The VFW was established on September 29, 1899, by a group of veterans from the Spanish-American War and the Philippine Insurrection. DID YOU KNOW?

Traffic James

The world's longest traffic jam, recorded in China in 2010, stretched for over 60 miles and lasted an astonishing 12 days. On a smaller scale, phantom traffic jams are often caused by a single driver braking unnecessarily, creating a ripple effect that slows cars miles behind. This phenomenon, known as a "traffic snake" or shockwave, can occur without any accident or obstruction, proving that the most significant cause of traffic is often just traffic itself.

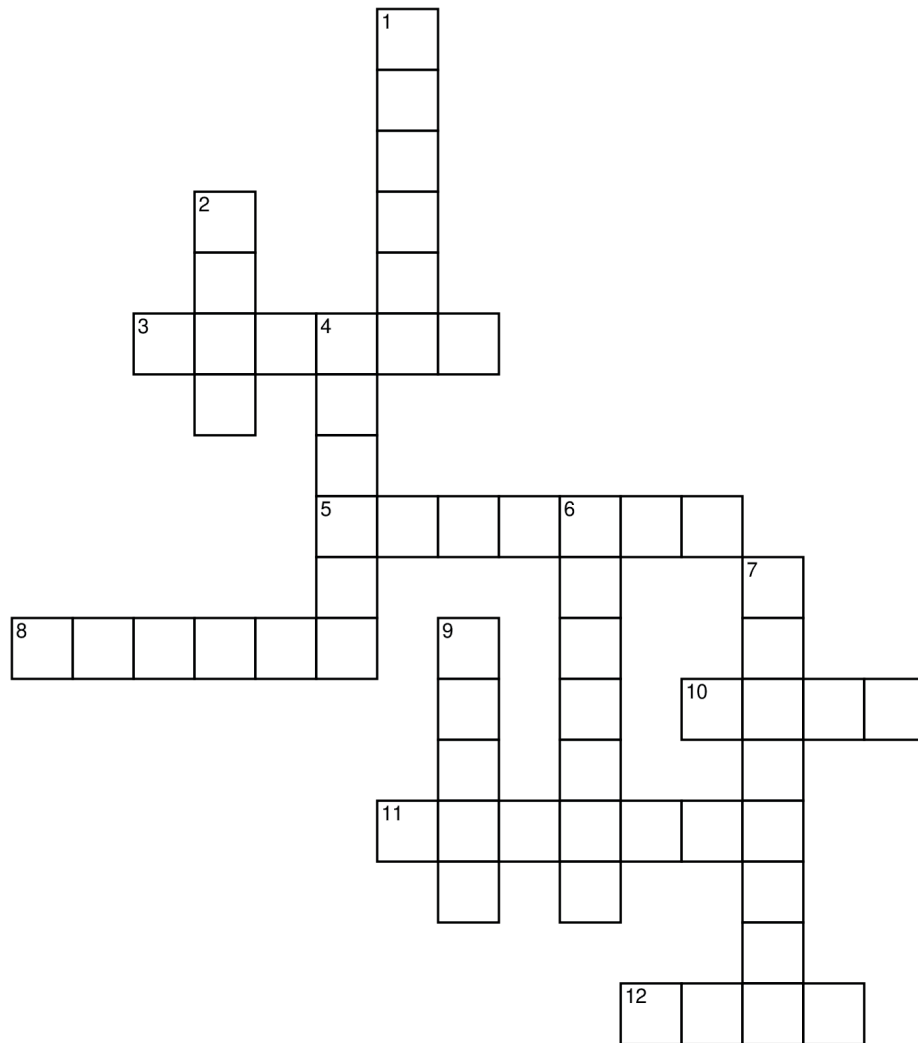

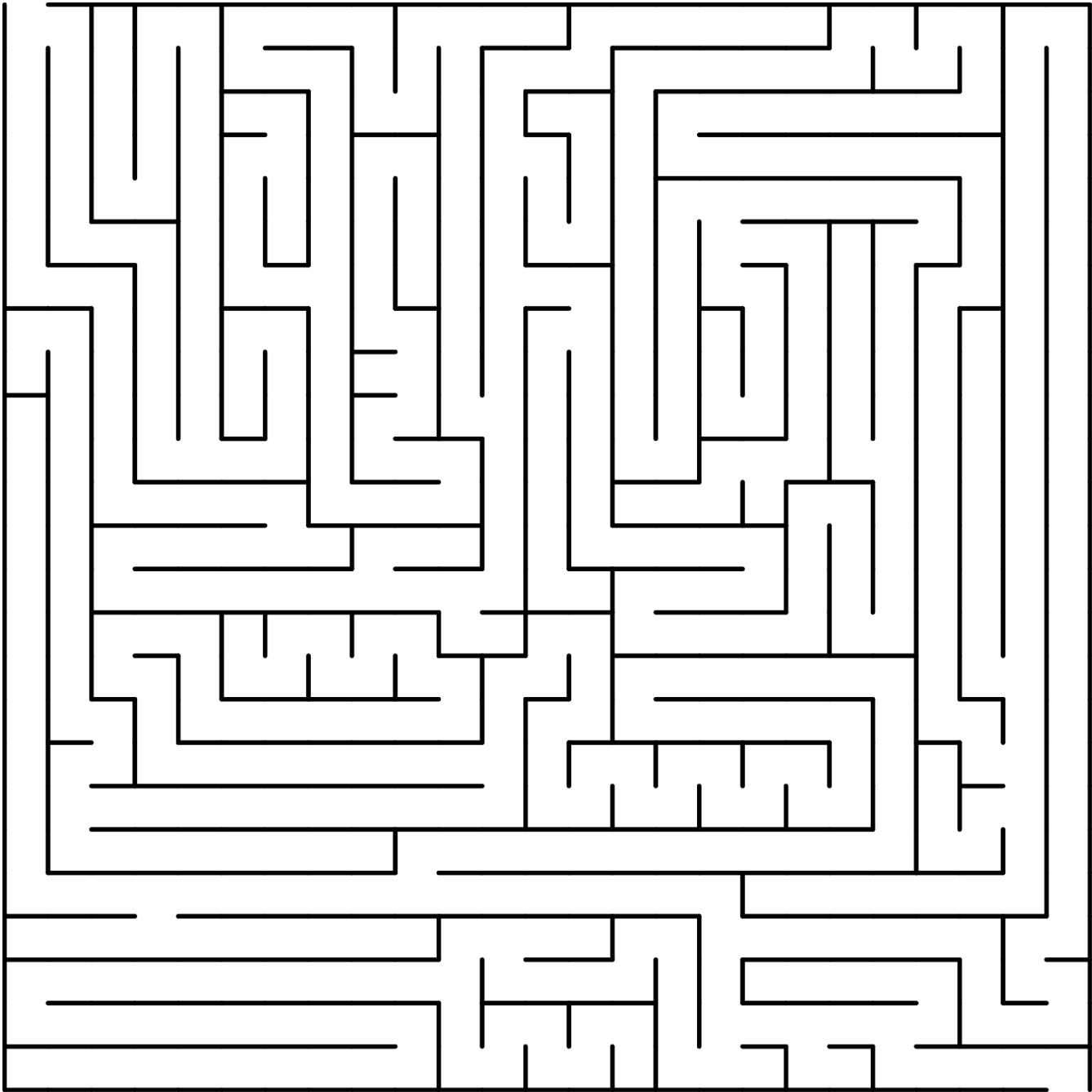
