### The Raw Truth

Though many think "steak tartare" links to the Tatar people who supposedly tenderized meat under their saddles, this is largely a myth. In reality, the dish earned its name from its accompaniment: tartar sauce. Originally known as "steak à l'Américaine" in early 20th-century France, it wasn't until a variation with tartar sauce was created that it transformed into "steak à la tartare," later shortened to the popular "steak tartare."






