DID YOU KNOW? When Davy Crockett Tackled a Would-Be Assassin

Davy Crockett, a Tennessee congressman, helped to subdue an assassin at the Capitol Building in 1835 during President Andrew Jackson's visit to attend a funeral. Despite their political differences, Crockett came to Jackson's aid along with several other men, and they were able to stop the would-be killer. Crockett later remarked that he was glad to have witnessed the event and seen the "damnedest villain in the world."

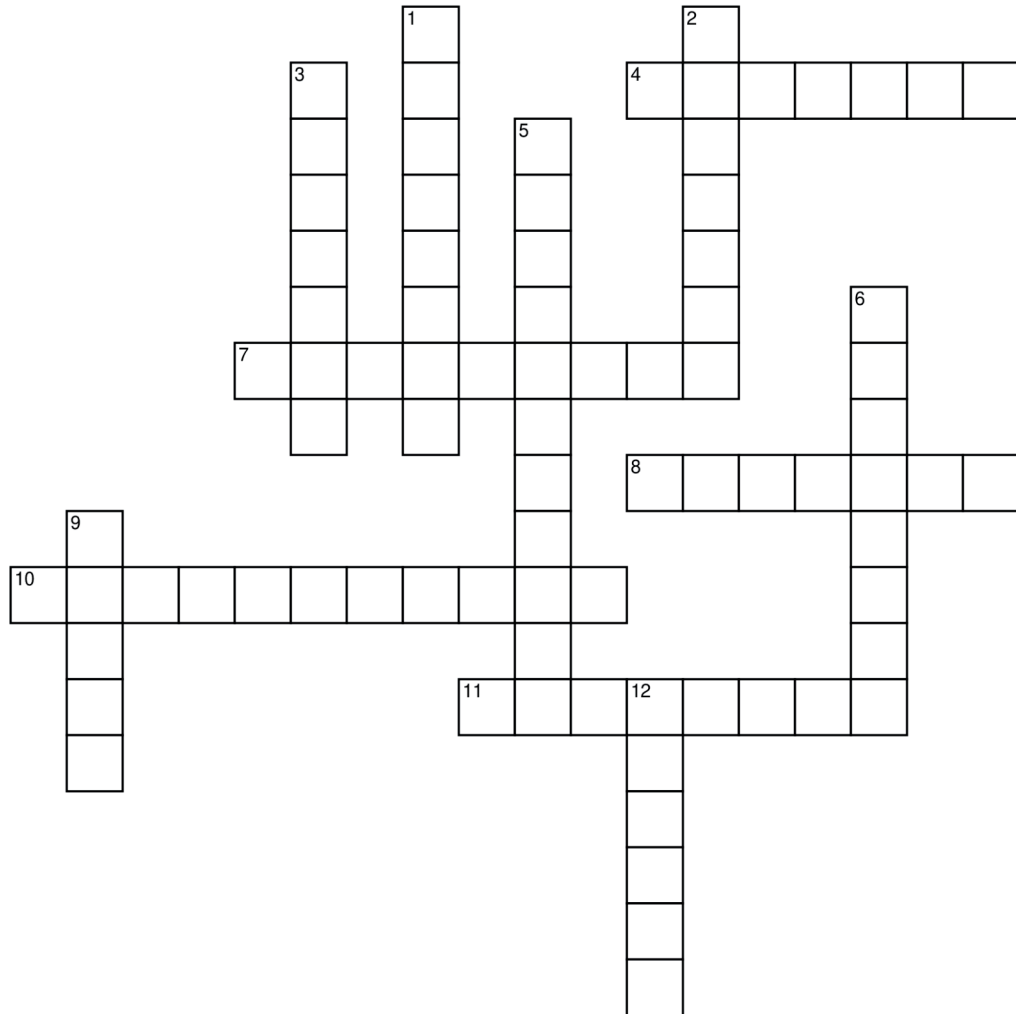

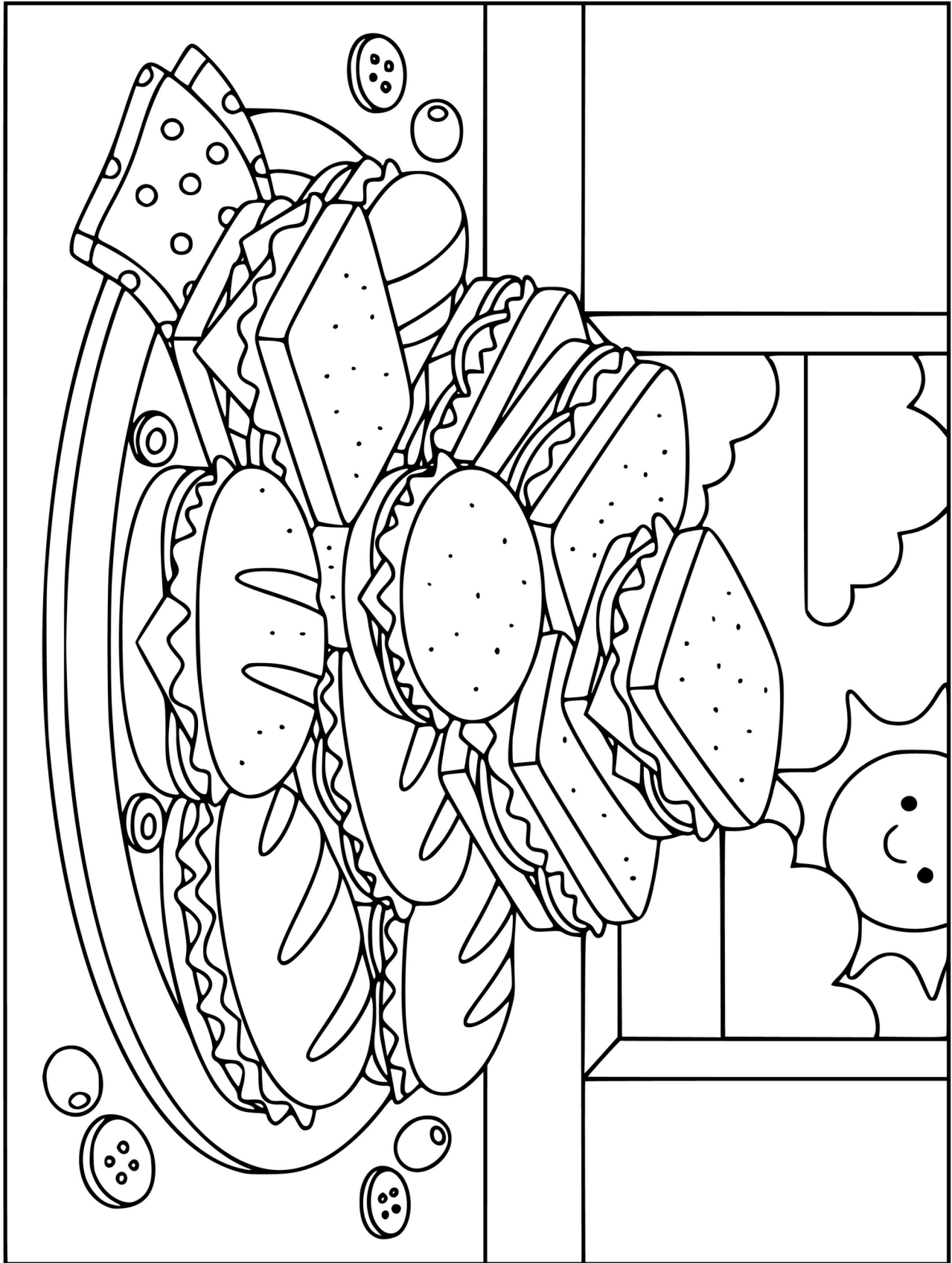

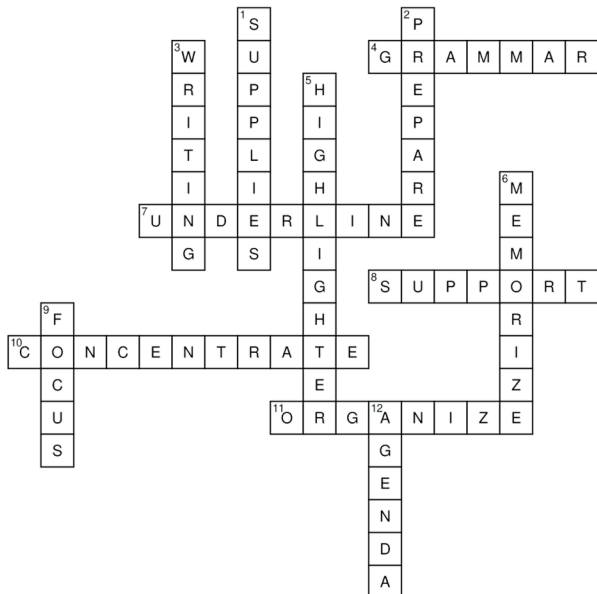
Trivia Answer: B.
