### **West Side Story's East Side Origins**

The original concept for West Side Story was quite different. Initially titled East Side Story, it was a modern retelling of Romeo and Juliet set in New York's Lower East Side, focusing on a conflict between an Irish Catholic boy and a Jewish girl during the Easter-Passover season. The project was shelved until news of rising gang violence in Los Angeles inspired a shift to the Upper West Side, featuring a white gang versus a Puerto Rican gang.




## Trivia Answer: D
