DID YOU KNOW? Hand-Me-Down Genes (Sometimes)

Handedness is not determined by a single gene but is a complex trait influenced by many genes, likely up to 40. 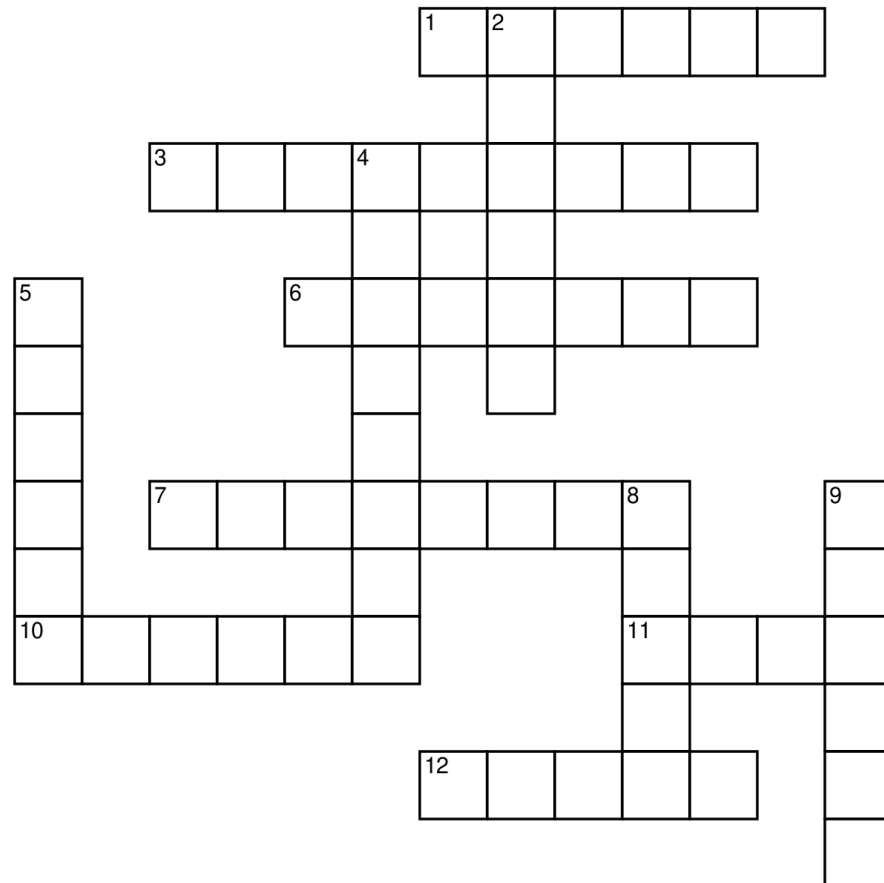

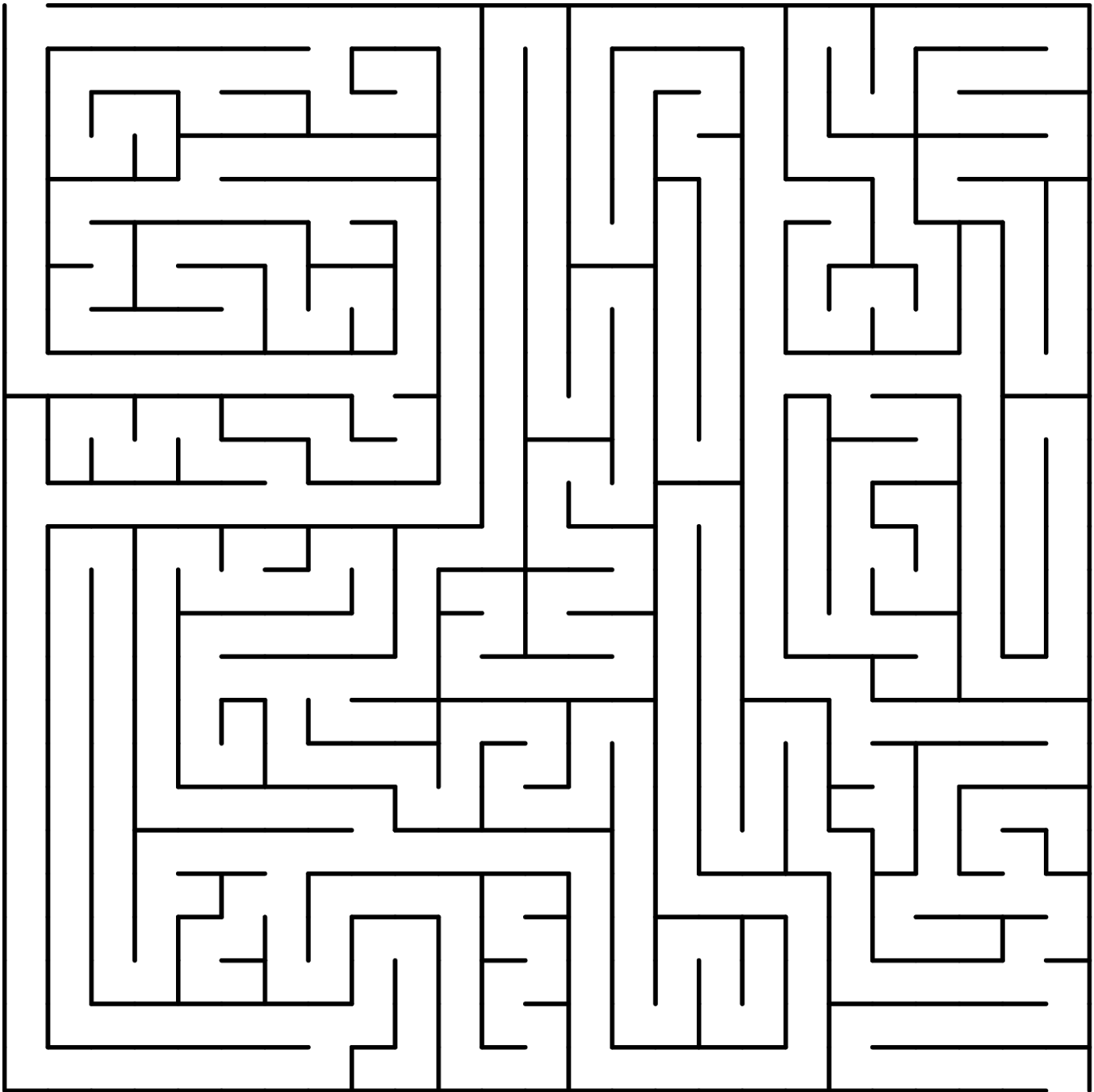

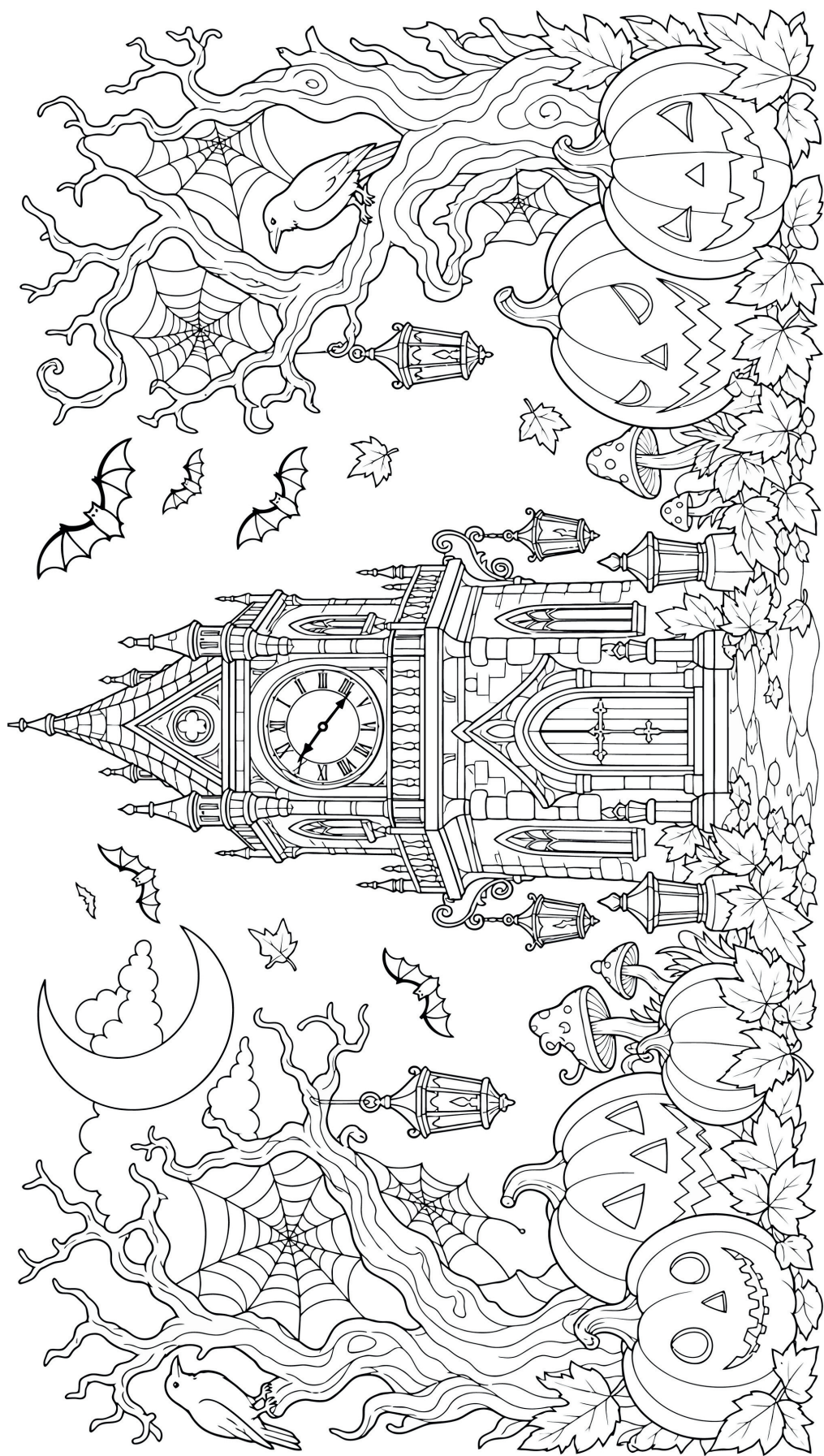
