### VP with a Hit Pop

Charles G. Dawes, a former U.S. Vice President and Nobel Peace Prize laureate, had an unexpected talent: songwriting. His 1911 instrumental piece, "Melody in A Major," later became the iconic song "It's All in the Game." Covered by artists like Tommy Edwards, Nat King Cole, Elton John, and Van Morrison, this song remains a popular standard. Dawes is the only U.S. President or Vice President to have a No. 1 hit song.




