

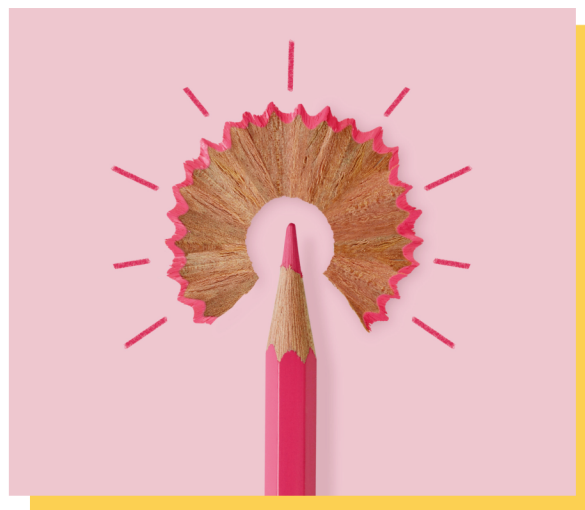

On the Japanese copy of the Japan Instrument of Surrender (marking the end of hostilities in WWII), Canadian Colonel Lawrence Moore Cosgrave signed on the wrong line. 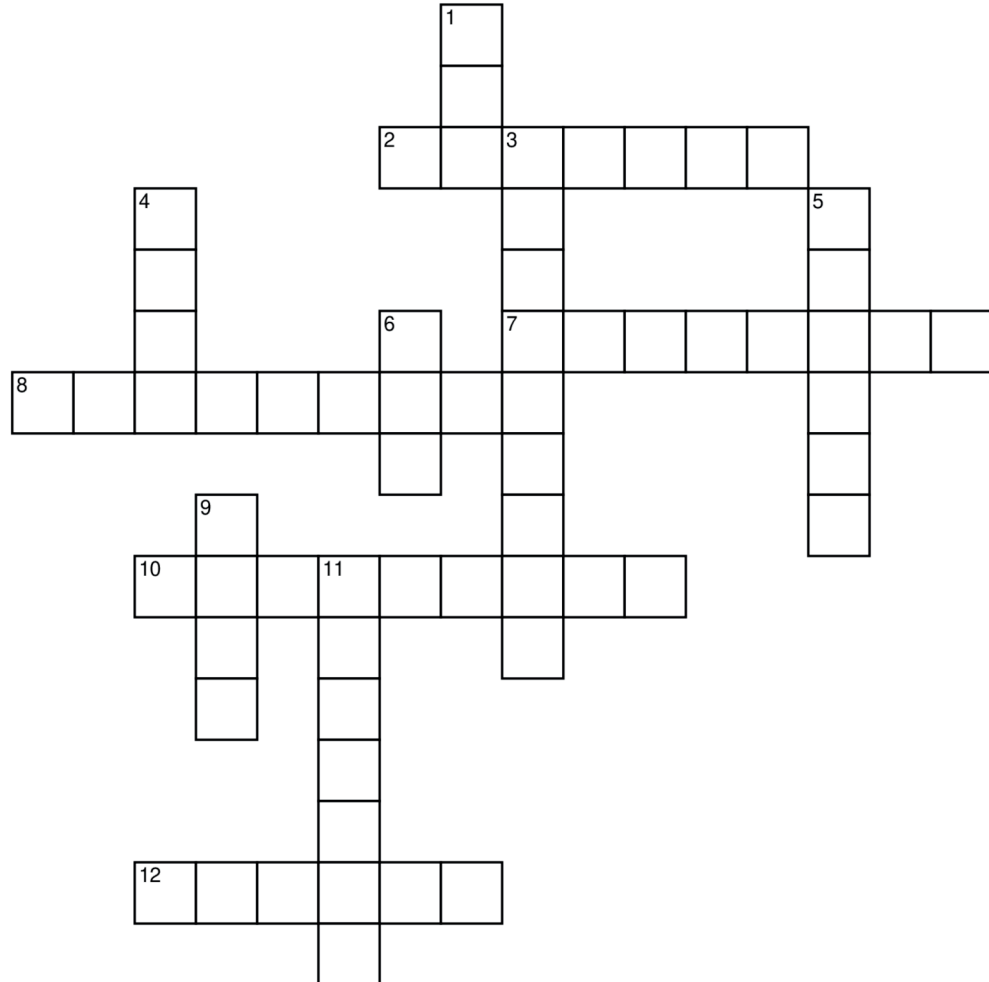

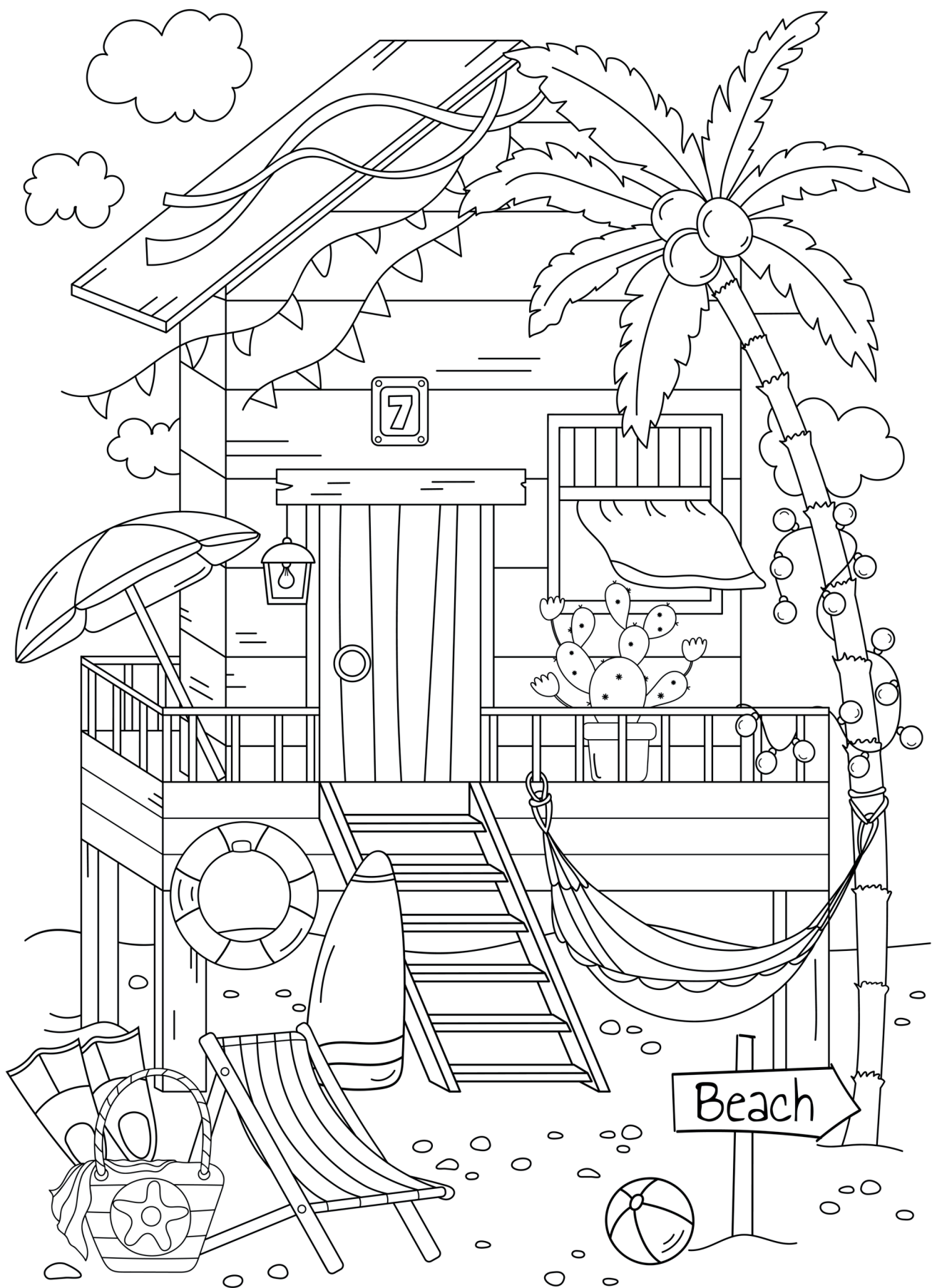

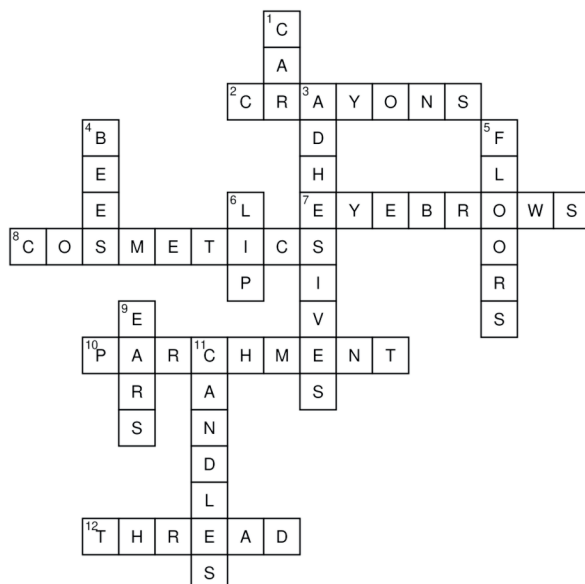
Trivia Answer: D
