Lot'a Olives!

Olives have a surprisingly low yield when it comes to oil. It takes about 11 pounds of olives to make 32 ounces — or 1 quart — of olive oil. That's between 5,200 and 8,000 olives, depending on the variety. This is also the reason olive oil is often more expensive than other kinds of edible oils. About 90% of the world's harvested olives are slated to become oil (the rest will become table olives).

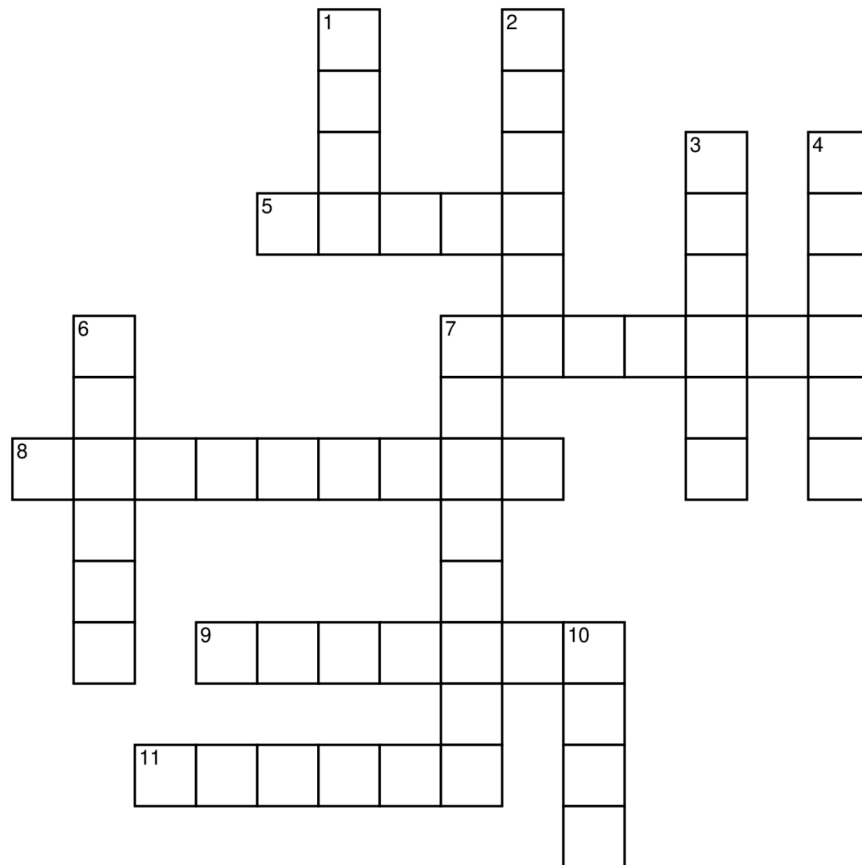

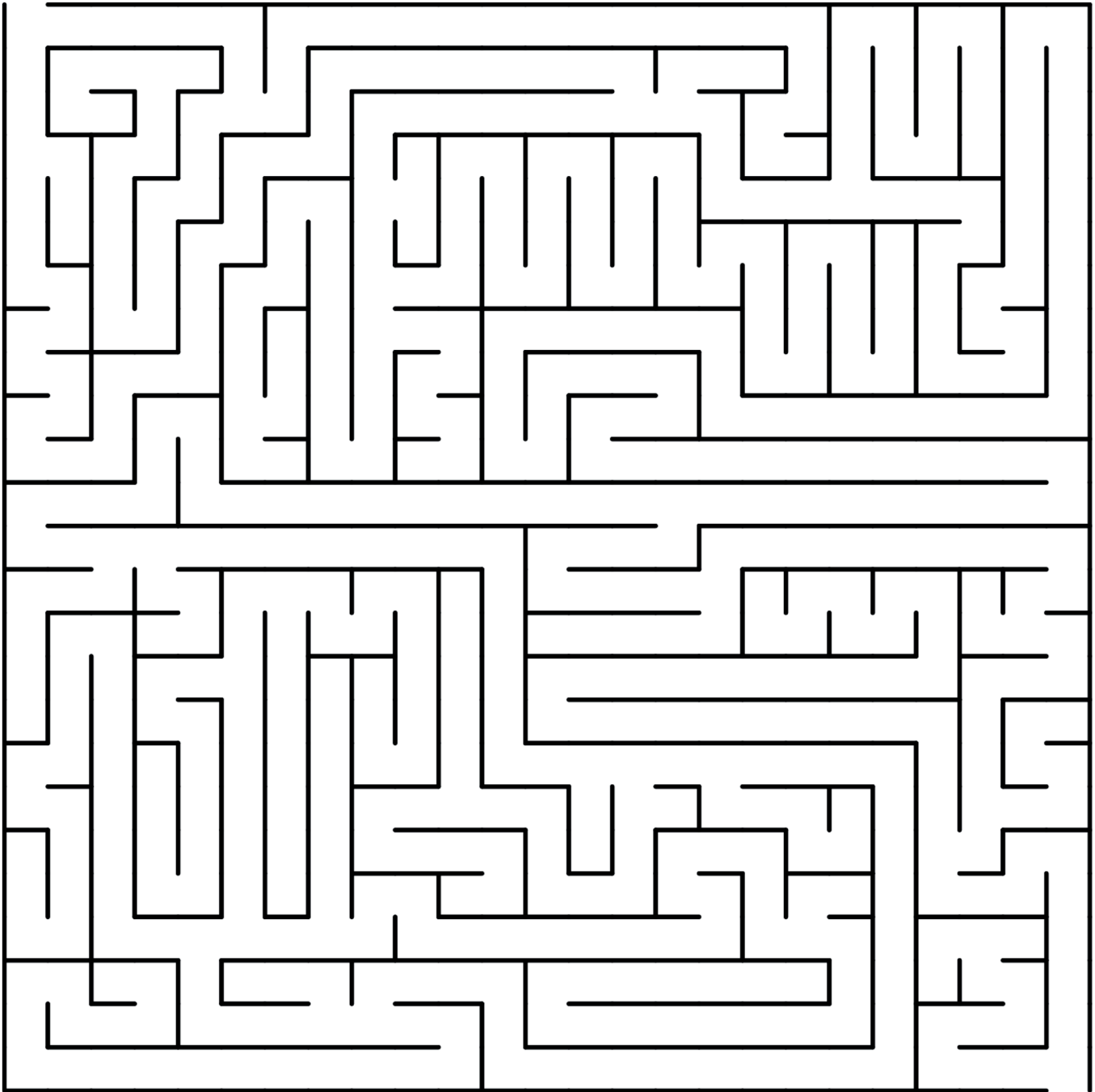

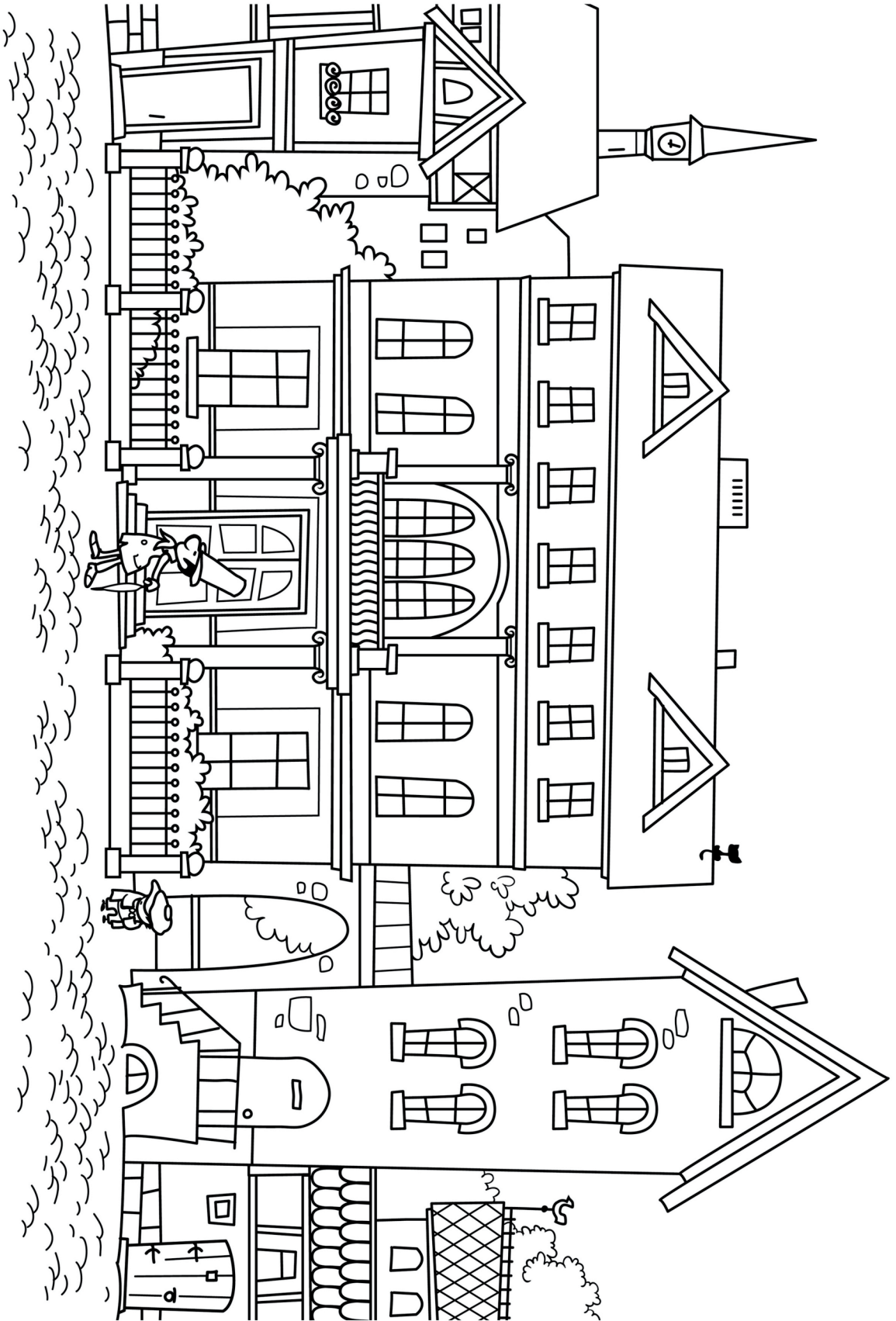
