In 1972, "I'm Still in Love with You," Al Green's 5th studio album, was released. It won the Billboard Album of the Year in 1973. He won 11 Grammy Awards and was honored with the Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award. Green was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1995.

Paving the Way: Kitty Wells' Groundbreaking Hit

Kitty Wells, known as the "Queen of Country Music," was the first female solo artist to have a number-one hit on the country charts. Her groundbreaking 1952 song, "It Wasn't God Who Made Honky Tonk Angels," was a bold answer to a popular male-led song. The controversial lyrics, which blamed men for women's "wild side," were initially banned by some radio stations but became a massive success, paving the way for female country artists who followed.

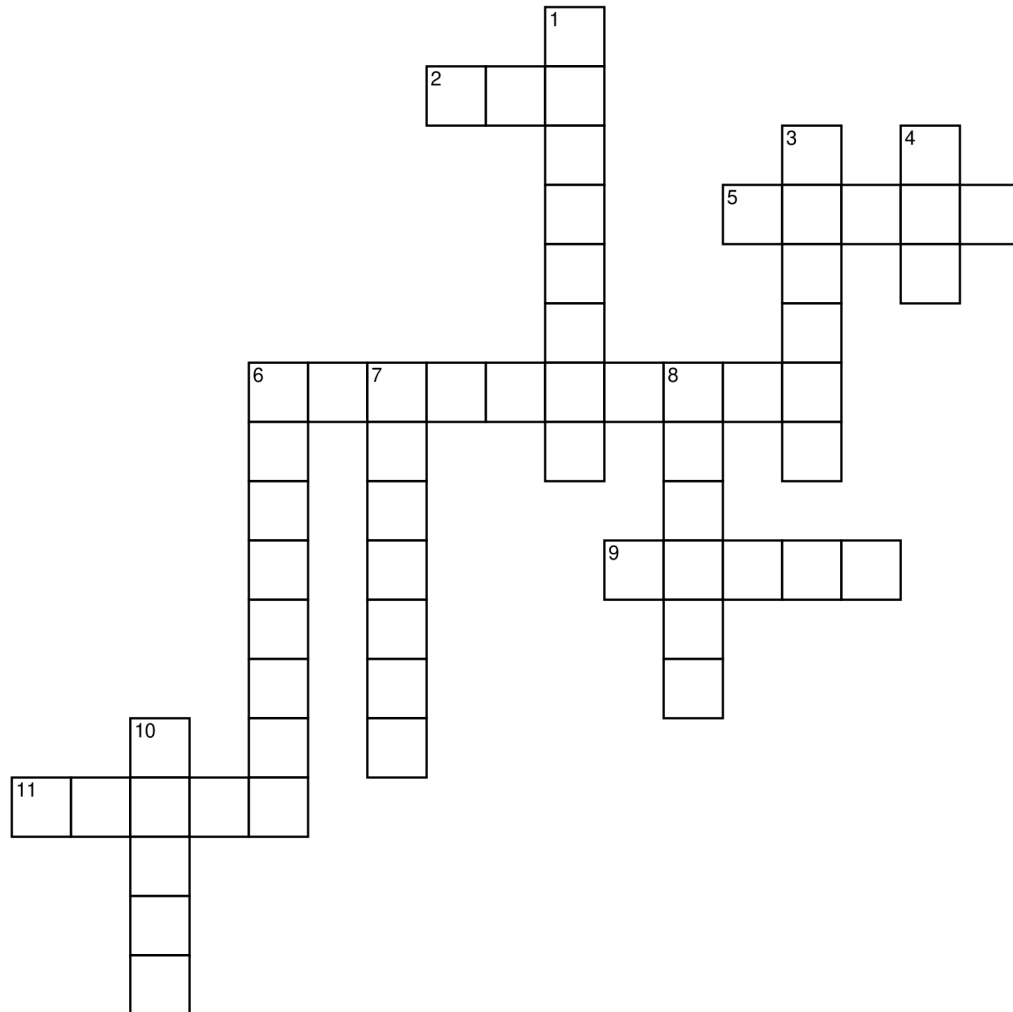

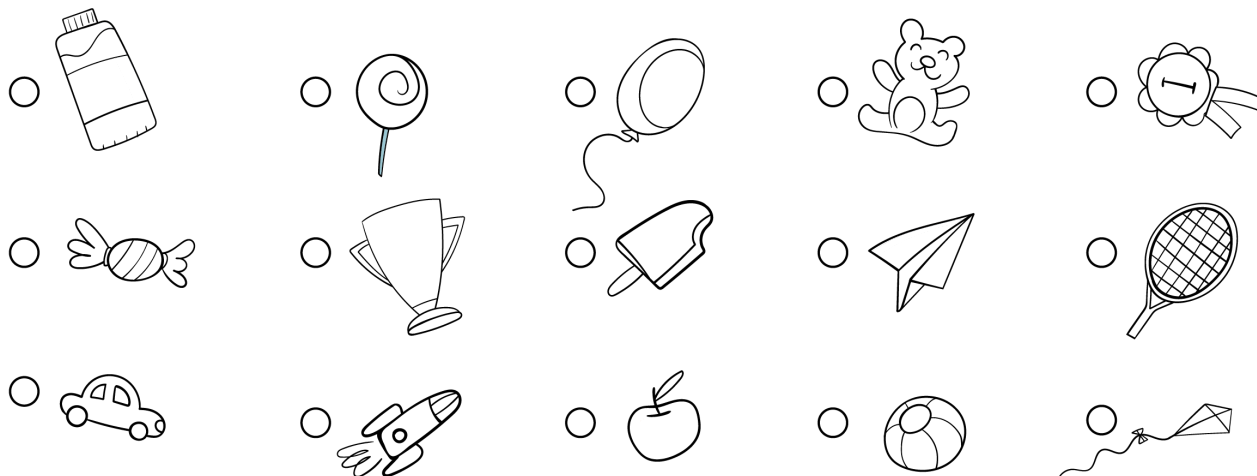
