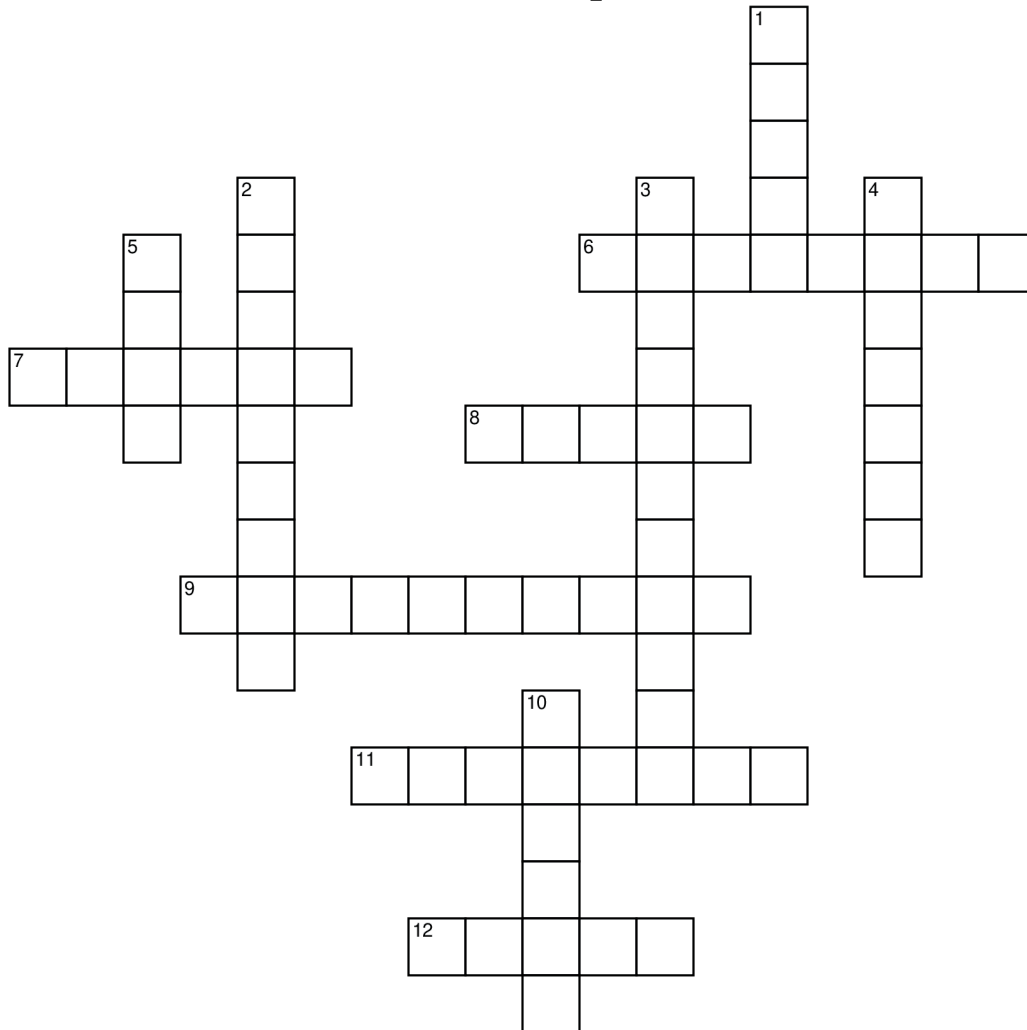

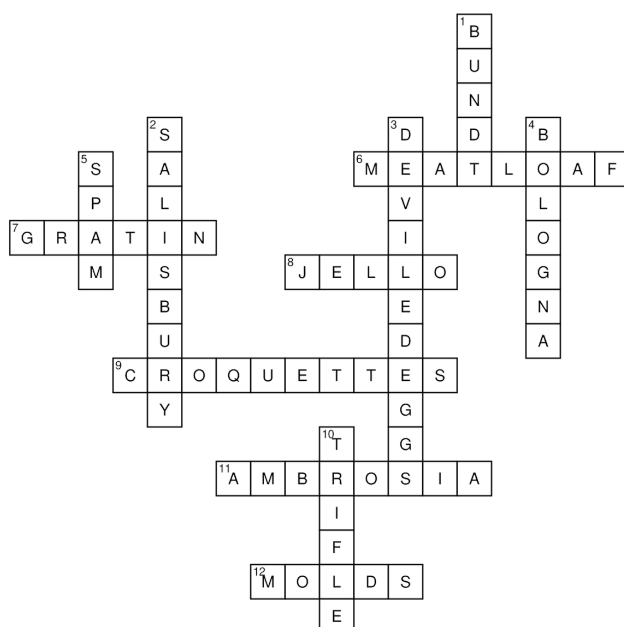
Trivia Answer: B
