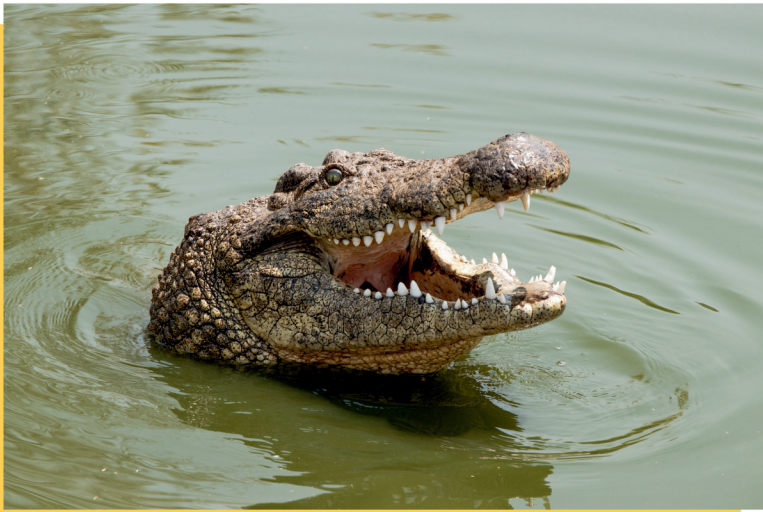


Today in History



In 1921, American inventor Charles Strite was granted a U.S. patent for the automatic pop-up toaster. He named his invention the “Toastmaster” and set up the Waters Genter company to manufacture and market it. Selling 1 million units annually by 1930, toasters became very popular.

Crocs Can't Stick Out Their Tongues

Crocodiles have the most powerful chomp in the animal kingdom, at 3,700 pounds per square inch for a saltwater crocodile. Attached to the roof of the mouth, crocodiles have a membrane that holds their tongues in place on the roof of their mouths, preventing them from sticking their tongues out. This can be useful when they quickly snap their jaws shut, so they won't accidentally bite off their tongue while eating prey.

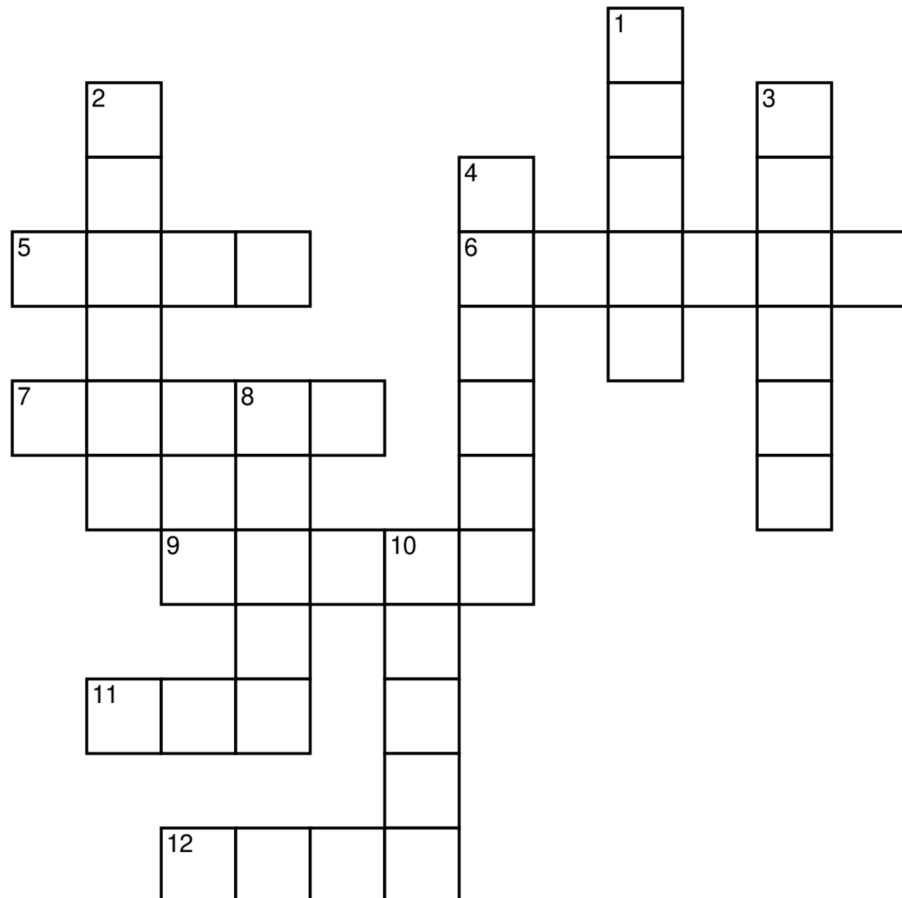

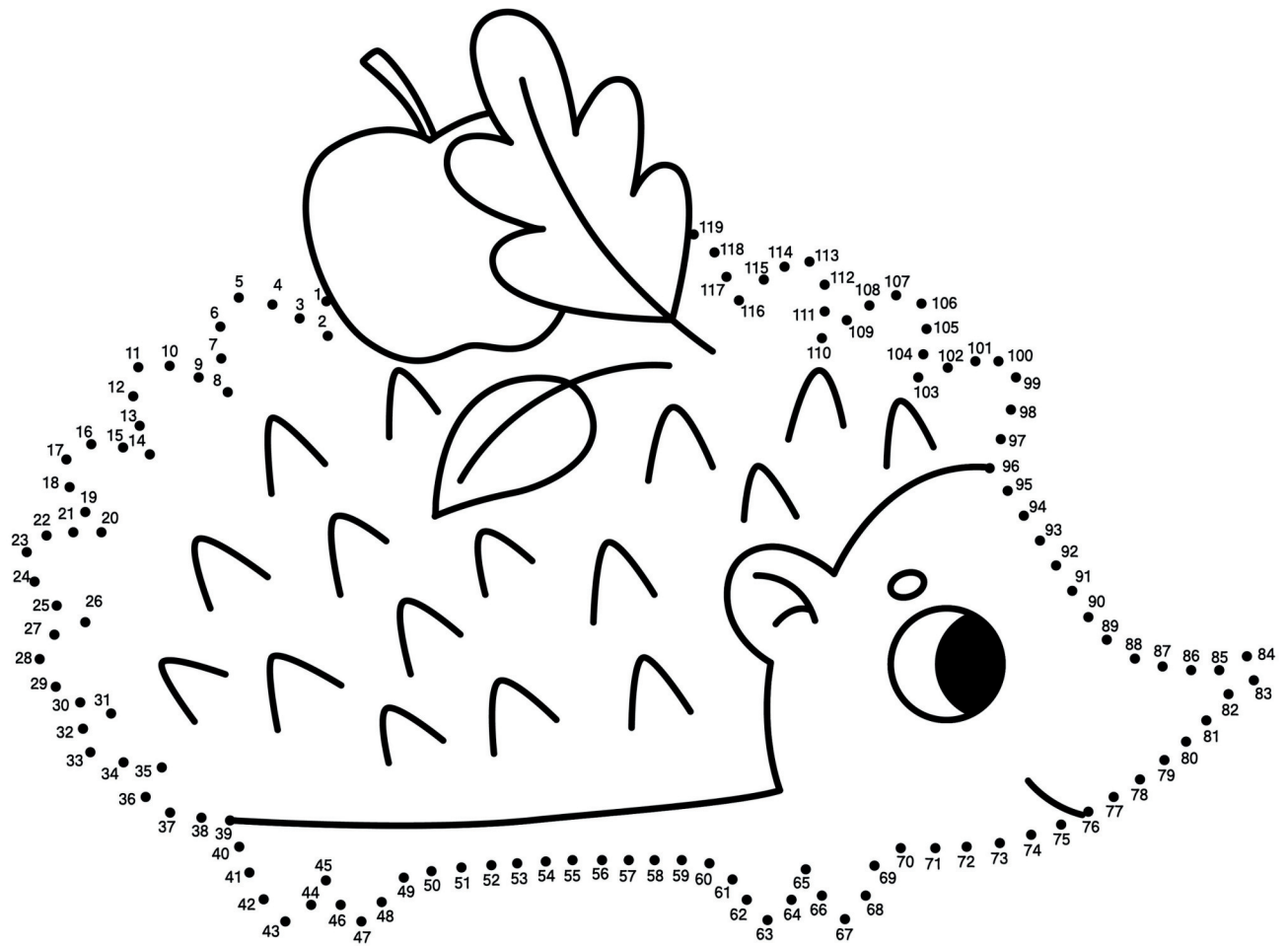

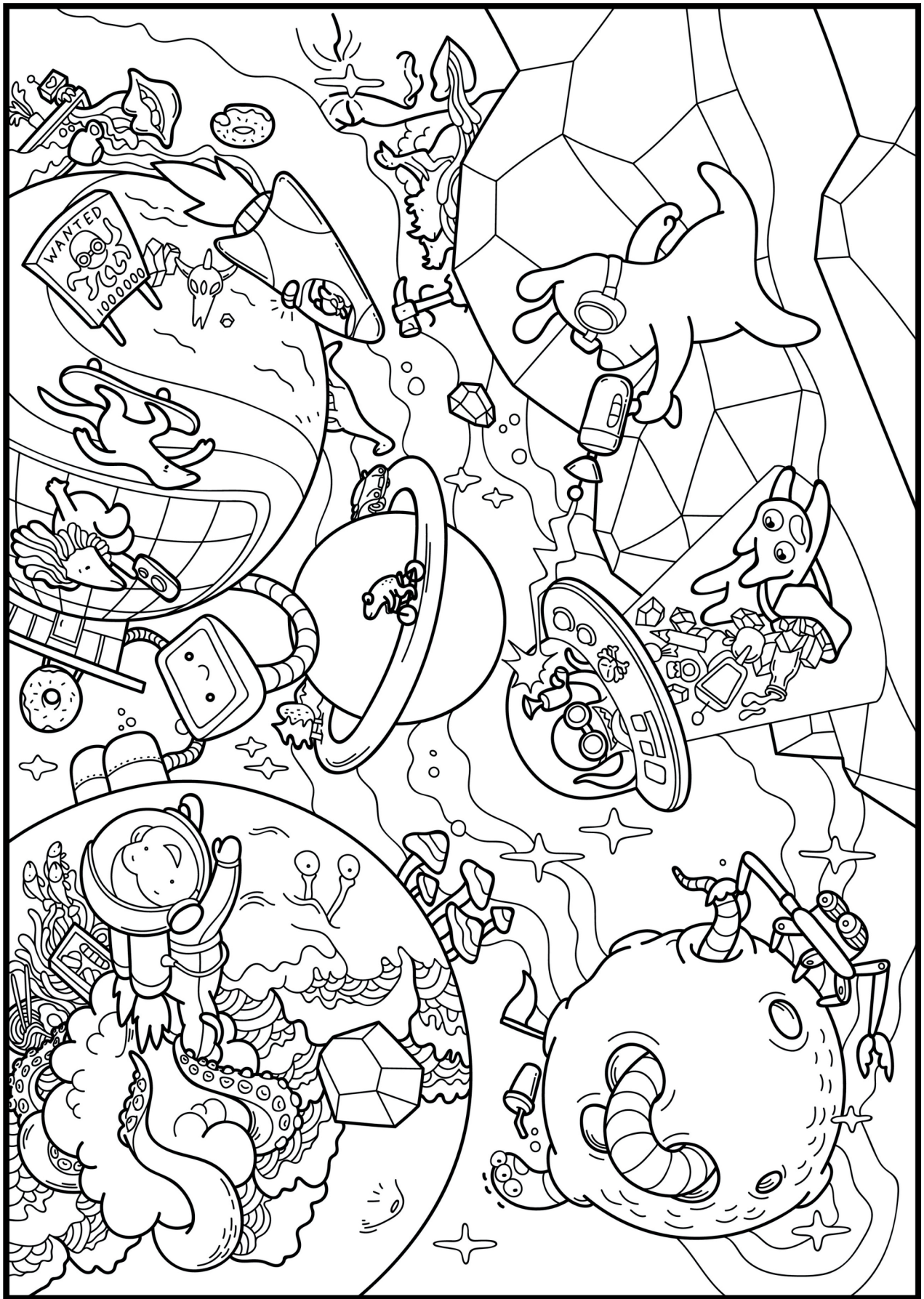
