## First Color TV Broadcast

It's hard to believe, but once upon a time, television was only broadcast in black and white. Like Dorothy walking out of her Kansas home into the magical land of OZ, June 25th, 1951, was the very first color television broadcast, and TV has never been the same. Arthur Godfrey hosted a variety show called "Premier," the first show to be broadcast on television in glorious color. While only five East Coast cities were the recipients of this historical achievement, the introduction of color TV to households wasn't far behind.

By the 1960s, more and more homes had color television sets, and by the 1970s, color TVs finally outsold black and white TV units. It's amazing how things have changed in fewer than 100 years!

In 1929, President Herbert Hoover authorized the building of the Boulder Dam, which was later named Hoover Dam. It was one of several mass public construction projects that happened during the Great Depression. Located near Boulder City, Nevada, it impounds Lake Mead.

Believe it or not, 200,000 day-old chicks travel via the postal service annually! These tiny travelers survive without food or water by absorbing their nutrient-dense yolks just before hatching. 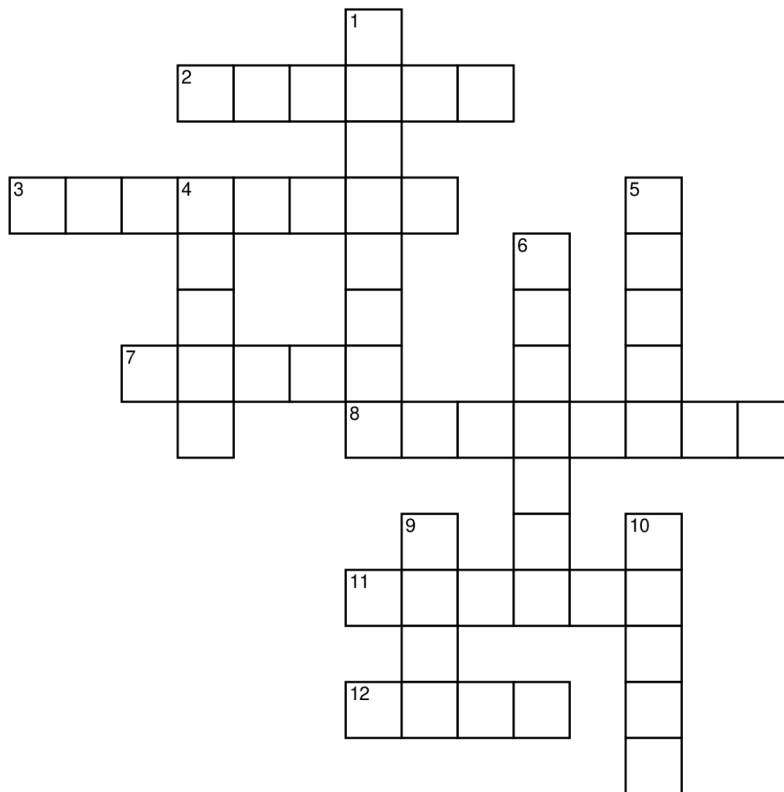

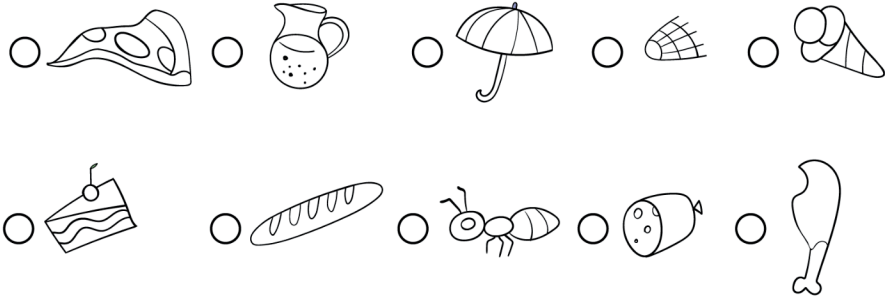

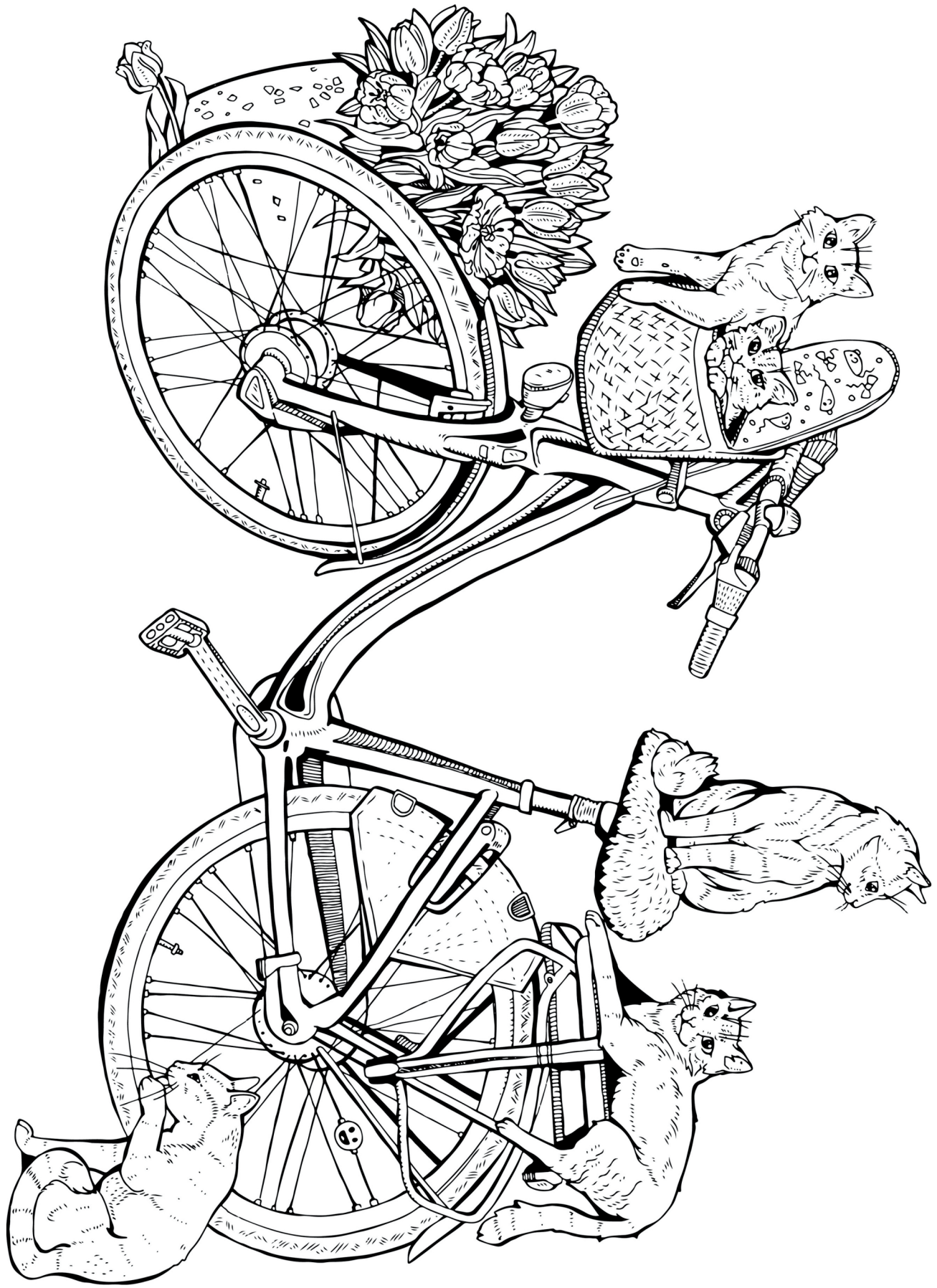
