Coral Triangle Day

The Coral Triangle is a marine region ranging from the Philippines and Malaysia to the Solomon Islands. This region is home to at least 500 species of reef-building corals. In fact, around 75% of the world's coral species are found in the Coral Triangle, giving it the highest coral diversity in the world. You can also find 6 of the world's 7 marine turtle species in the Coral Triangle. The region's fast population and economic growth have brought new pressures on the Coral Triangle. Coral Triangle Day was initiated to raise awareness and support for ocean conservation. To celebrate this day, spread the word about conservation efforts and organizations, and take some time to learn more about the importance of our world's coral reefs and the threats they face from climate change, pollution, and more.

Once kept on the dressing table in the Victorian era to store hair as it was removed from brushes and combs. The hair was recycled mostly for stuffing small bags that were called ratts (and this is how it was spelled) and used to bulk out women's hairstyles. 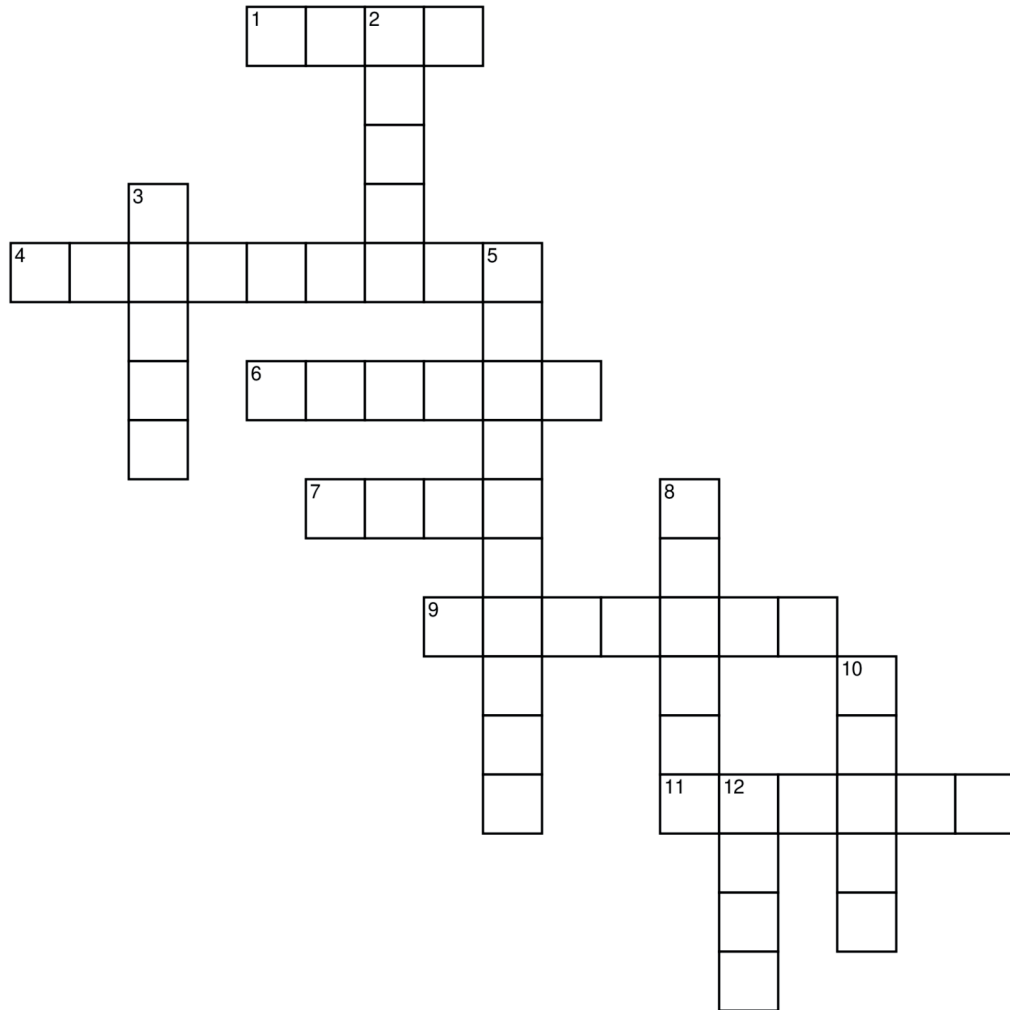

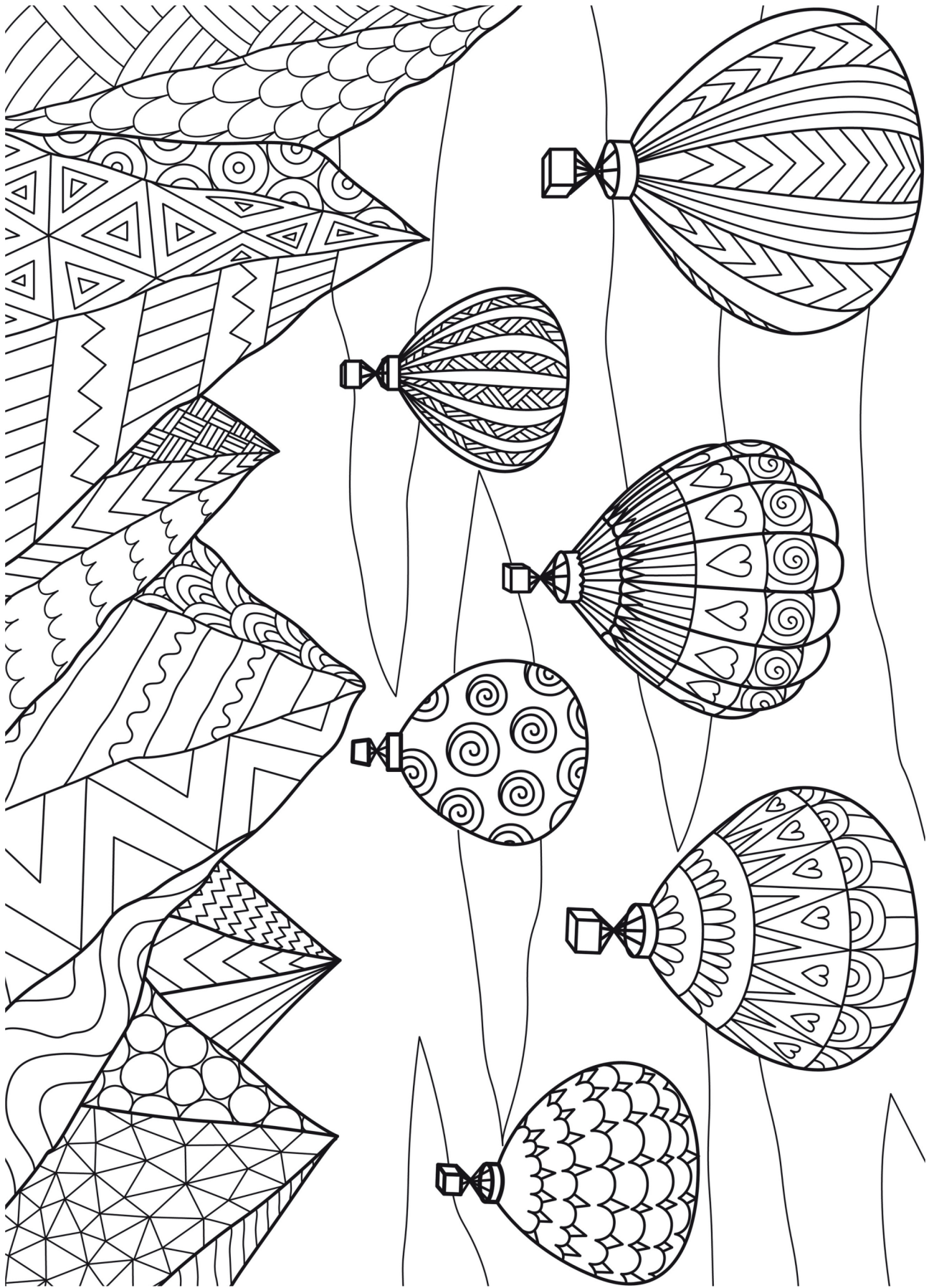
Use the following conversation prompts to start a discussion with friends or family! You may also use the provided lines to answer the questions on your own if you prefer.
