Sweet Caroline became a stadium tradition because crowds love shouting, "So good! So good!" However, those famous crowd responses were not part of the original recording. Fans gradually added them over the years, and the call-and-response tradition spread from ballparks to bars, weddings, and sporting events, transforming a simple pop song into a shared cultural experience enjoyed by millions around the world.

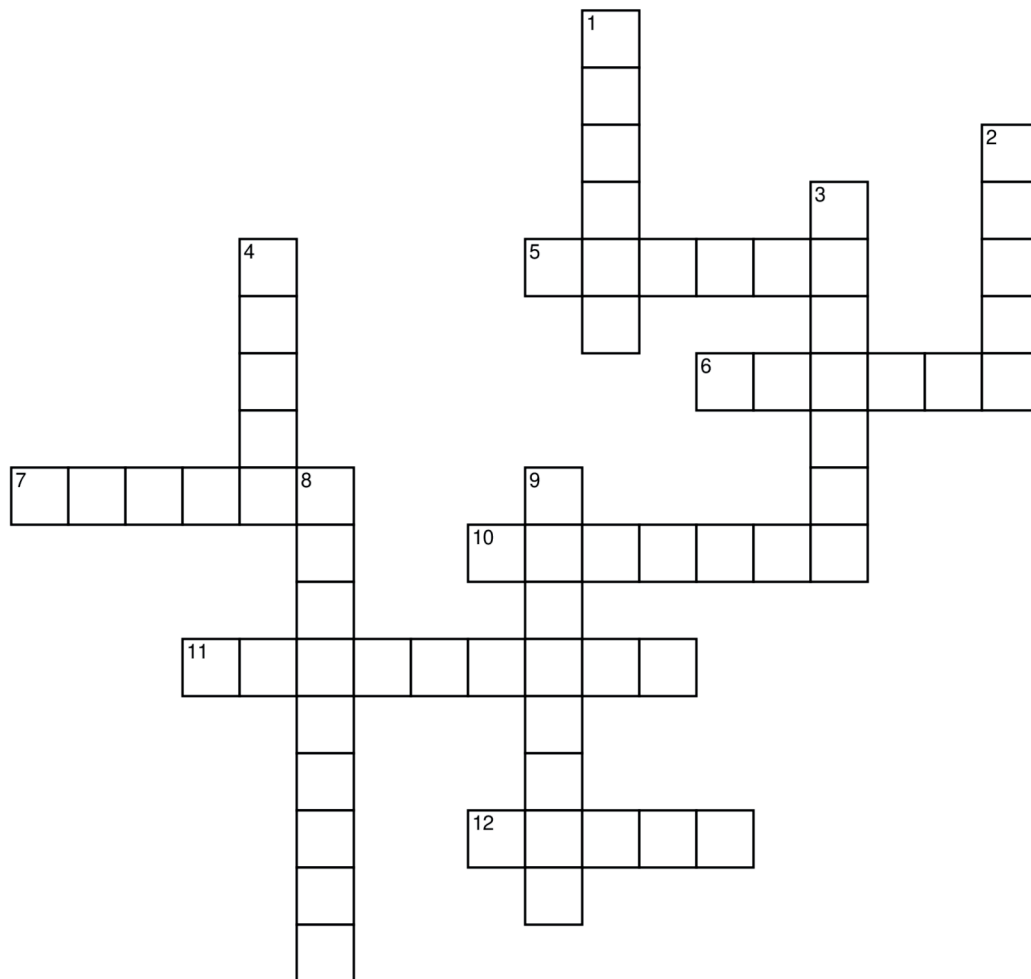

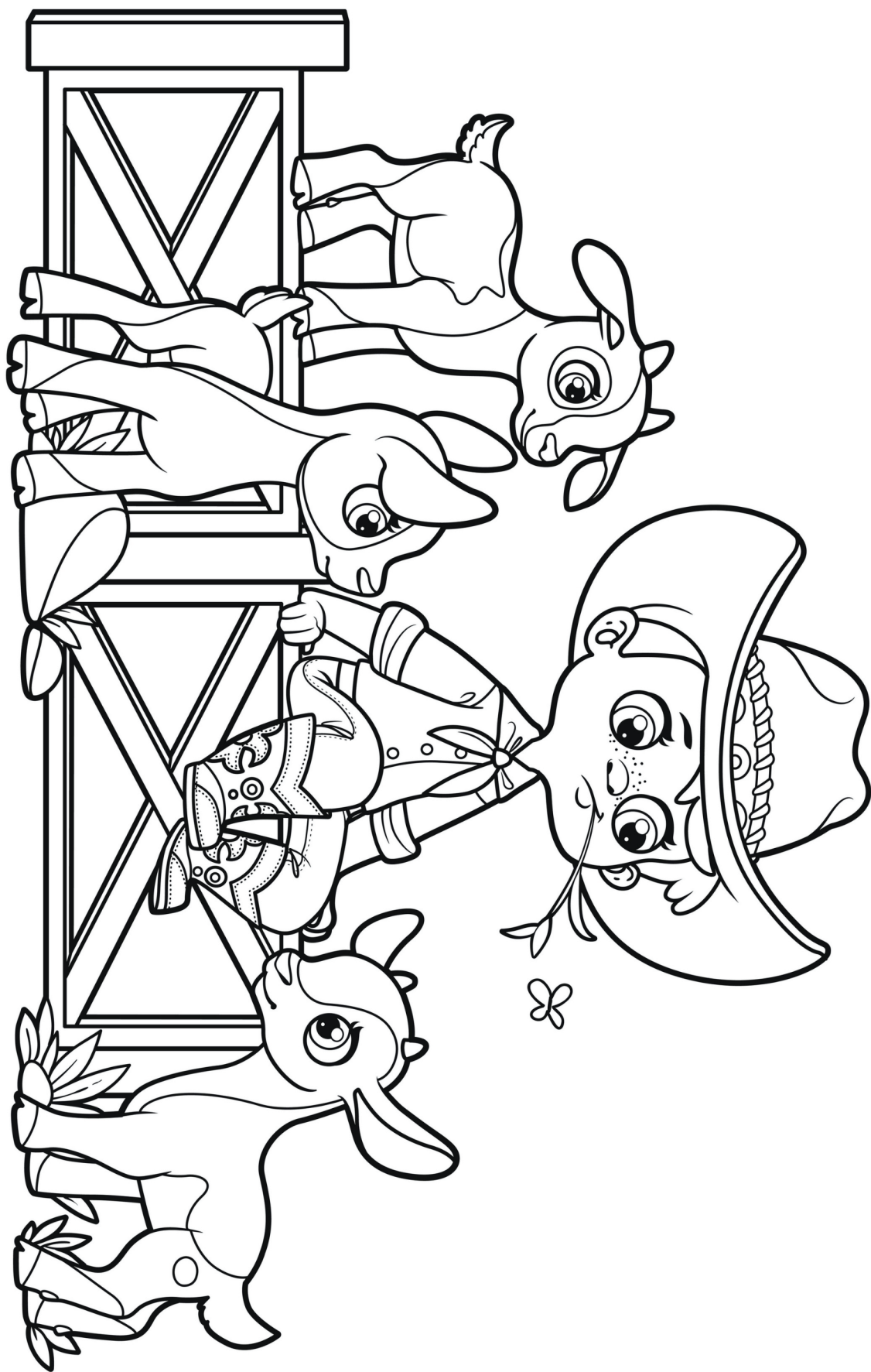

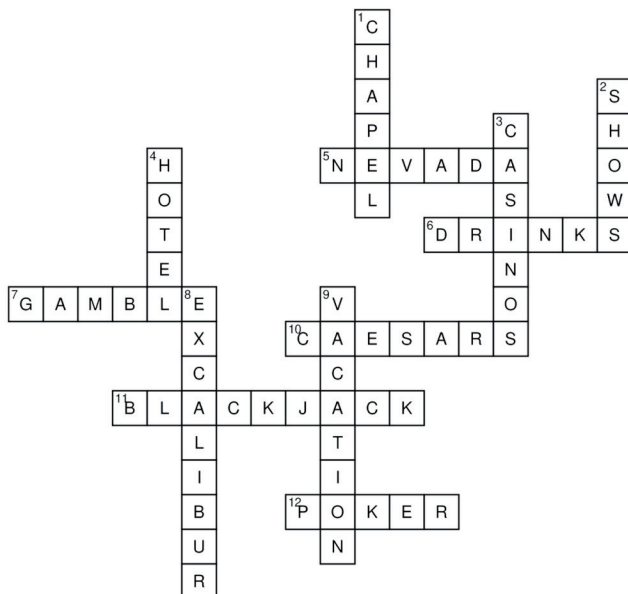
