

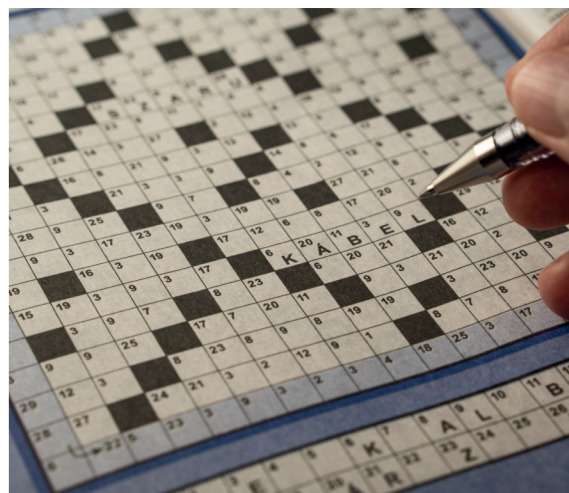

## Today in History



In 1968, Frank Borman, Jim Lovell, and William Anders were aboard Apollo 8, the first manned moon voyage. Borman was the commander of Apollo 8. The 3 astronauts orbited the moon ten times during the six-day mission. Borman became an executive at Eastern Airlines in 1970.

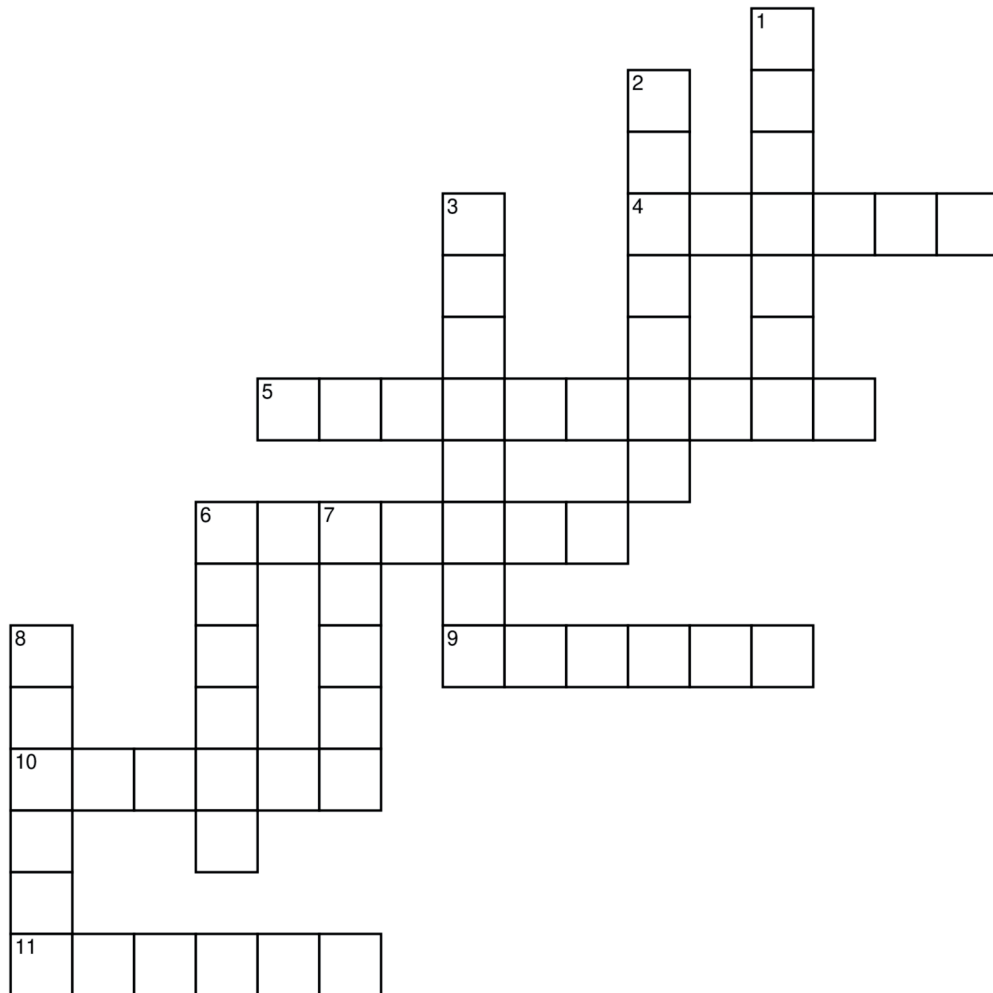
## Helpful Tip:

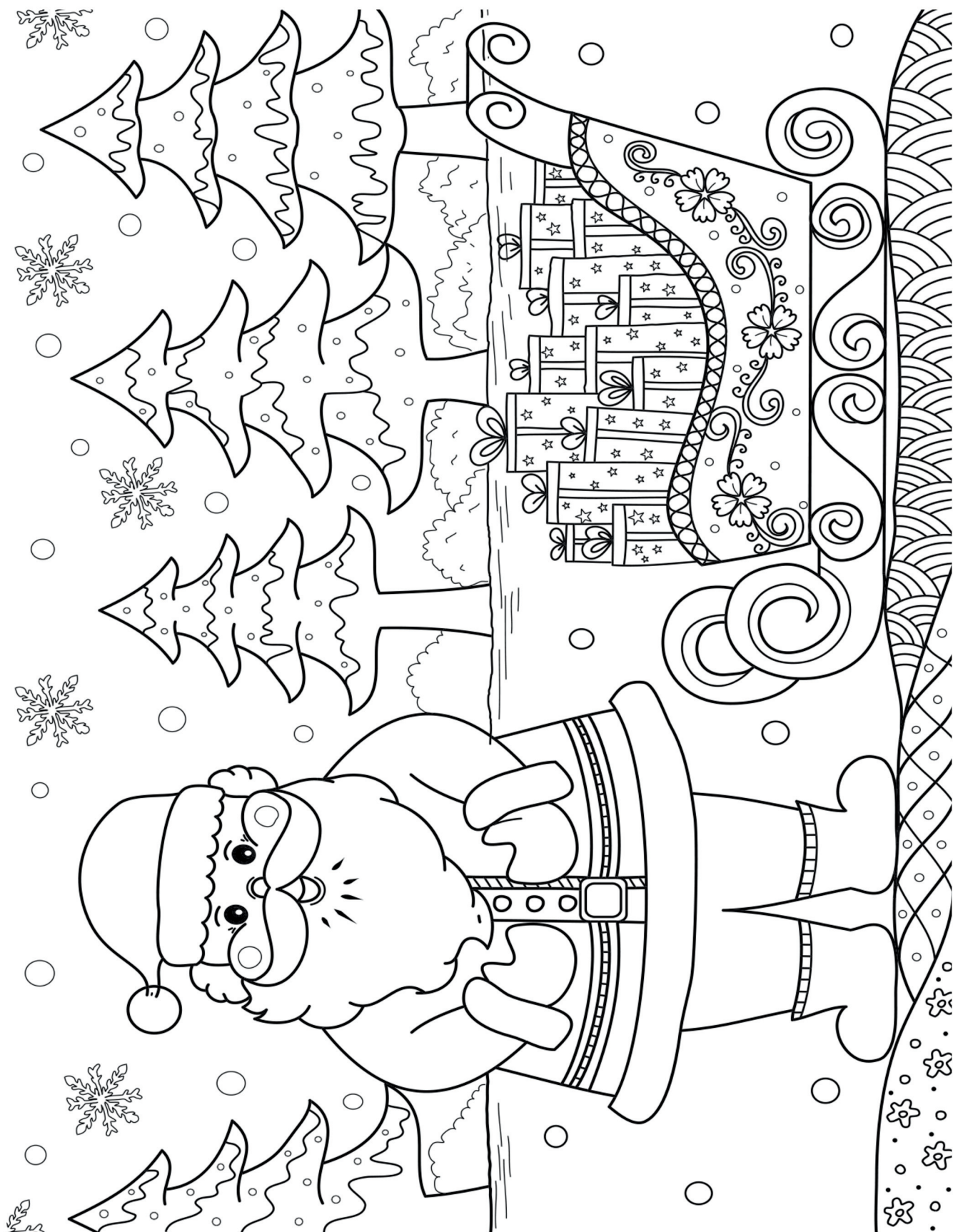
