History of the Maid

The Maid of the Mist is a sightseeing boat tour of Niagara Falls, starting and ending on the American side, crossing briefly into Canada during a portion of the trip. The first Maid of the Mist steamboat was large enough to carry a stagecoach and horses. In 1848, the construction of a suspension bridge curtailed business, and the Maid of the Mist was re-branded as a sightseeing adventure that still operates to this day.

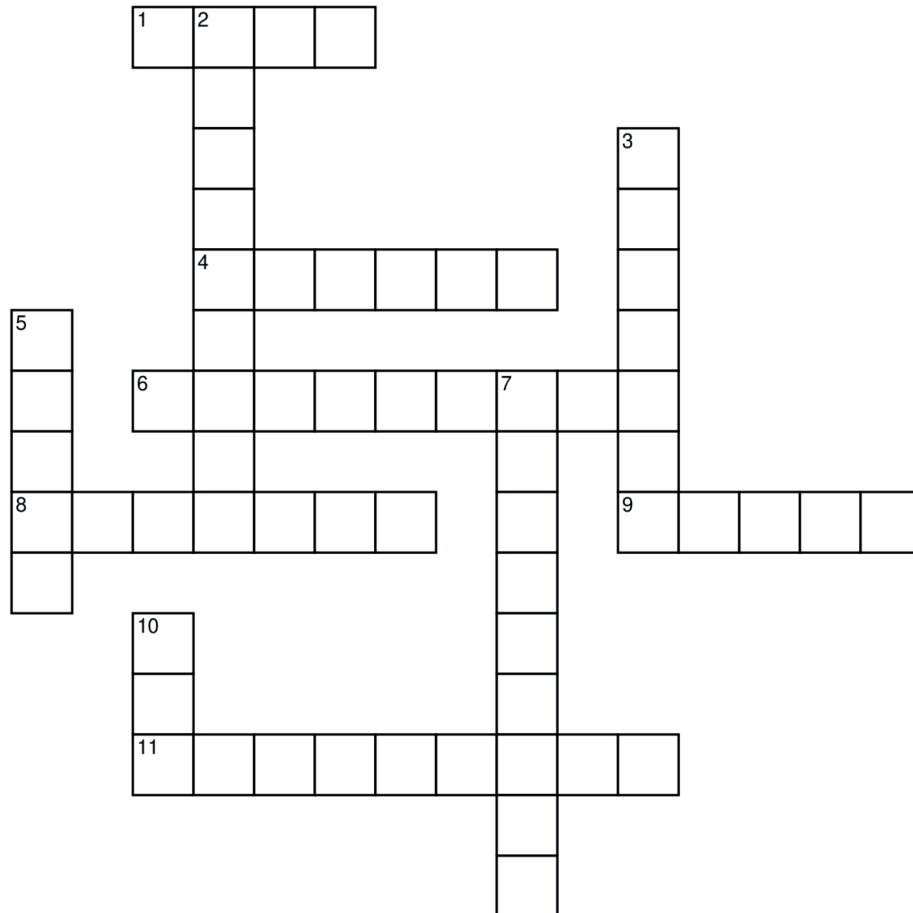

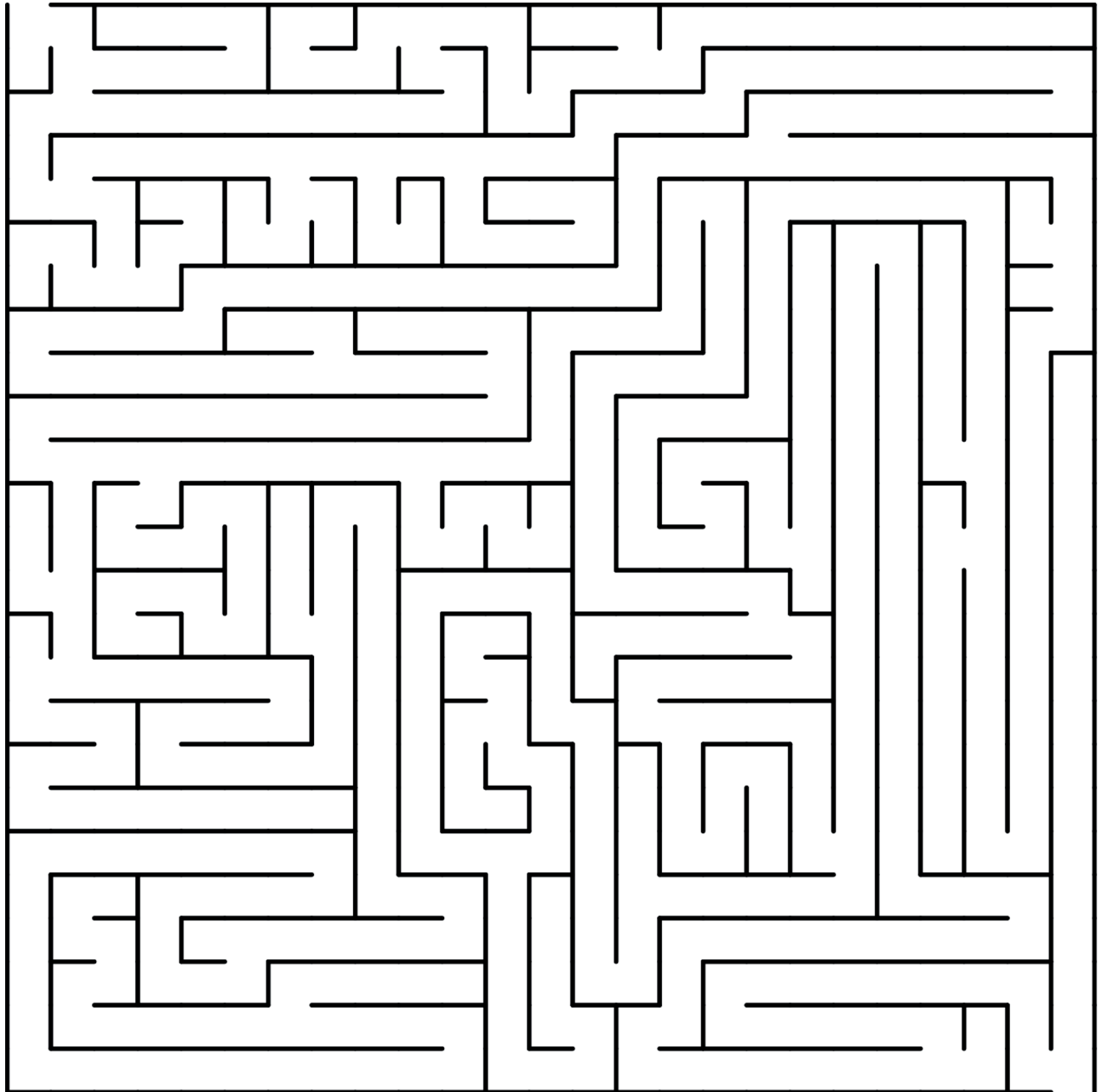
