The iconic voice of James Earl Jones was once silenced by a severe childhood stutter, leaving him functionally mute for eight years. His life changed after he met his high school English teacher, Professor Donald Crouch. Crouch saw potential and encouraged Jones to read poetry aloud in class. 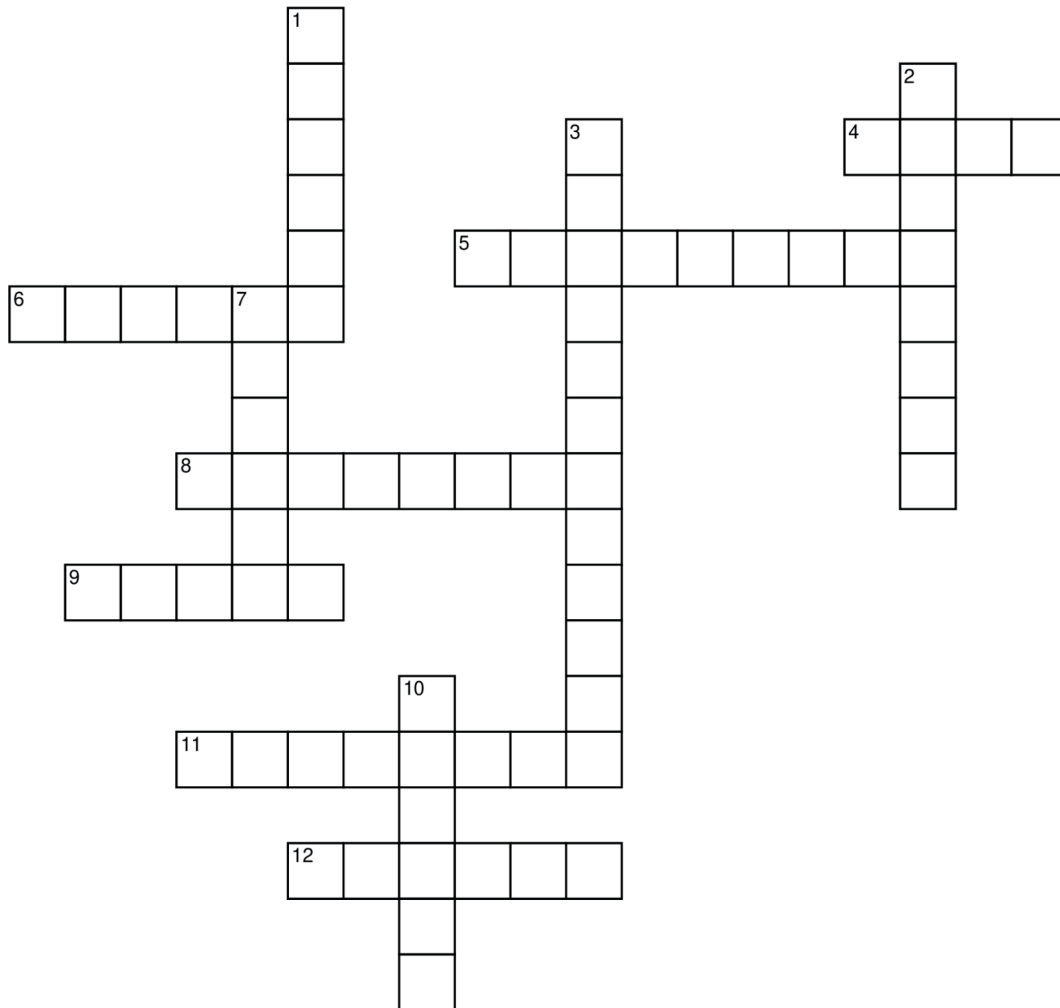

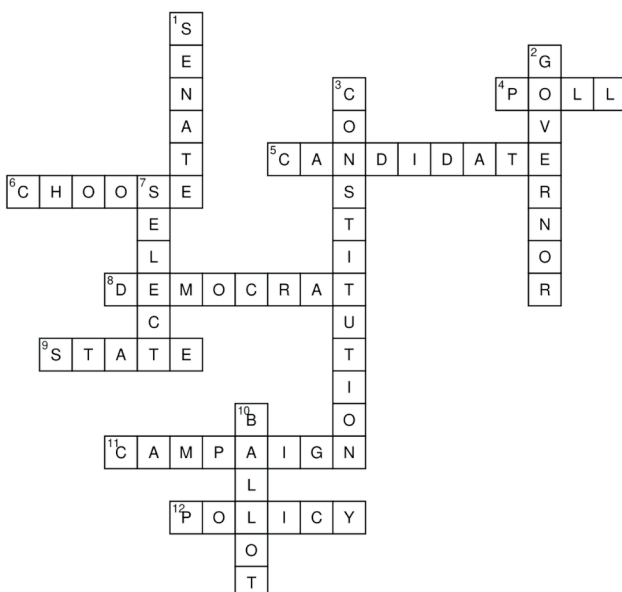
