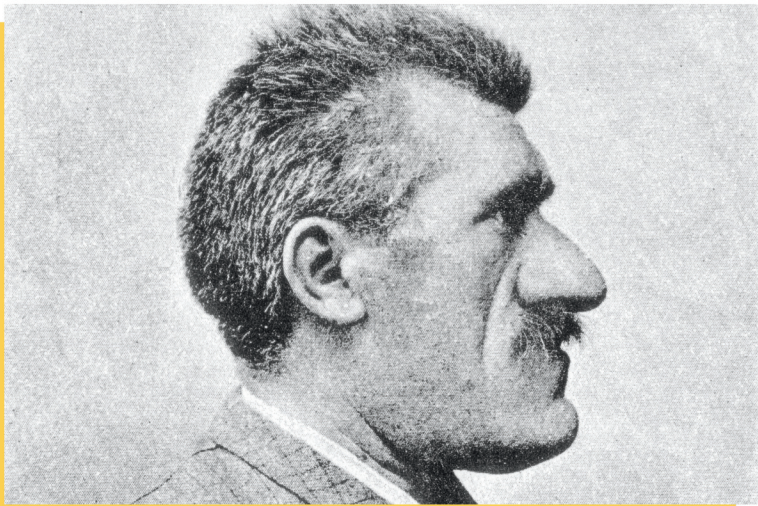
Today in History

The Man Who Inspired Shrek

The character Shrek from the 2001 animated film was inspired by a real person, Maurice Tillet, also known as "The French Angel". Tillet was a French-born wrestler known for his strength and intimidating appearance. He had a rare disorder called Acromegaly, which caused excessive growth in certain parts of his body. Tillet had a successful wrestling career in Boston, going undefeated for 19 months in a row, before passing away in Chicago at the age of 51.

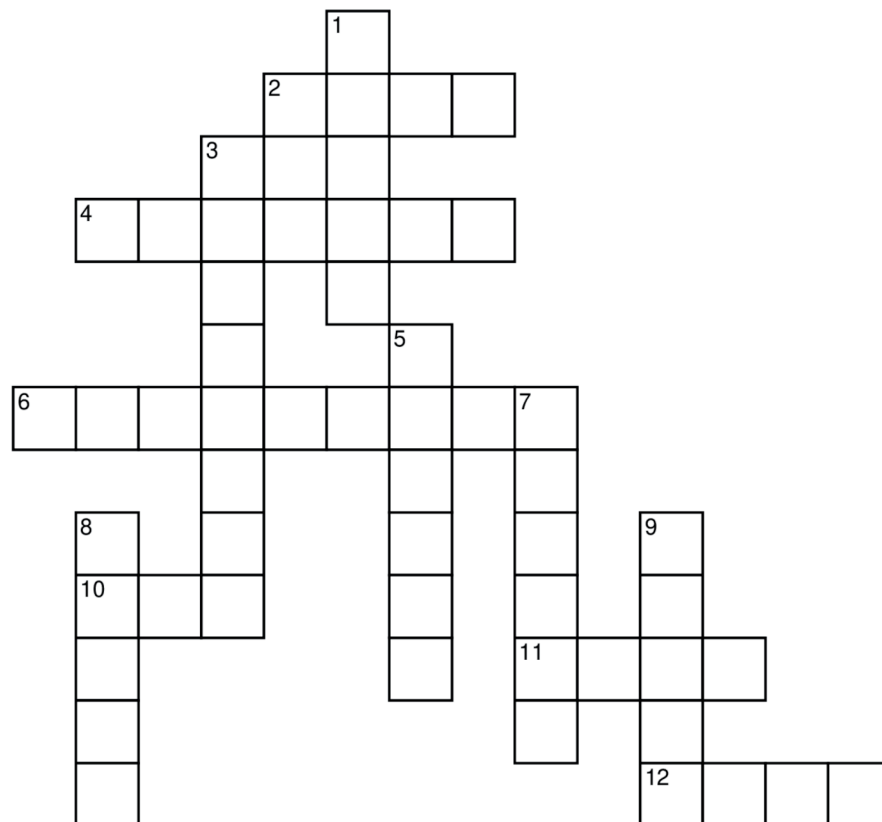

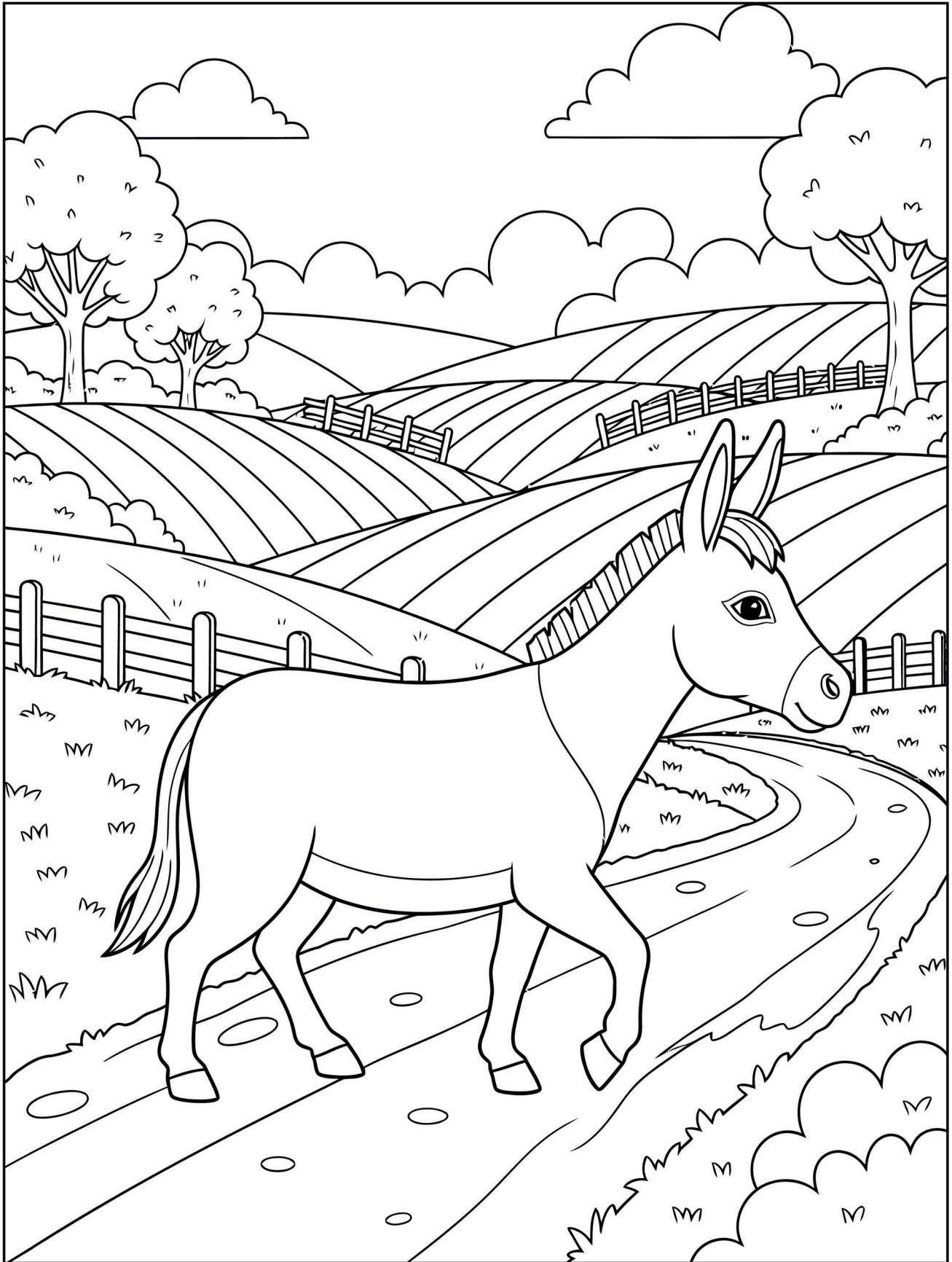
