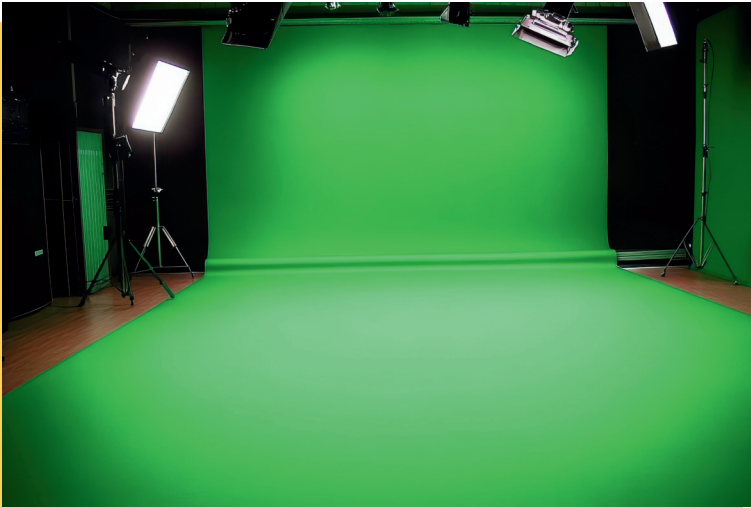


## Today in History

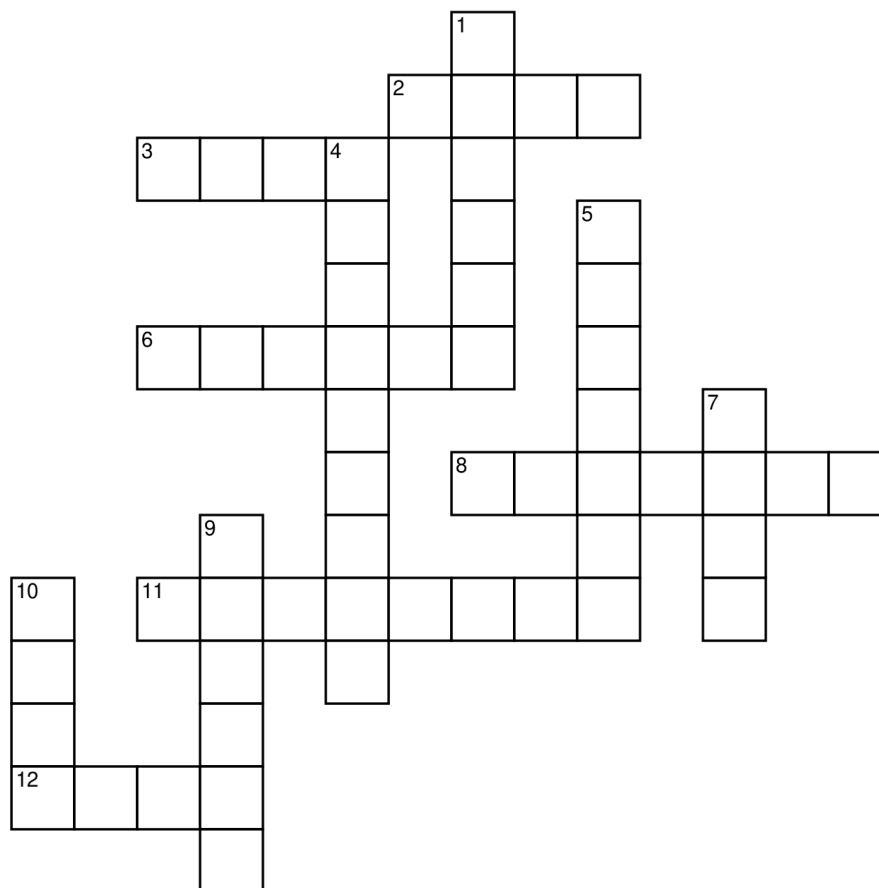

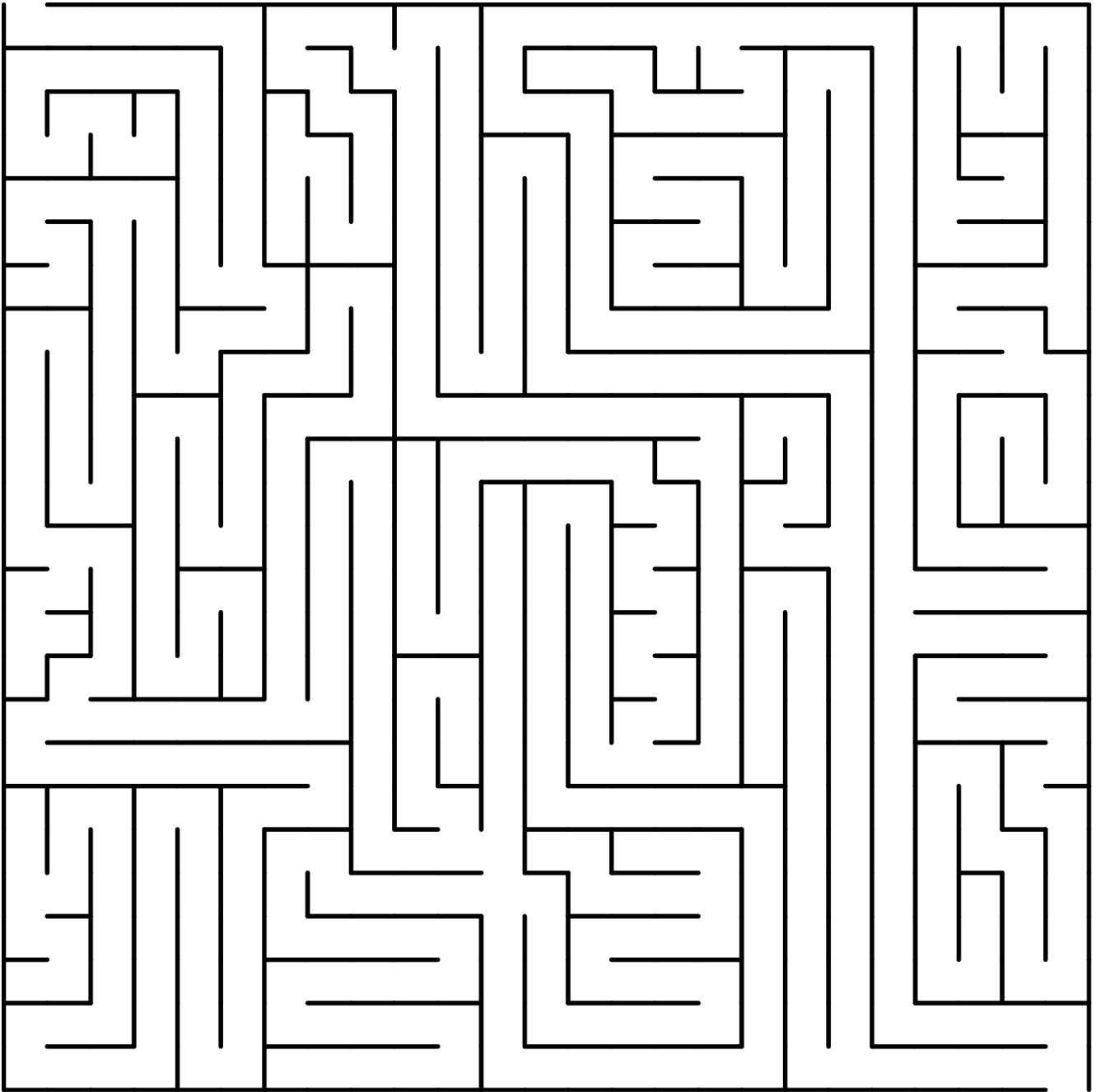

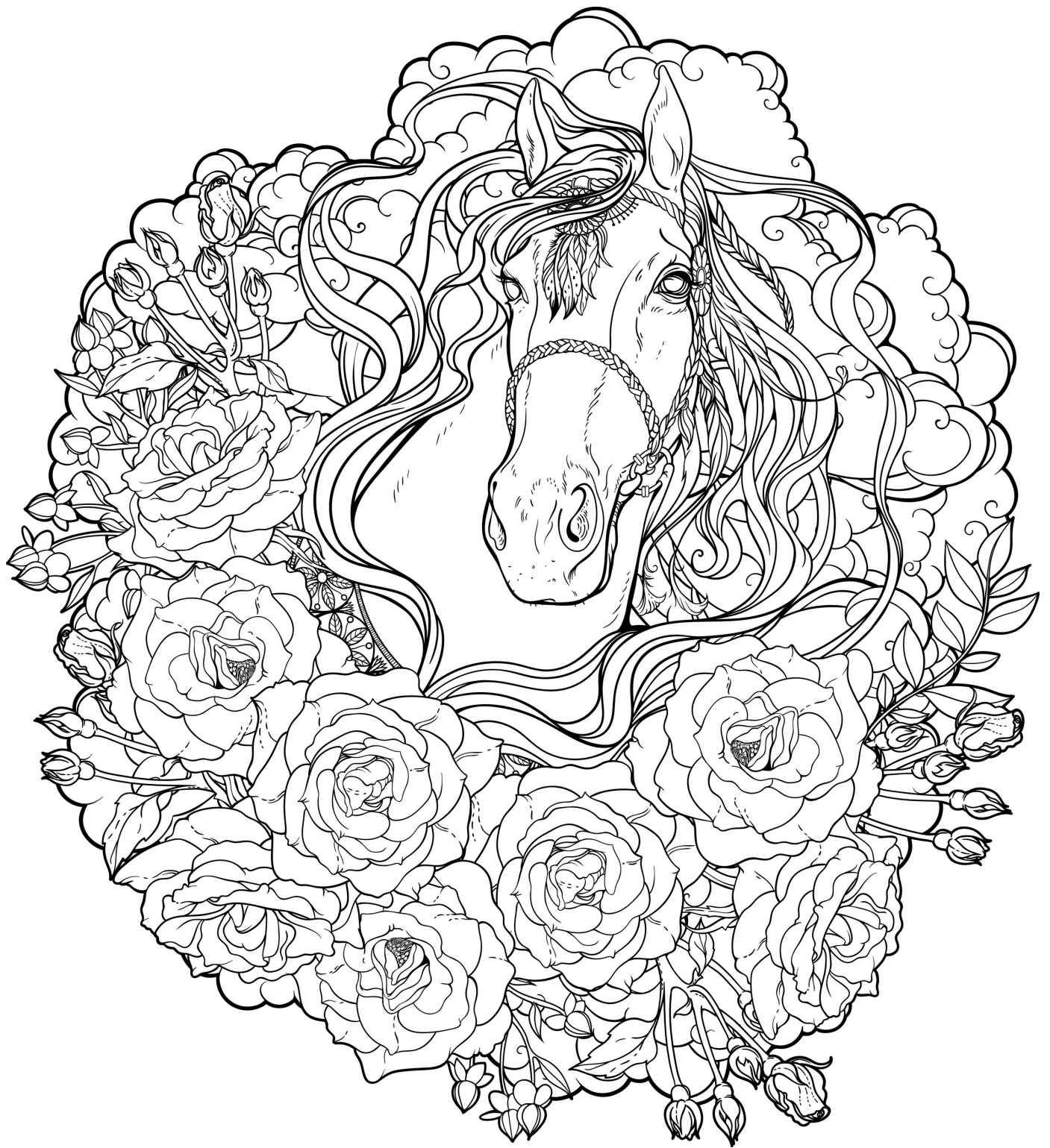
