Moxie Soda

Moxie was originally developed in 1876 as a medicinal syrup from gentian root extract. It was later mixed with carbonated water and bottled as a soft drink, which became an immediate success. The drink became an indelible part of early-20th-century pop culture, with figures like Calvin Coolidge and Ted Williams endorsing it. Today, Moxie is largely obscure except in the New England region, where it originated, and is celebrated with a Moxie Day festival in Maine.

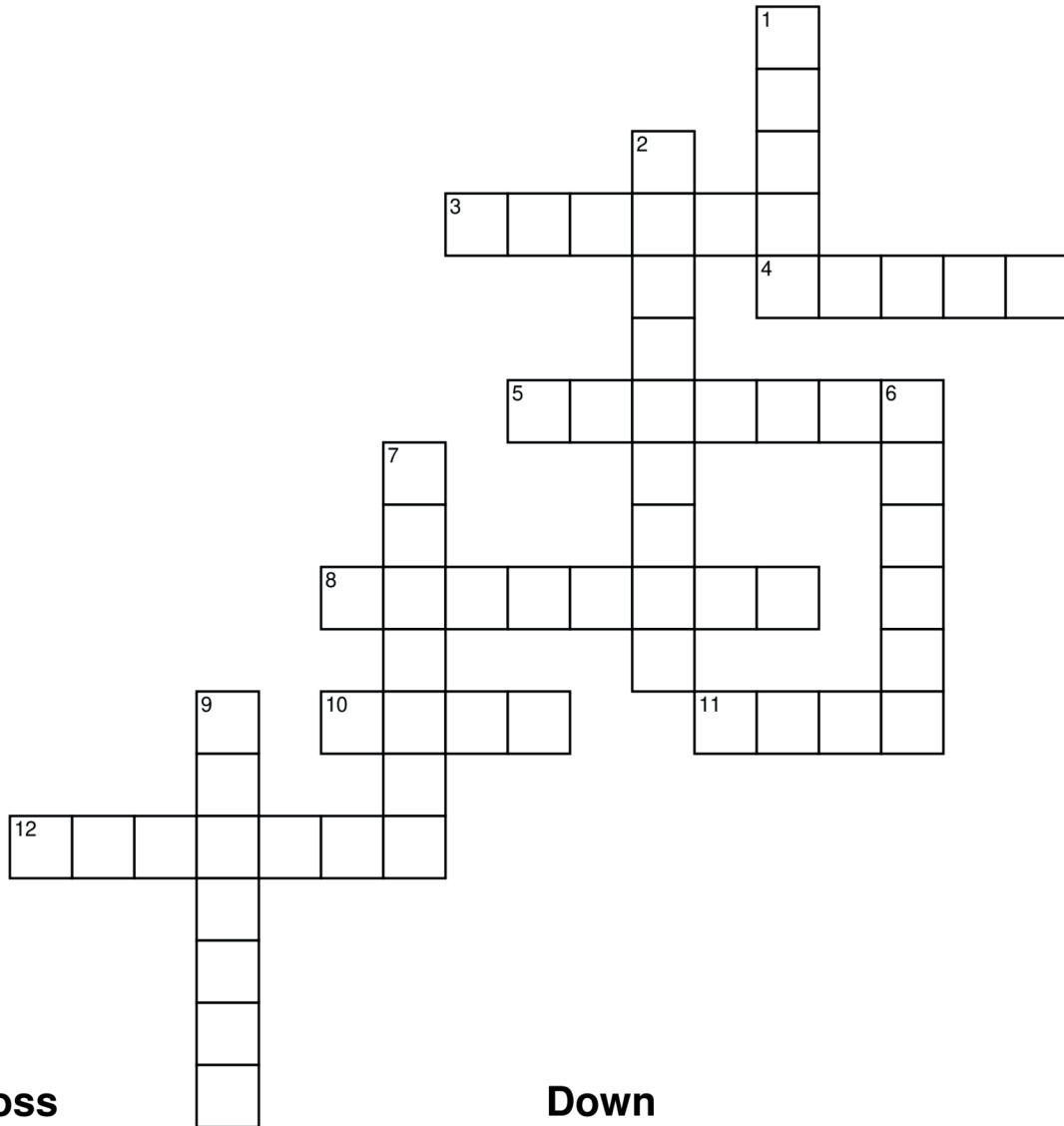

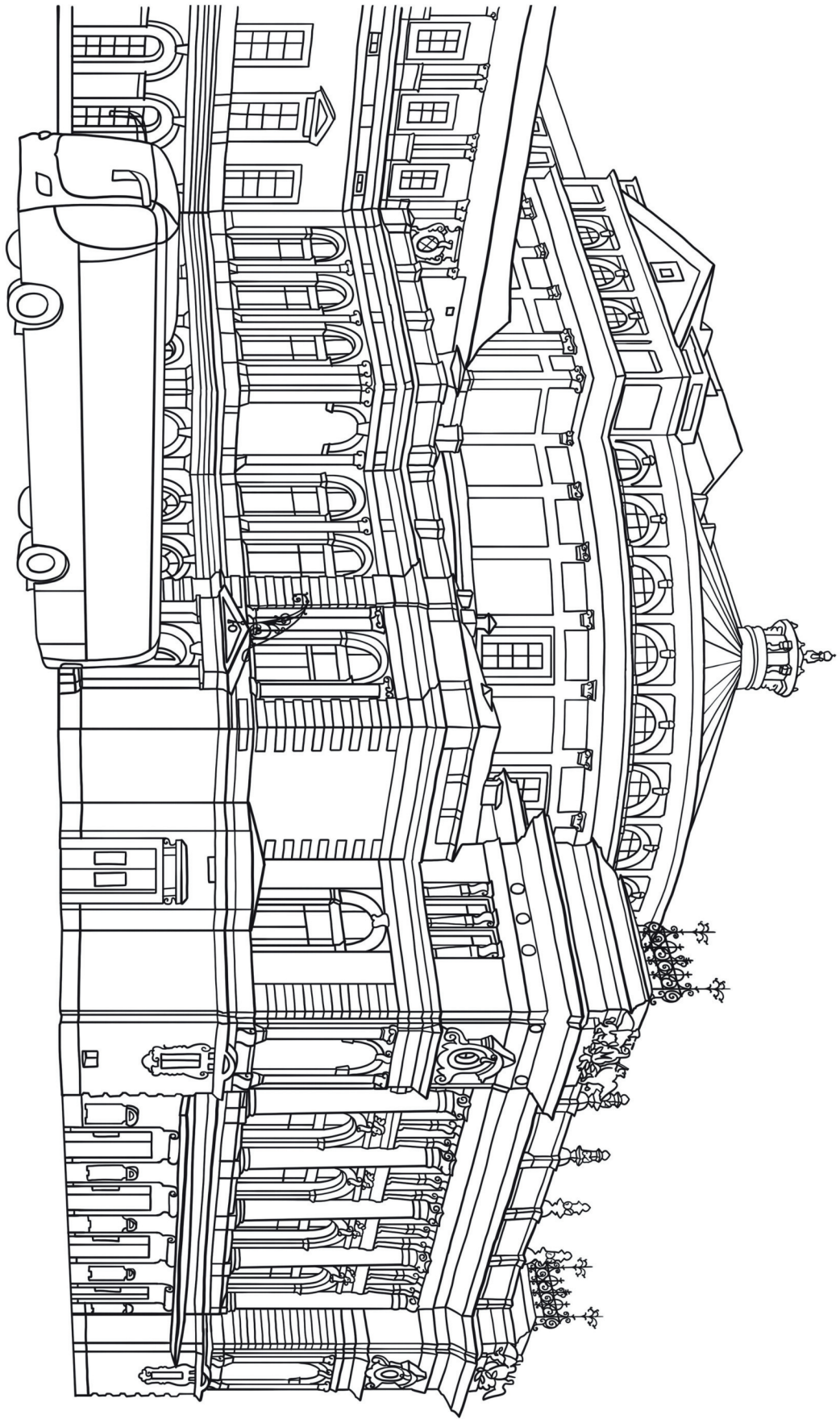

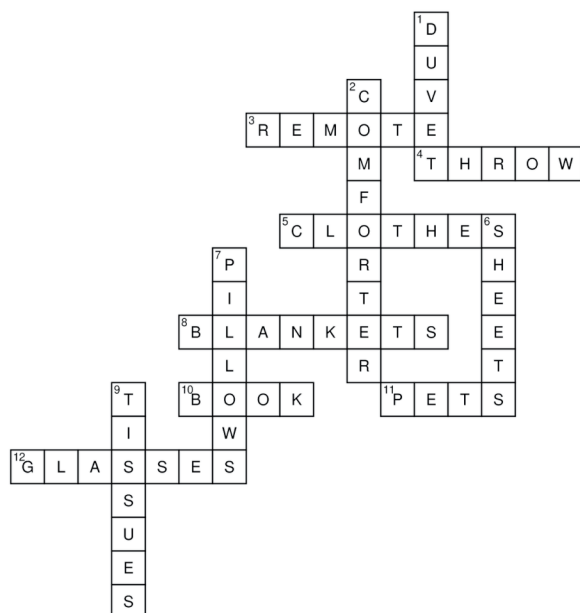
