

Types of Ecosystems





Trivia Answer: A. Franklin D. Roosevelt

Franklin D. Roosevelt was elected during the Great Depression. His unprecedented four terms prompted the ratification of the 22nd Amendment in 1951, which formally limits presidents to two terms in office.
