In 1936, Daytona Beach Road Course held its first oval stock car race. Local racer Sig Haugdahl was asked to organize and promote the race. It was a 3.2-mile course, and the race was stopped after 72 of 78 laps. The \$1,700 prize went to Milt Marion.

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DID YOU KNOW?

Doorstop to Dollars

The initial gold rush in America did not occur in California but in North Carolina. A 12-year-old discovered a 17-pound gold nugget in a creek near Charlotte. His father used the rock as a doorstop. In 1802, a jeweler assessed it, and the father set a price for what he believed was a high sum of \$3.50, but the nugget's actual value was around \$3,600. By 1803, he had established the first gold mining operation in North Carolina.




