The Original Hand Grenade

The pomegranate has an astonishing connection to both history and weaponry. The name "pomegranate" comes from the Latin *pōmum grānātum*, meaning "seeded apple," while its French name, *grenade*, gave rise to the name of the explosive device. The round, seed-filled shape of a pomegranate was a perfect metaphor for the early grenades, which scattered shrapnel like seeds when they detonated.

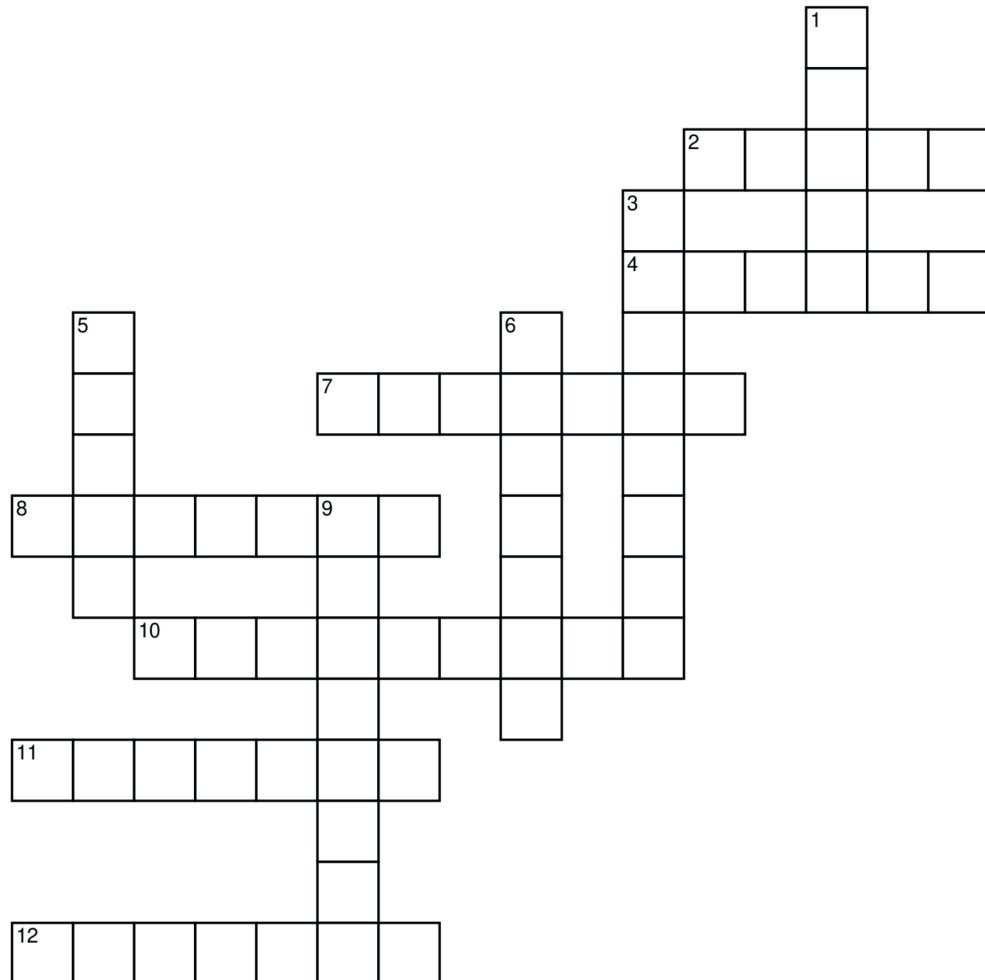

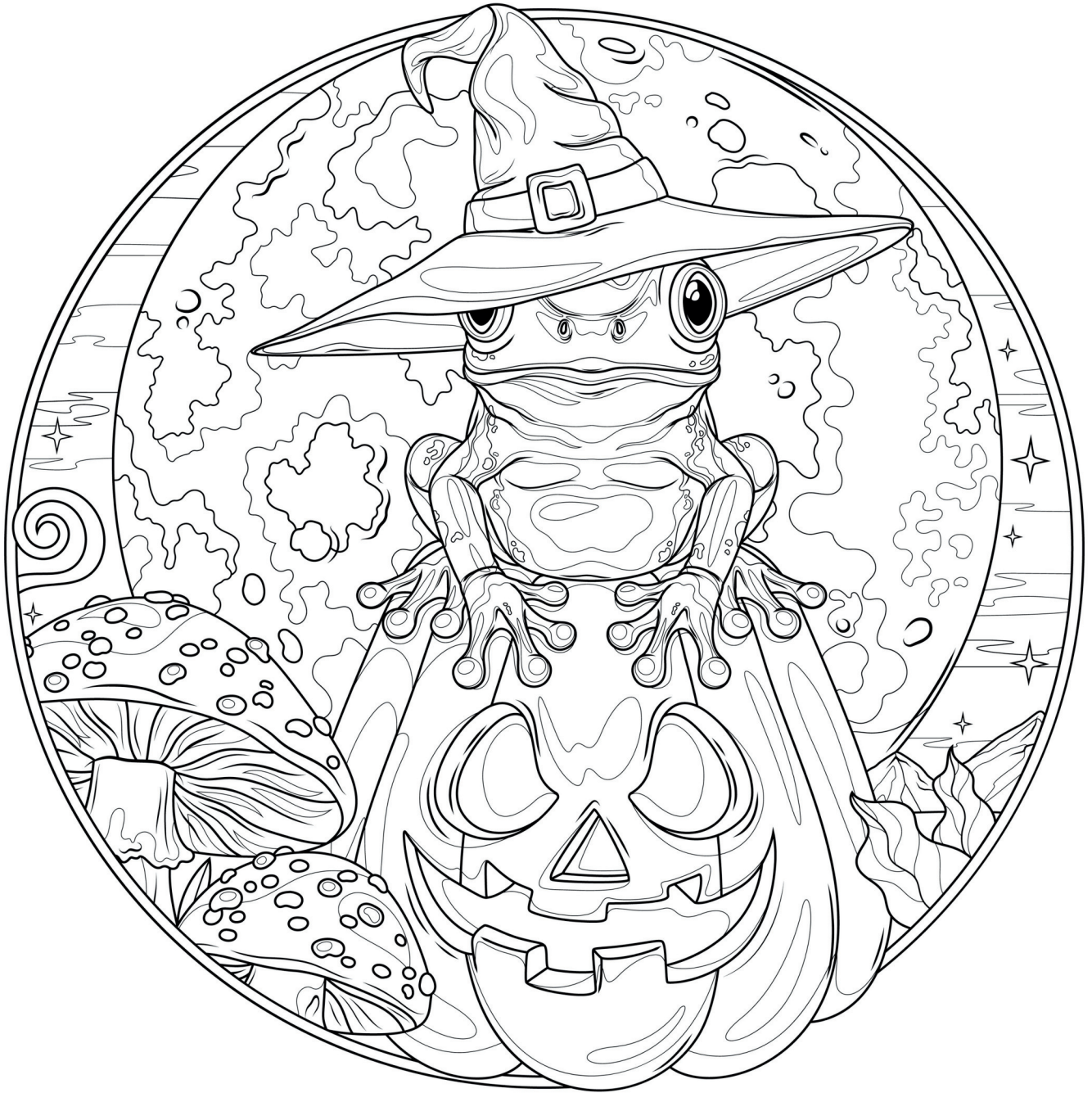

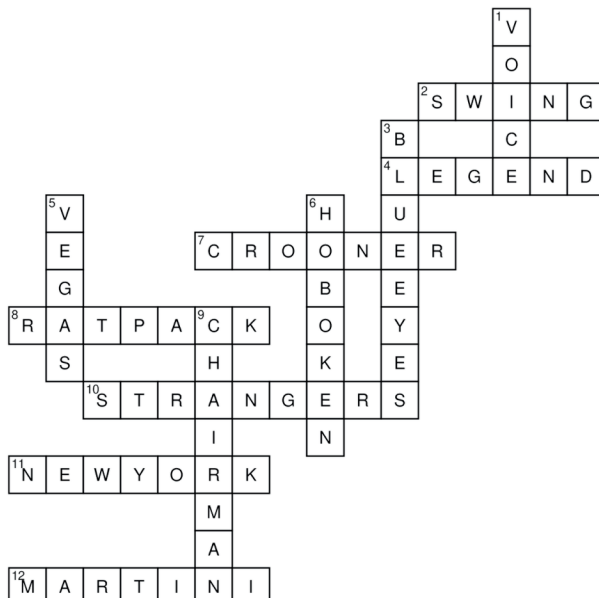
