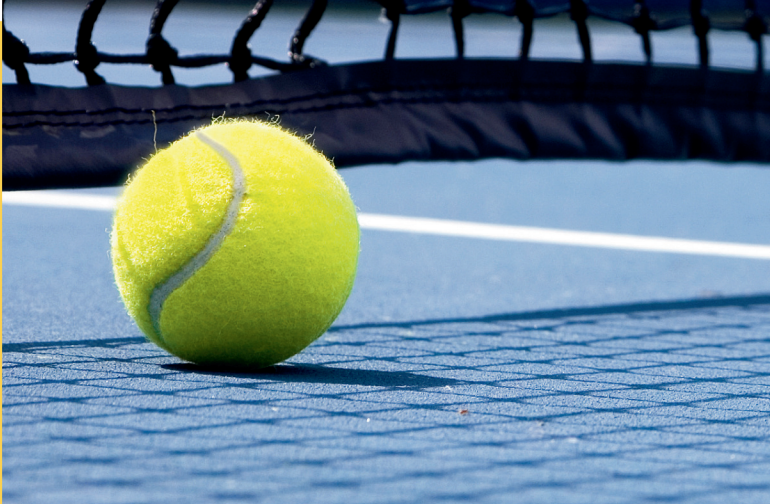


Today in History



In 1872, Victoria Woodhull became the 1st woman nominated for U.S. President by the Equal Rights Party. She was an activist for women's rights, labor reforms, and the freedom to marry, divorce, and bear children without government interference.

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DID YOU KNOW? **Why Tennis Balls are Yellow**

Color television became popular in the 1970s, and many people upgraded their TV sets. To make tennis more visible on TV, neon-yellow balls were introduced in 1972. The International Tennis Federation found the bright shade of yellow made it easier for viewers to follow. Wimbledon, the oldest tennis tournament, didn't switch to yellow for another 14 years, despite being broadcast in color since 1967.

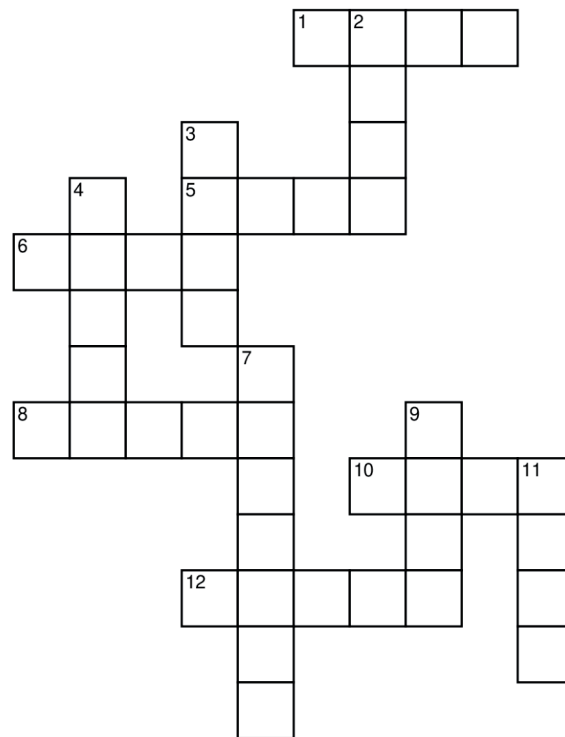

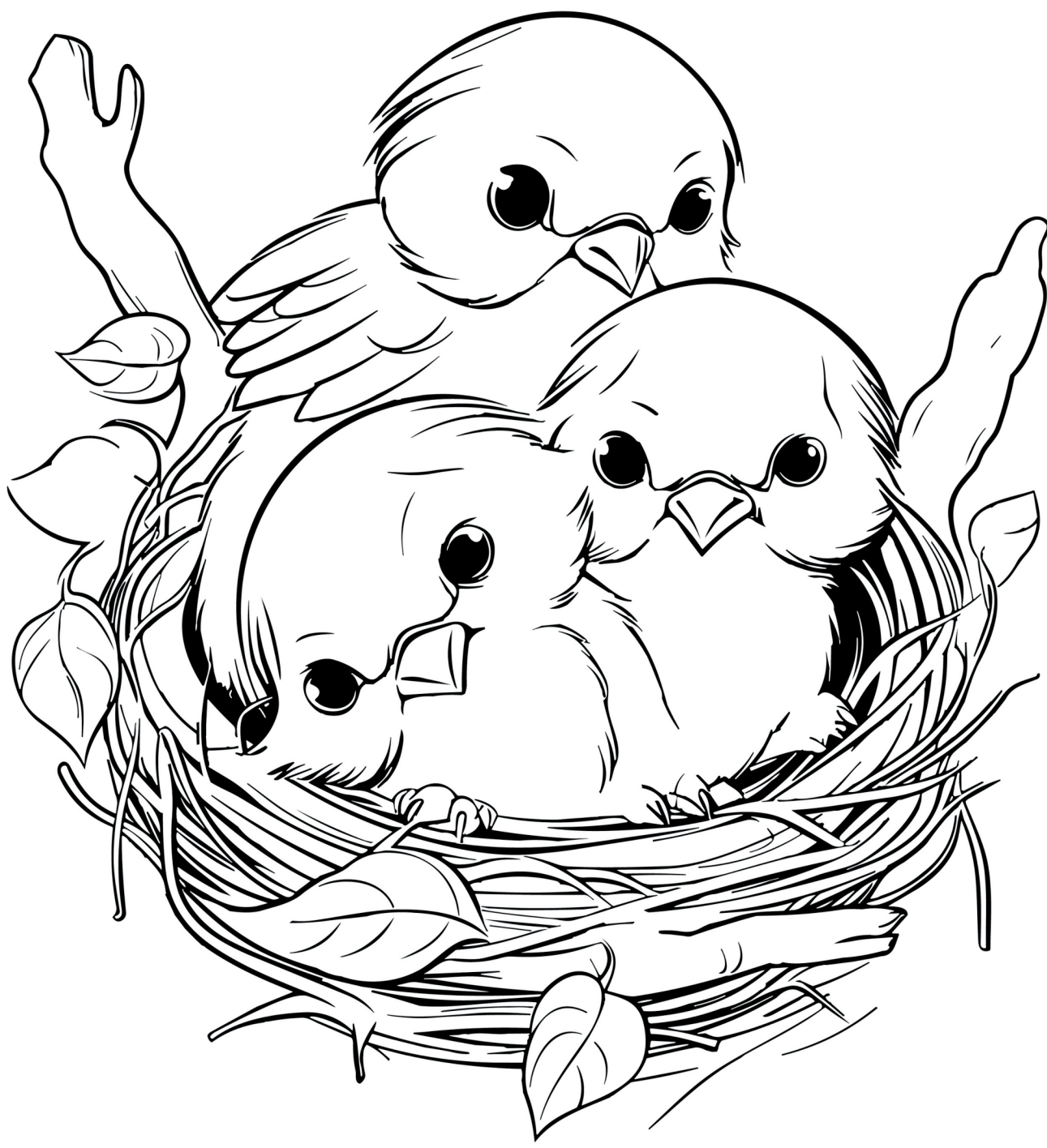

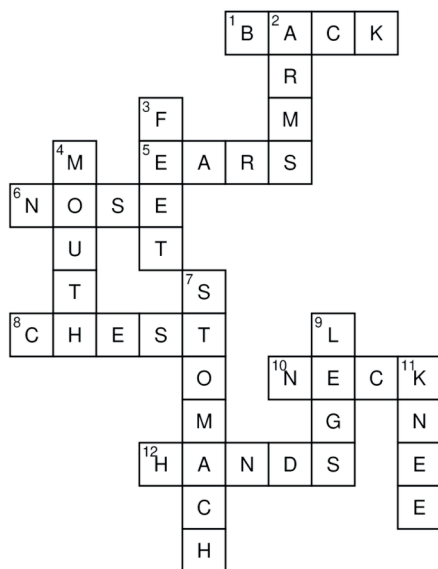
