Pins and Needles Day

Pins and Needles Day is celebrated on November 27th each year to commemorate the opening of the Broadway musical Pins and Needles in 1937. The International Ladies Garment Workers' Union produced the play, which was a pro-labor musical that ran for three years and 1,108 performances. The play's cast was made up of sewing machine workers, cutters, and basters who wanted to be creative in their free time.

The story is about a group of workers trying to keep their jobs during the American labor movement of the 1930s, which focused on wages, working conditions, and political expression. The play was so successful that the cast members were able to quit their jobs and perform the show full-time for eight weeks.



Today in History



In 1920, "The Mark of Zorro" was shown in New York. It was the first American superhero film and starred Douglas Fairbanks, who started acting as a teenager. He co-founded United Artists in 1919 and the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences in 1927, and retired from acting in 1934.

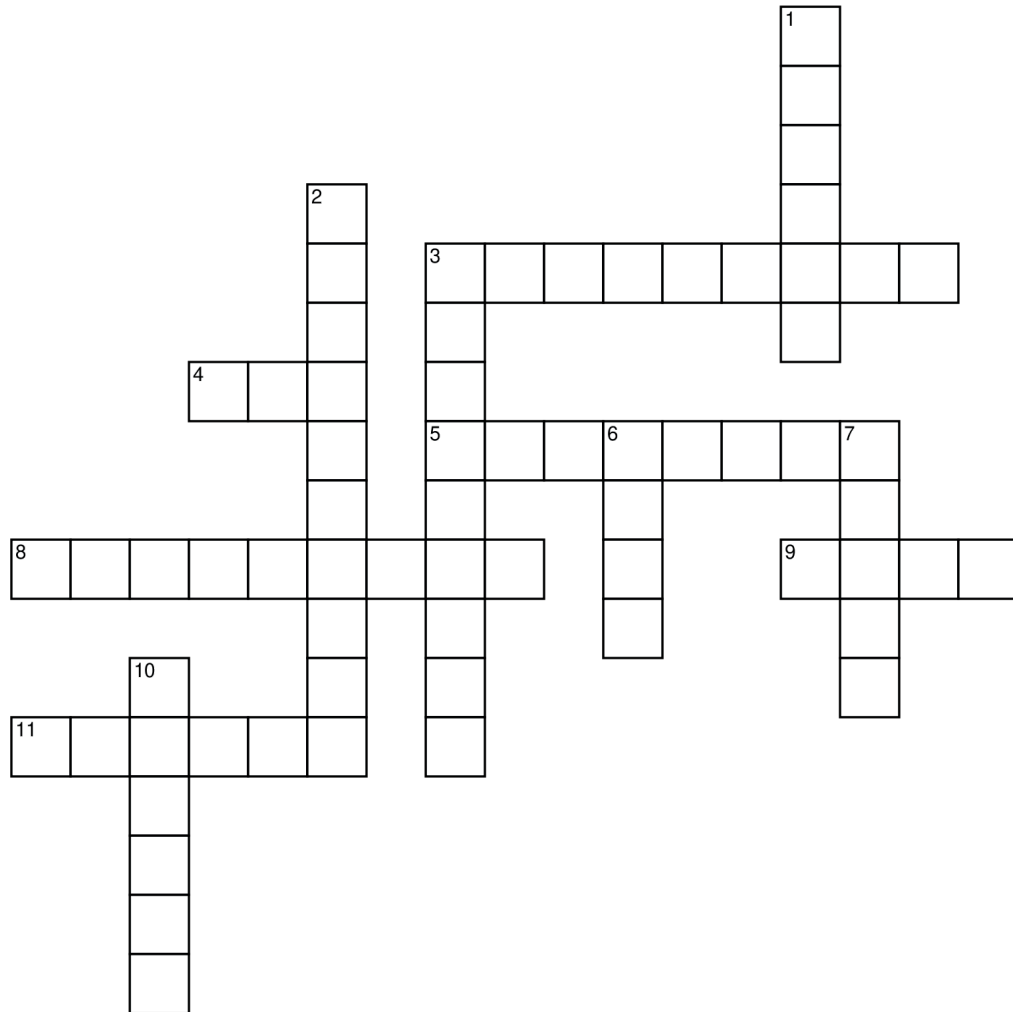

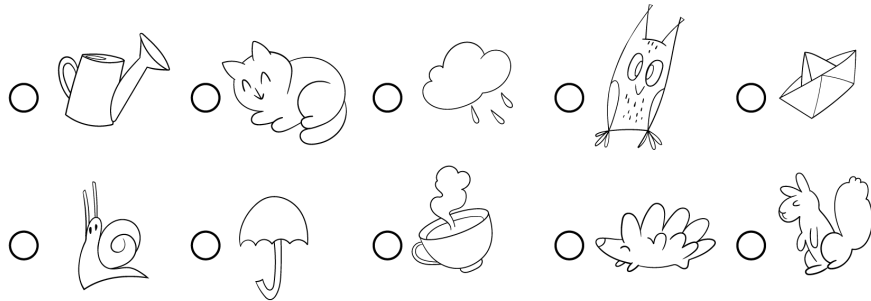

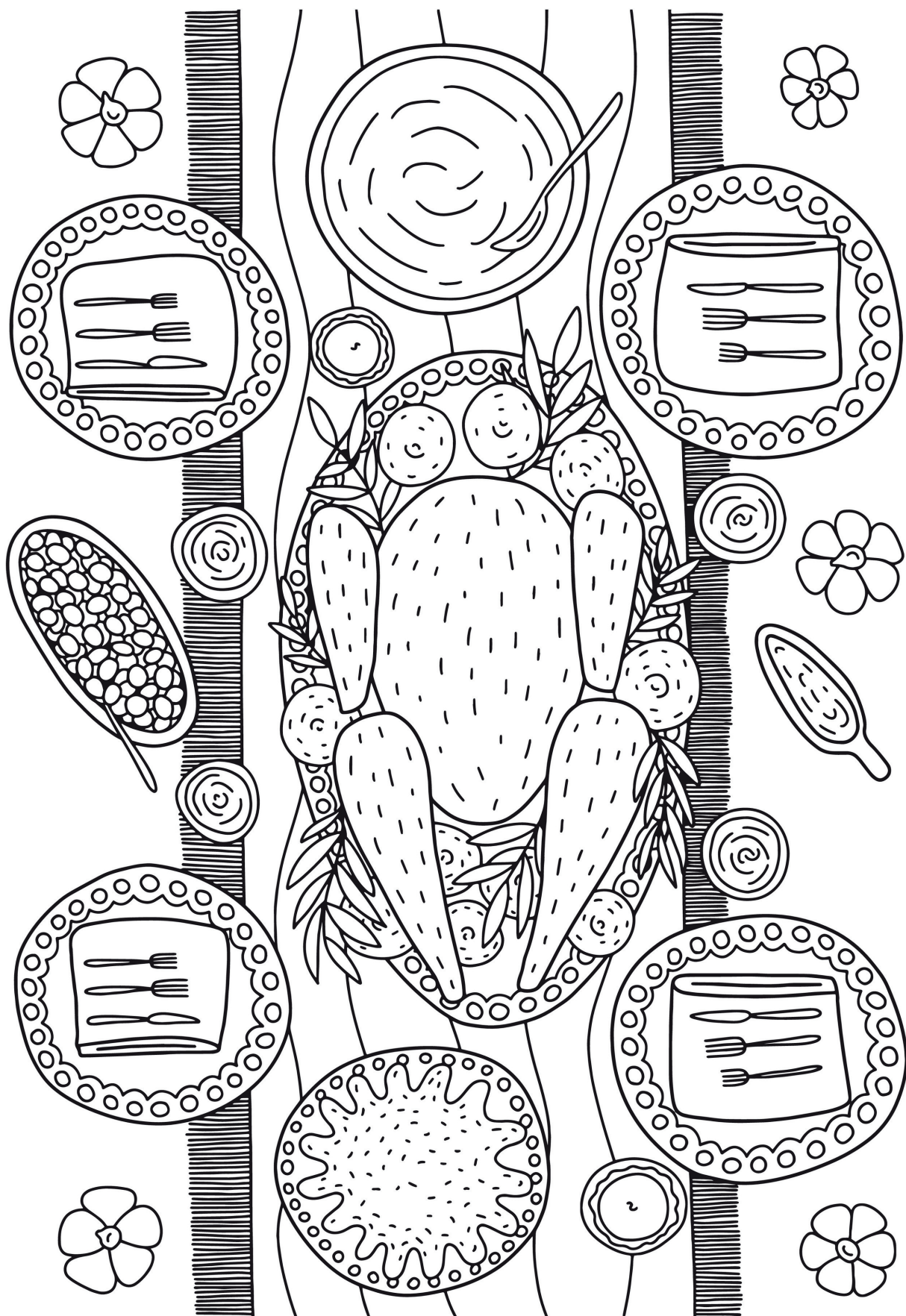
