Each year on January 27th, the world remembers one of the most horrific events in modern history. From 1941 to 1945, Nazi Germany and its collaborators committed the systematic murder of over six million Jews, along with hundreds of thousands of others who were deemed to be enemies of the Nazi regime. 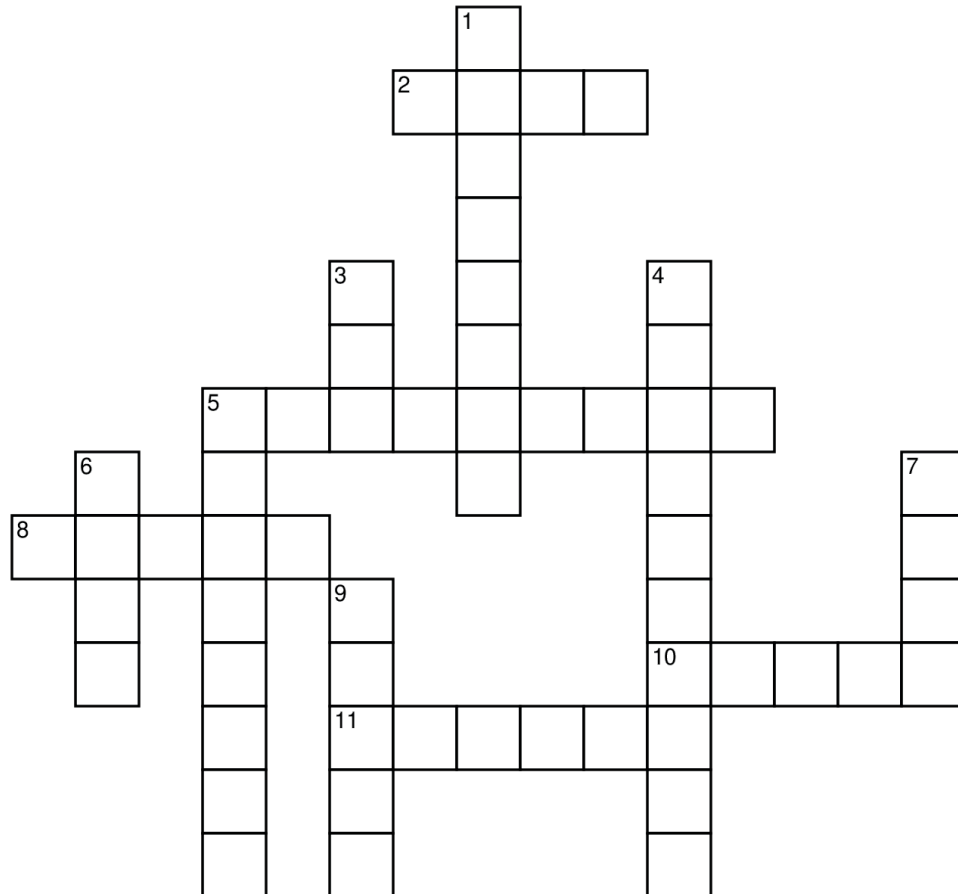
