The organization, Greenpeace, was founded on September 15th, 1971, when 17 activists hoped to stop the nuclear testing taking place off the shores of Alaska. Although they were unsuccessful in their mission, this protest set a movement that is still growing today. Greenpeace still holds peaceful protests for change. Today marks a day to perhaps get a group together to pick up trash, engage in cleanup, or discuss ways to help our environment.

In 1853, Antoinette Brown Blackwell became the first U.S. woman to be ordained a minister. She left the ministry in 1857 and returned to her work as an orator and reformer for women's rights issues. Blackwell was awarded honorary Master's and Doctoral degrees from Oberlin College.

Nevada was almost Humboldt

Alexander von Humboldt was a German polymath, geographer, naturalist, and explorer. Humboldt's name is widely used in the West, thanks to the explorer Alexander von Humboldt. Although he never visited the western U.S., fellow explorer John C. Fremont named many locations in honor of him. Nevada was also considered to be named "Humboldt," but "Nevada," the Spanish word for "snow-covered," was chosen instead.

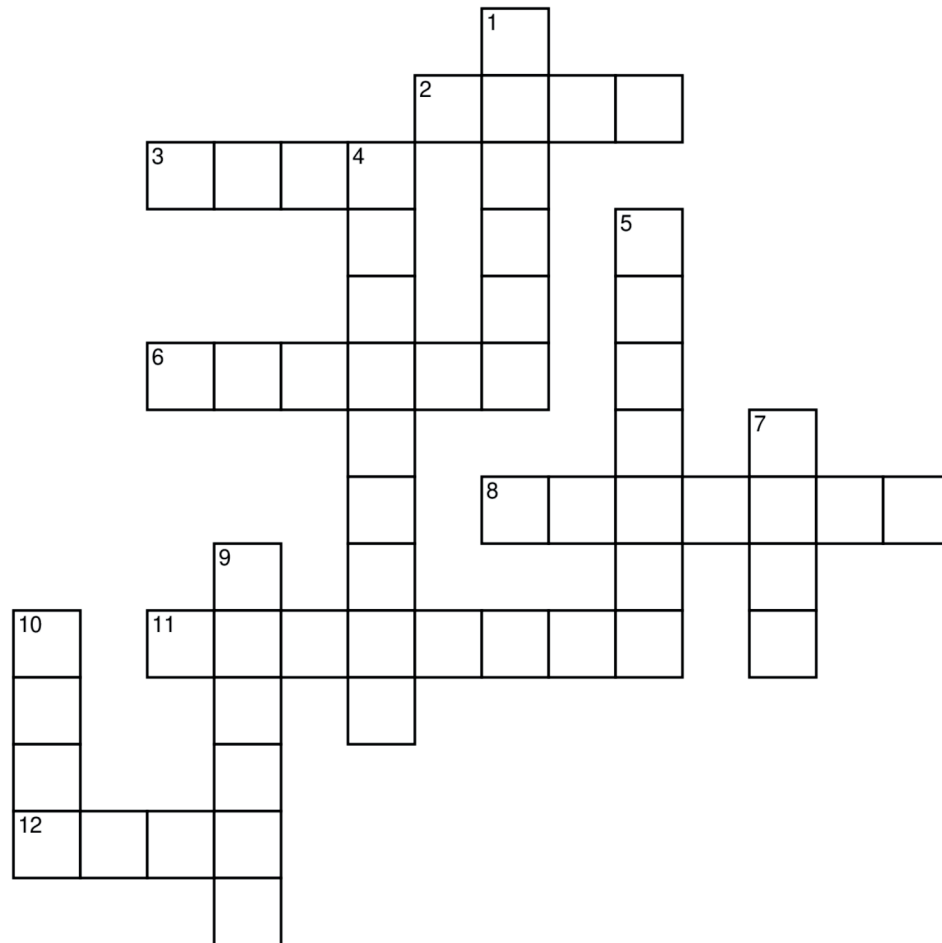

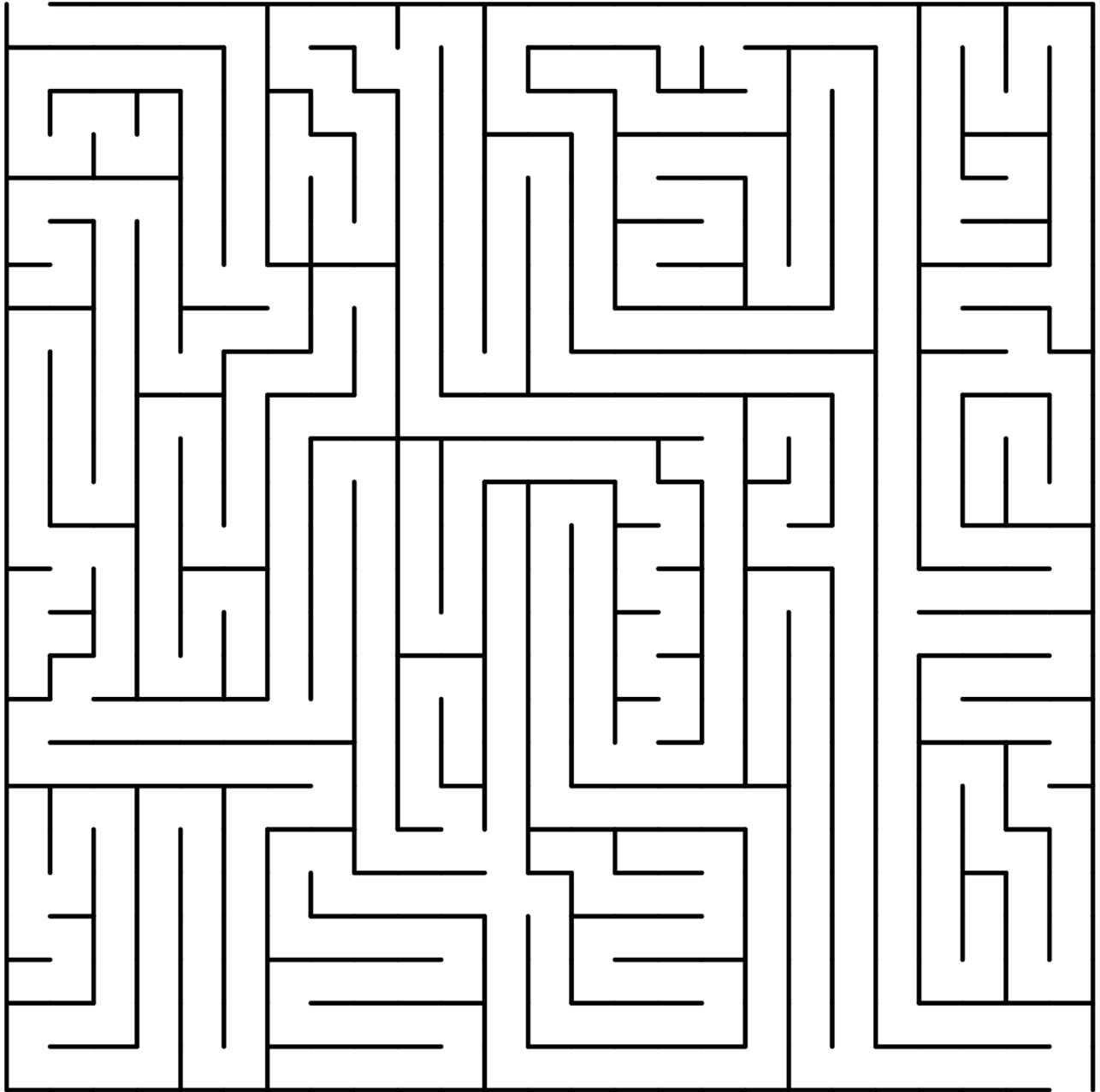
