Spiders have Arachnophobia?

Arachnophobia is a common phobia, even among spiders. A 2021 study found that zebra jumping spiders fear larger jumping spider species, even when shown deceased specimens or 3D models. Approximately 19 million Americans have a phobia. Acrophobia (heights), aerophobia (flying), trypanophobia (needles), and social phobias like public speaking also rank among the most common fears.

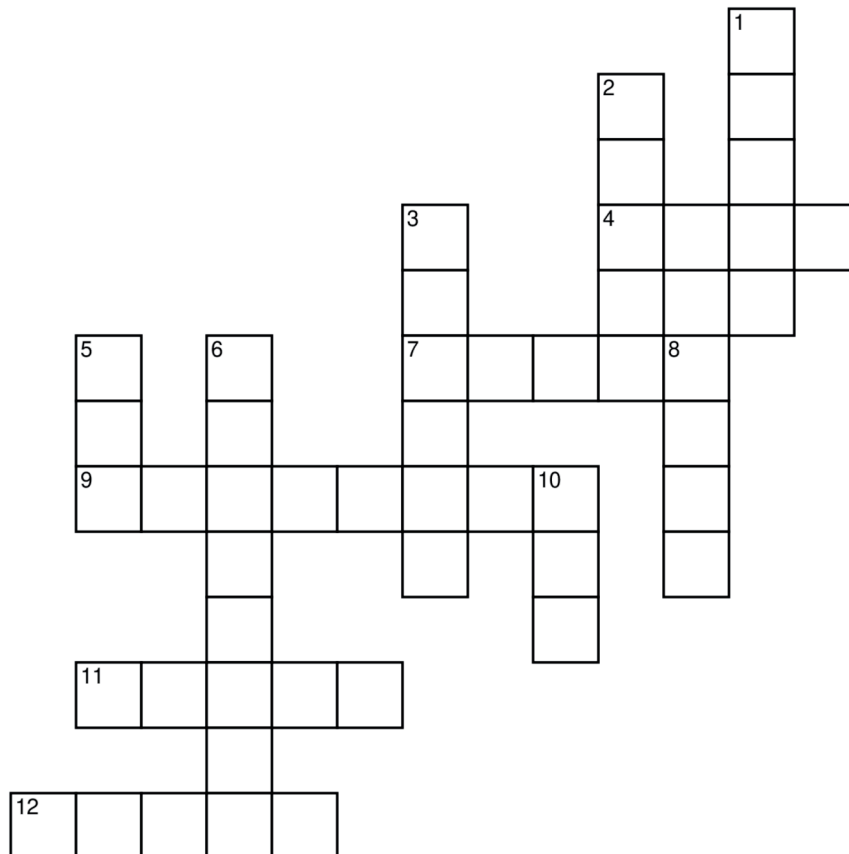

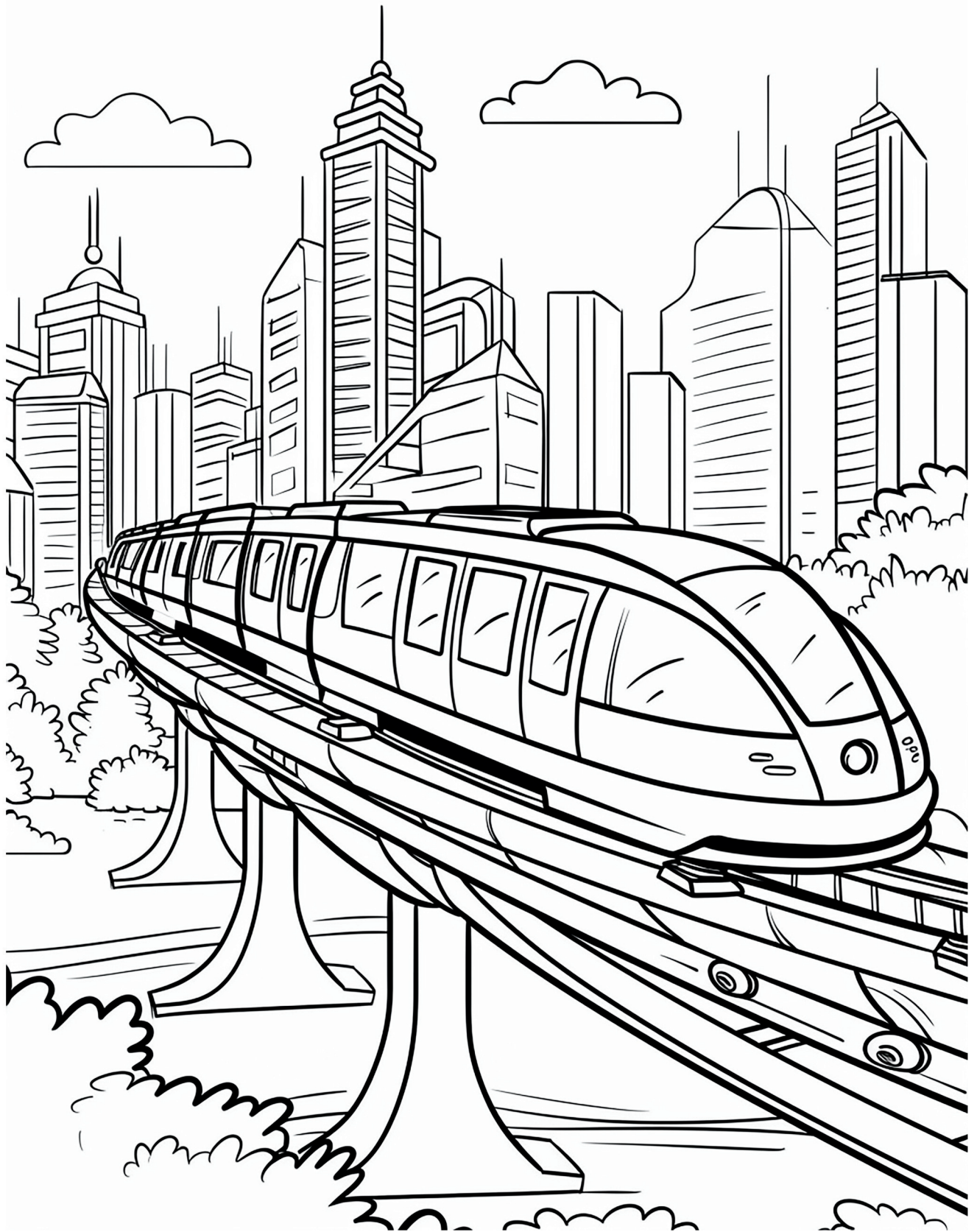
