St. Lucia is the only sovereign nation named after a woman, honoring St. Lucy of Syracuse, the patron saint of the blind. Initially called Louanalao by the Arawaks, it was named "Sainte Alousie" by French sailors who arrived on St. Lucy's feast day, December 13, which is now the National Day of St. Lucia. While female namesakes are rare for countries, Queen Victoria's name graces numerous locations worldwide.




