National Winston Churchill Day

On April 9th, 1963, former British Prime Minister Winston Churchill was made an honorary citizen of the United States by President John F. Kennedy. Although Churchill was not present at the ceremony, his son and grandson attended. It's interesting to note that Churchill's mother, Jennie Jerome, was an American who married Lord Randolph Churchill.

Churchill was well-known for his leadership as Prime Minister of the United Kingdom during World War II, and he earned his reputation through experience in both politics and the military. This was the first time in U.S. history that an honorary citizenship was granted, and since then, seven other honorary citizenships have been awarded.

In 1962, Rita Moreno became the first Hispanic Woman to win an Oscar for her role of Anita in “West Side Story.” Moreno landed her first Broadway role at the age of 13 and had a supporting role in “The King and I,” which won five Academy Awards in 1956.

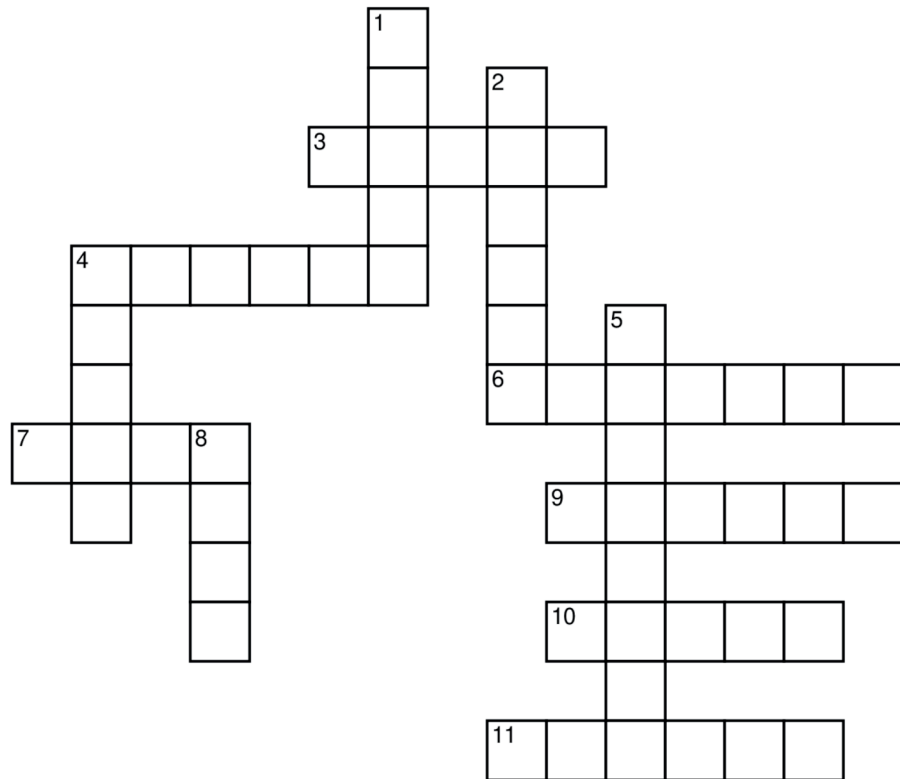

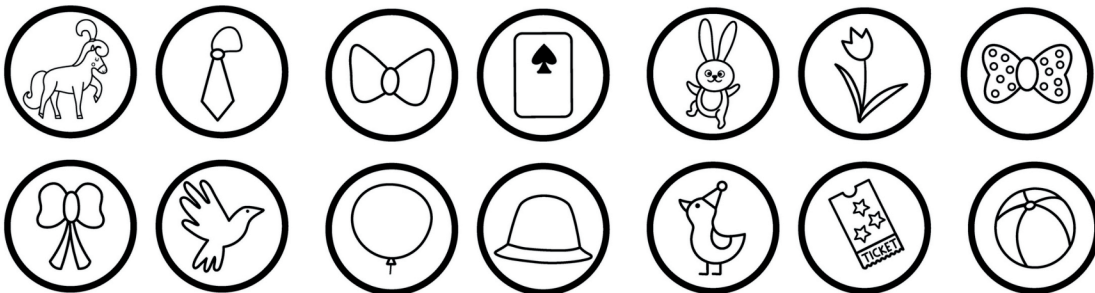
