



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DID YOU KNOW? **A Souper Power**

Did you know that blowing on hot food to cool it is a perfect example of applied physics? It's not just that your breath is cool; you're performing "forced convection." A hot bite creates an insulating blanket of steam and warm air above it, which slows cooling. By blowing, you forcefully replace that hot, stagnant layer with cooler, drier ambient air. This new air rapidly pulls more heat away, significantly speeding up the cooling process.




