Cave and Karst Day

Explorers love June 6 because it is Caves and Karst Day! Founded in 2017, in the United States, this day highlights the natural wonders found in caves. Caves offer exciting opportunities for exploration and are home to diverse plant and animal species. Are you unsure what a “karst” is? Karsts form through erosion in certain types of rock, like limestone, creating towers, ridges, sinkholes, fissures, and other dramatic landforms.

Some of the best-known caves in the United States include Mammoth Cave in Kentucky, Antelope Canyon in Arizona (which features a brightly colored slot cave), and Carlsbad Caverns in New Mexico, which boasts more than 100 caves. Tennessee has over 10,000 subterranean caves ripe for exploration, featuring waterfalls, underground lakes, and stunning land formations.

DID YOU KNOW?

Not in the Kitchen Anymore

Before commercial butter production, people made butter at home by churning cream. The most commonly used household butter churn was the hand-crank butter churn, introduced in the mid-19th century and remained in use until the 1940s. The Dazey Churn & Manufacturing Company introduced glass churns in the early 20th century, which could make smaller quantities of butter much faster than the larger, time-intensive churns. After churning, butter could be poured or pressed into decorative molds for serving.

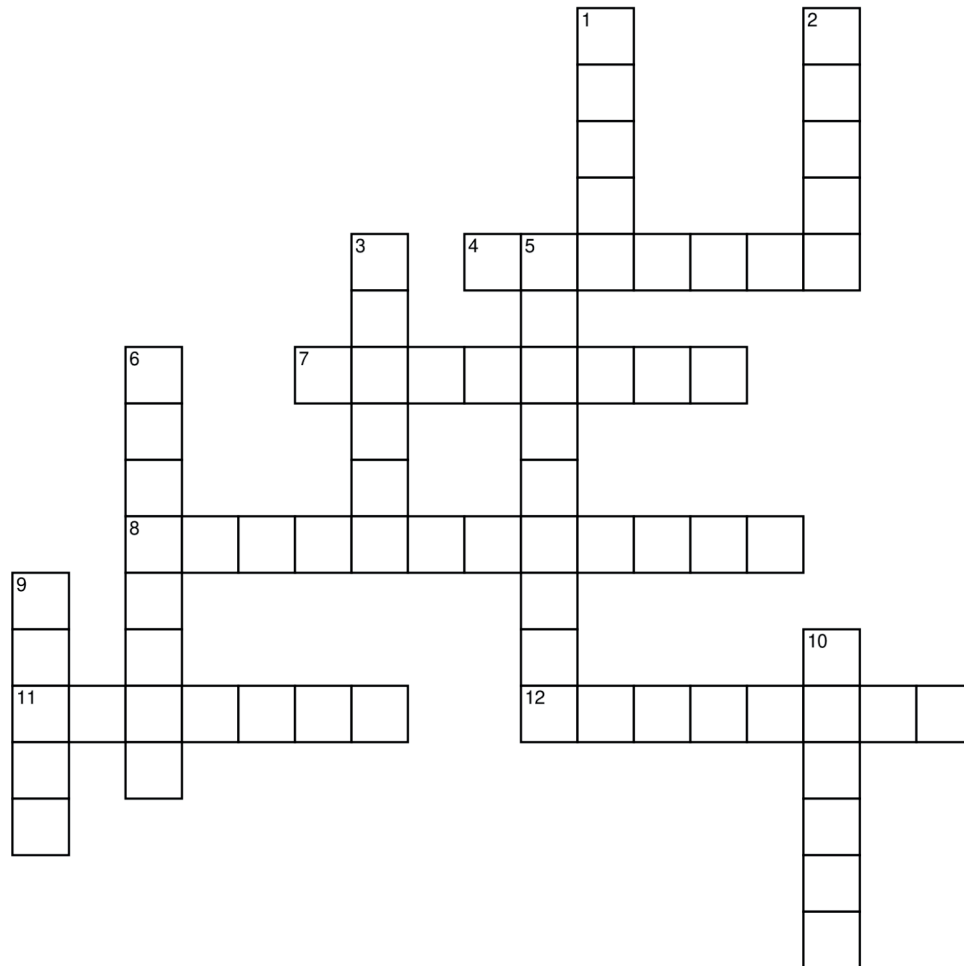

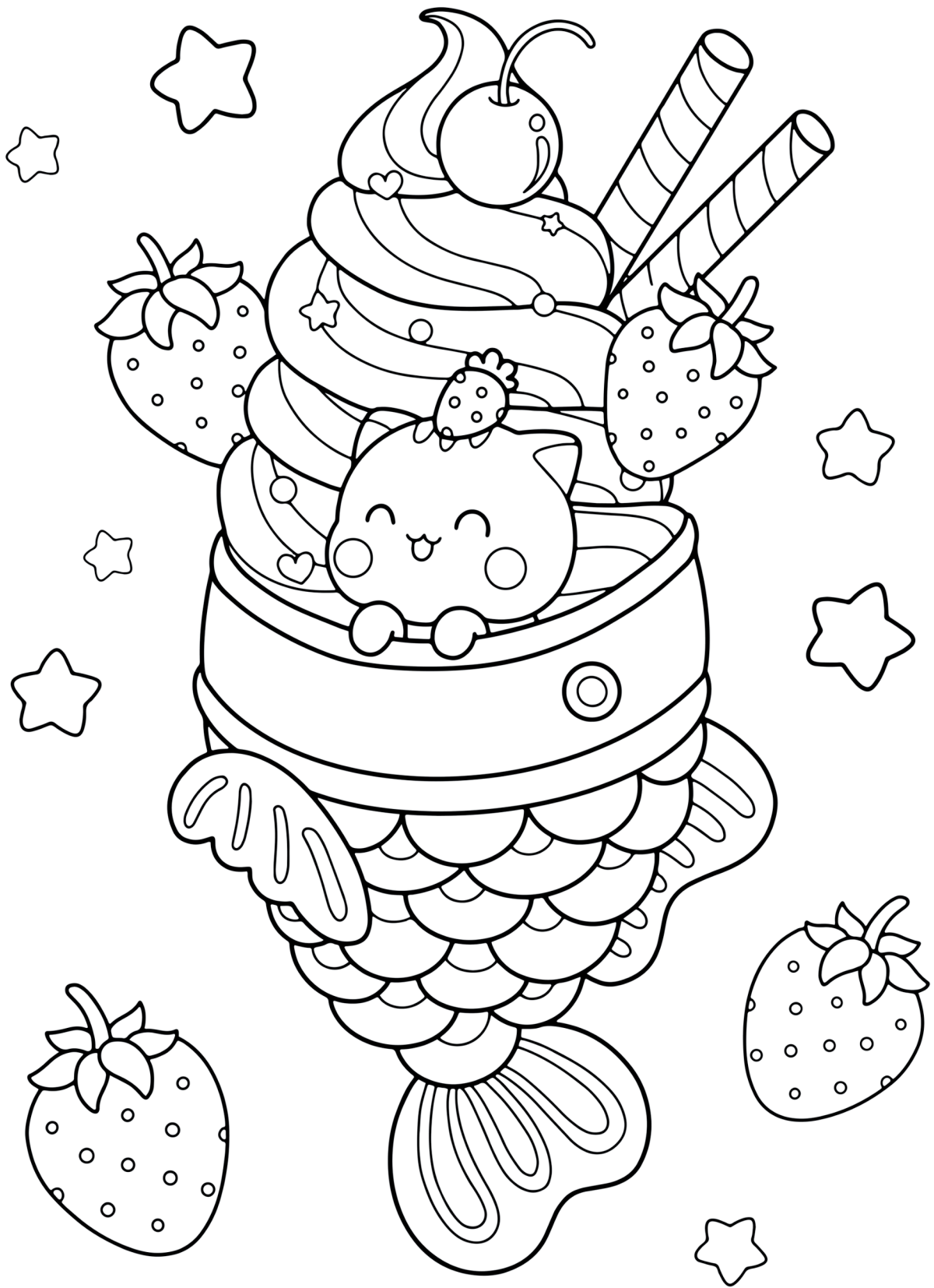
